Walker notched 16.5 points per game to lead Radford to a 2-0 record in Big South play last week to clinch the No. 2 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. She got things going with 20 points on 60 percent shooting from the floor, four rebounds, six assists, three steals and one block as the Highlanders downed UNC Asheville on Feb. 26. Four days later against Winthrop, Walker put in 13 points and was a perfect 9-of-9 at the line. She also came away with three rebounds and three steals against Winthrop to secure the season sweep and the No. 2 seed in the tournament. For the week, she was 8-of-16 from the floor and connected on 16-of-19 from the charity stripe for an 84 percent clip. The honor marks her second Player of the Week accolade this season.

Maier averaged 20.5 points per game and shot 53 percent from the field to lead the Panthers to a 2-0 record on the week. She got her week started with 24 points at Charleston Southern on Feb. 26. She connected on 10-of-19 from the field against the Lady Bucs for a 53 percent clip and added two from the line and two from downtown. She also ripped down nine rebounds and posted three blocks, three assists and one steal in the win. On March 1 at Coastal Carolina, Maier put in 17 points on 7-of-13 from the floor as well as two from the charity stripe and one from beyond the arc. In the paint, she corralled six rebounds, two steals and turned away three shots. The honor marks her fourth Freshman of the Week nod this season.

With Liberty's win over UNC Asheville last week, the Lady Flames have clinched the 2008 regular-season championship and the No. 1 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Regular-Season Championship ... Radford picked up two wins last week and secured the No. 2 in the tournament with a season sweep of Winthrop ... Winthrop locked up the No. 3 seed, while High Point has the fourth spot ... The rest of the seeds will be known after this week's games.

THAT'S RIGHT, WE'RE THE ONLY ONES THIS YEAR

Against High Point on Jan. 29 MEGAN and MORIAH FRAZEE became the only sisters in Division I to put in 20-or-more points each in a game this season. Megan notched 22 points while Moriah put in 20 ... In the Big South, Megan and Moriah are the only two players to earn multiple Player of the Week honors.

M² ... MORE ON MEGAN AND MORIAH

Megan and Moriah have combined for 7-of-13 Big South Player of the Week honors this season. Megan has earned the honor five times, while Moriah picked up honors on Dec. 10 and Feb. 4. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs' 48 rebounds against High Point was their highest total in conference play this season ... CSU had 19 offensive rebounds versus High Point, also its best in league play ... Senior **SHAUNTE SMALL** had one rejection against High Point, pushing her program-record career block total to 178 ... Senior **NATALIE CALDWELL** is two point shy of reaching 700 for her career ... Freshman **DYNASTY GREENE** set a new career high with nine rebounds versus High Point, including four offensive boards ... Freshman **KATIE TULL** connected on a career-high five free throws on her way to 10 points versus High Point, her eighth double-digit scoring game of the season ... With 17 points against High Point, junior **PAM TOLBERT** has scored in double figures in 15 consecutive games ... Freshman **CRYSTAL ROBINSON** scored six points against High Point, helping her eclipse the 200-point total with 203, joined by Tull, whose 10 points gave her 201.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal honored its three seniors Saturday afternoon before the game against High Point. **C.J. WARE**, **VICKY BLANCHARD** and **JOANNA PEKONEN** played their final game at Kimbel Arena in the 65-59 loss to High Point... **DEVIN RIVERS** scored a career high 14 points against the Panthers... **JESSICA NOLL** also had a career high with nine points, going 2-of-4 from three-point range... Coastal ends the regular season Wednesday, March 5 at Charleston Southern before taking nine days off for the 2008 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament... In the loss to High Point, **AMANDA STULL** had eight points, nine rebounds and three assists. Seven of those rebounds came in the first half.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers concluded the regular season last week, winning back-to-back road games over Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. High Point will have 13 days off before the start of the Big South Conference Tournament on March 14-16 in Asheville.

LIBERTY

With a 60-46 victory at UNC Asheville on Saturday, Liberty wrapped up its 10th Big South regular-season championship in the last 11 seasons ... **MEGAN FRAZEE**, who posted double-doubles in both of Liberty's games this past week, is one of eight players in the nation averaging over 18 points and 9 rebounds per contest ... If the Lady Flames defeat Radford in Friday's regular-season finale, Liberty will equal the program record for regular-season victories, with 26. The 1997-98 Lady Flames were 26-0, entering the conference tournament ... A victory on Friday would also complete an undefeated season at home. Four previous Lady Flames squads have gone unbeaten during an entire season ... **EGLA SMIGELSKAITA** made a late season debut. The senior played her first game of 2007-08 at Winthrop on Wednesday, after missing the first 26 contests due to a foot injury ... Liberty bounced back from a Wednesday setback at Winthrop with a Saturday triumph at UNC Asheville, meaning the Lady Flames still have not lost consecutive Big South contests since February 1997.

PRESBYTERIAN

Senior guard **AMY JONES** scored 13 points, while teammates **BRIDGET TAKACH** and Sharie Hopkins added 10 points each in Presbyterian College's 73-58 loss to Longwood ... The loss to Longwood ends PC's first year in NCAA Division I women's basketball with PC owning a 2-24 record ... Jones finished the game and her Lady Blue Hose career by hitting 3-of-8 from field goal range, grabbing seven caroms, dishing out two assists and forcing four steals ... Takach was 2-for-5 from 3-point range and finished the game with a 4-of-12 performance from the floor overall, scoring 10 points in her final collegiate game ... Presbyterian College senior point guard Jones finished the season by leading the team in five statistical categories. Jones, who appeared in all 26 games this season, led the team in minutes played (862), assists (89), steals (54), points (261) and point per game average (10.0). She guided the Lady Blue Hose through their first season of Division I competition, instrumental in the first NCAA DI victory over South Carolina State with 14 points ... During a seven-game road stretch in December, Jones registered double-digit point performances against Cincinnati (13), College of Charleston (11), South Carolina State (14) and UNC Asheville (13). She finished her collegiate career in the same fashion, with double figures against USC Aiken (21), Converse College (23) and Longwood (13) ... Freshman **KATLIN MOORE** broke into the starting lineup for the Lady Blue Hose just four games into the 2007-08 season. She held the team lead in points for most of the season before a late surge by Amy Jones allowed her to take the title. Moore finished with 12 double-figure games on the season. Moore had three stretches in which she reached double-figure point totals, the first of which came in games against Georgia Southern (11), Stetson (19) and Radford (10) from Dec. 20-28.

RADFORD

Radford closed out their home schedule in style on Saturday with a hard fought 67-54 victory over Winthrop on Senior Day. Seniors **KELLI DARDEN** and **CORRIE FERTITTA** combined for 32 points in their final contest in the Dedmon Center, while clinching second place in the Conference. Darden also recorded her eighth double-double with 13 rebounds. For the second straight season, RU finished 12-2 at home and has won 27 of its last 31 home games. Milestones as well as chart movers were the norm for the week. As a team, Radford won 20 regular season game for only the second time in school history (1987-88) as well as registering back-to-back 20-win seasons since 1986-87 & 1987-88. A win next Friday would tie the 1987-88 team for most regular season wins with 22. The team also is one steal (384) from the second most in school history. Along with the team, a few individuals moved up the charts. Darden's 13 boards moved her into seventh on the career list with 739. She also had five blocks to tie her own Big South and RU single-season record of 85. Fertitta jumped from 10th to seventh on the career scoring list with 1,172 points. She moved into a tie for fifth on the Big South rebounding list with 878 and is now third on the three-pointer list with 111. **JOHNETTE WALKER** moved into second on RU's career steals list with 252 and fourth on the single-season chart with 91. She also surpassed the 400-assist plateau, making her just the second Highlander to amass 400 assists and 250 steals in a career. **STEPHANIE HOWARD** (1985-89) finished her career with 661 assists and 377 steals. It also brought her season total to 144, tying a career best and tying herself for the fifth most in a single season. Also, she jumped into third with 136 free throws this year. She is just 12 makes away from setting a new RU record.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville lost its final three games of the regular season and will finish the regular season at Winthrop on Wednesday night. Chioma Okoli scored 18 points against Radford on Tuesday night while **ASHTON BARTON** moved into ninth place on Asheville's all-time scoring list with 15 points against Liberty on Saturday. Barton now has 1,109 career points. **STACY SHEPARD** has set a new division I school record for most rebounds in a single season with 285 rebounds. She is attempting to become the first Asheville player since the school went D1 in 1986 to finish the season with double figure rebounds per game.

WINTHROP

Winthrop had a historic week as it defeated Liberty, ranked 27th at the time for its biggest win in school history. It was the highest ranked team Winthrop had ever defeated and it also ended a 25-game losing streak against the Flames. The win also meant the Eagles would finish with a conference record above .500 for the first time in school history. It also tied the school record for the most wins in a single season at 19. **ASHLEY FANN** scored 22 points in the loss at Radford and moved into 9th on Winthrop's all-time scoring list with 1,140. She is now just seven points out of 8th. She also pulled down 11 rebounds and moved into 11th, just eight rebounds from 10th. Junior point guard **YVONNE VAN DAALEN** is having her finest year as an Eagle and is coming off a nine assist, two turnover game at Radford on Saturday. She now has 141 assists on the season, which is the fourth highest total in a single season ever at Winthrop. She also has 270 career assists and has moved into the school's all-time leaders at 10th.
