The Lady Flames picked up the No. 12 seed in the 2008 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship and will take on No. 5 Old Dominion on Sunday, March 23 at 7:00pm. The game will be aired live on ESPN2 ... Liberty looks to repeat the magic of the 2005 tournament when it made a run to the "sweet 16" as a No. 13 seed. In the 2005 tournament, the Lady Flames downed #4 Penn State and #5 DePaul before falling to #1 LSU ... This year's trip to the NAAs is the Lady Flames 10th overall.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

Liberty has been receiving votes all season in the national polls. The Lady Flames picked up their highest vote total in the week 19 poll as the coaches ranked them No. 26 in the nation.

WOMEN'S NIT IN THE COMMONWEALTH

Radford will stay in Virginia to play its Women's NIT games. The Highlanders drew James Madison for their first round game and will take on the Dukes Thursday, March 20 at JMU at 7:00pm ... Radford's 23 wins this season is the second-most in school history ... The Highlanders will be playing in the post season for the first time since 1996, their fifth post season appearance overall.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Junior **PAM TOLBERT'S** 501 points this season ranks fifth in program history for a single-season ... She is eighth all-time with 1129 points in her career ... She set a school record with 217 three-pointers attempted this season, vaulting her into first all-time with 462 attempts in her career ... Her 73 three-pointers made this season is the second-highest total in program history ... She now ranks first with 151 three-pointers made in her career ... Her 443 field goal attempts this season is the second-highest in program history ... Career total of 1081 field goal attempts ranks seventh all-time ... Her 168 made field goals was the fifth highest single-season total and she now ranks eighth all-time with 400 field goals made in her career ... She also ranks seventh in all-time assists (290) and eighth in career steals (167) ... Senior **SHAUNTE SMALL** had 48 blocks this season, the third highest total in school history ... She has the top two totals, as well, giving her a program record 182 rejections in her career ... she is currently fifth all-time in the Big South in career blocks ... Her 110 games played is tied for fourth all-time ... Senior **NATALIE CALDWELL** moved into 10th place on the all-time three-pointers attempted list with 218 in her career ... Freshman **KATIE TULL'S** 158 three-pointers attempted this season ranks sixth all-time ... The Lady Bucs set a team record with 580 three-pointers attempted ... Fell two shy of tying the school record for three-pointers made, sinking 169 on the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell in the quarterfinals of the 2008 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championships 62-51 to High Point... **LACEY LYONS** set the Coastal sophomore record for three-point field goals in a season with 71. She also set the freshman record (44)... High Point knocked off the Lady Chanticleers for the third time in the last four years... **VICKY BLANCHARD**, an All-Big South Second Team selection, scored 11 points in the game against High Point, while **SYDNEI MOSS**, a Big South All-Freshman Team member, added 10... **C.J. WARE** ended her four year career at Coastal by scoring eight points. Coastal has now won 52 games in the last three seasons.

HIGH POINT

High Point finished the 2007-2008 season with a 15-15 overall record and went 6-6 in the Big South. High Point had three freshmen pick up conference honors at the Big South Women's Basketball Tournament banquet. **MACKENZIE MAIER** was named the 2008 Big South Freshman of the Year, earning a spot on the All-Freshman team as well as being named Second Team All-Conference. **JURICA HARGRAVES** and **FRANCES FIELDS** were both also named to the All-Freshman team. In the tournament the #4 seeded Panthers defeated #5 Coastal Carolina in the opening round before falling to #1 Liberty in the semi-finals. Hargraves was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 17.5 points. She shot 52.9-percent from the arc during the tournament, knocking down 9-of-17 including six against Liberty.

LIBERTY

One of the finest seasons in Liberty women's basketball history came to a close on March 23, when the No. 12 seed Lady Flames were defeated by No. 5 seed Old Dominion, 82-62, in the first round of the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship ... Liberty finished 28-4, tying the program and Big South records for most victories in a season ... The Lady Flames also won their 11th Big South title in the past 12 seasons ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** was recognized as the Richmond Times-Dispatch State Women's Basketball Player of the Year, becoming the first Lady Flame since **KATIE FEENSTRA** in 2004 to earn the honor ... Frazee set a Liberty single-season free throw percentage record (.878) and ranks No. 3 for points (595) and No. 5 for rebounds (303) on the Lady Flames' all-time single-season lists ... As a team, Liberty set program single-season records for both field goal percentage (.459) and free throw percentage (.728) ... The Lady Flames will graduate three seniors—**ALLYSON FANSACHT**, **EGLE SMIGELSKAITE** and **COURTNEY WATKINS** ... The trio went 98-29 during its four years at Liberty, which featured three Big South championships and a trip to the "Sweet 16" in 2005.

PRESBYTERIAN

Senior guard **AMY JONES** scored 13 points, while teammates **BRIDGET TAKACH** and **Sharie Hopkins** added 10 points each in Presbyterian College's 73-58 loss to Longwood ... The loss to Longwood ends PC's first year in NCAA Division I women's basketball with PC owning a 2-24 record ... Presbyterian College senior point guard Jones finished the season by leading the team in five statistical categories. Jones, who appeared in all 26 games this season, led the team in minutes played (862), assists (89), steals (54), points (261) and point per game average (10.0). She guided the Lady Blue Hose through their first season of Division I competition, instrumental in the first NCAA DI victory over South Carolina State with 14 points ... During a seven-game road stretch in December, Jones registered double-digit point performances against Cincinnati (13), College of Charleston (11), South Carolina State (14) and UNC Asheville (13). She finished her collegiate career in the same fashion, with double figures against USC Aiken (21), Converse College (23) and Longwood (13) ... Freshman **KATLIN MOORE** broke into the starting lineup for the Lady Blue Hose just four games into the 2007-08 season. She held the team lead in points for most of the season before a late surge by Amy Jones allowed her to take the title. Moore finished with 12 double-figure games on the season. Moore had three stretches in which she reached double-figure point totals, the first of which came in games against Georgia Southern (11), Stetson (19) and Radford (10) from Dec. 20-28.

RADFORD

Radford concluded one of its best seasons in recent history. The Highlanders won the second most games in school history, won 20 regular season games and recorded back-to-back 20-win seasons for just the second time in school history. RU reached the Big South Championship Game for the second straight season and a conference record 12th time. They also made their first postseason appearance since 1996 and fifth overall. They also recorded their second straight 12-2 home record and have won 27 of their last 31 home contest. As a team, RU set new records for blocks, free throws made and attempted and defensive rebounds. They also registered the second most steals in a RU single season. Individually **KELLI DARDEN**, **CORRIE FERTITTA** and **JOHNETTE WALKER** moved up the career charts. Darden and Fertitta, who both played in a school record 122 games, finished fifth and sixth respectively in scoring. Darden leaves as the Big South's all-time shot blocker. She also finished fifth in free throws made, sixth in rebounds and 10th in field goals made. Fertitta ended her career as the RU's third and the Big South's fourth best rebounder. At RU, she finished fourth in blocks, fourth in three-point field goals and ninth in steals. Walker ends her junior season, ranked second in steals, third in assists, third in free throws made, 22nd in scoring and 24th in rebounding. This season also had several single season top fives. Darden set a new Big South and RU block record with 98. Walker hit a school record 152 free throws. Walker finished second (106) and **TALEIA MOTON** tied for fifth (88) in steals. Walker's 80.4 free throw percentage was third best and Fertitta's 39.3 three point percentage was fifth best in a single season. Walker also tied for the third highest assists total with 162. **JERI PORTER** also reached her 150th career win this season as well as posting a record 23 victories as a head coach.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finished the season with a 72-64 double overtime loss to Radford in the Big South quarterfinals. **JESSICA MONROE** posted her second career double-double with 16 points and ties her career high with 10 rebounds. Freshman **ARESCIA MOORE** had a solid outing with 10 points and six rebounds. Her best two games of the season have come against the Highlanders, she had 11 points and 10 rebounds at RU on Feb. 2. **STACY SHEPARD** ended her career with 774 career rebounds which is the second highest total at UNC Asheville since the school went division I in 1986. She finished with a DI single-season record of 298 rebounds just two boards shy of a double-figure average but she does manage to finish the season as the Big South's leading rebounder at 9.9 boards per game. **ASHTON BARTON** finished her career with 12 points and nine rebounds against Radford she scored 1,139 points for the Bulldogs which is ninth on the all-time list and sixth among those who played against DI competition. **ANA BAKER** played 49 of the 50 minutes in the loss to Radford while Kendall Shepard played 47 minutes against the Highlanders.

WINTHROP

With the first round victory against Charleston Southern on Friday, Winthrop reached the 20-win mark for the first time in school history. The previous high was 19 wins. The win also put the Eagles into the semi-finals of the tournament for the third straight season ... Junior **ASHLEY FANN** finished the season with 1176 career points and is now ranked 8th on Winthrop's all-time scoring list. She also finished with 616 career rebounds, which ranks 7th all-time ... Junior **TIFFANY RODD** was able to reach the mark of 201 career three-pointers before the season came to an end. She is now third all-time in Big South history for three-pointers made, just two back from **KYLIE WILLIAMSON** of Radford and 38 back from **NIKKI REDDICK** of Coastal Carolina, the all-time leader.

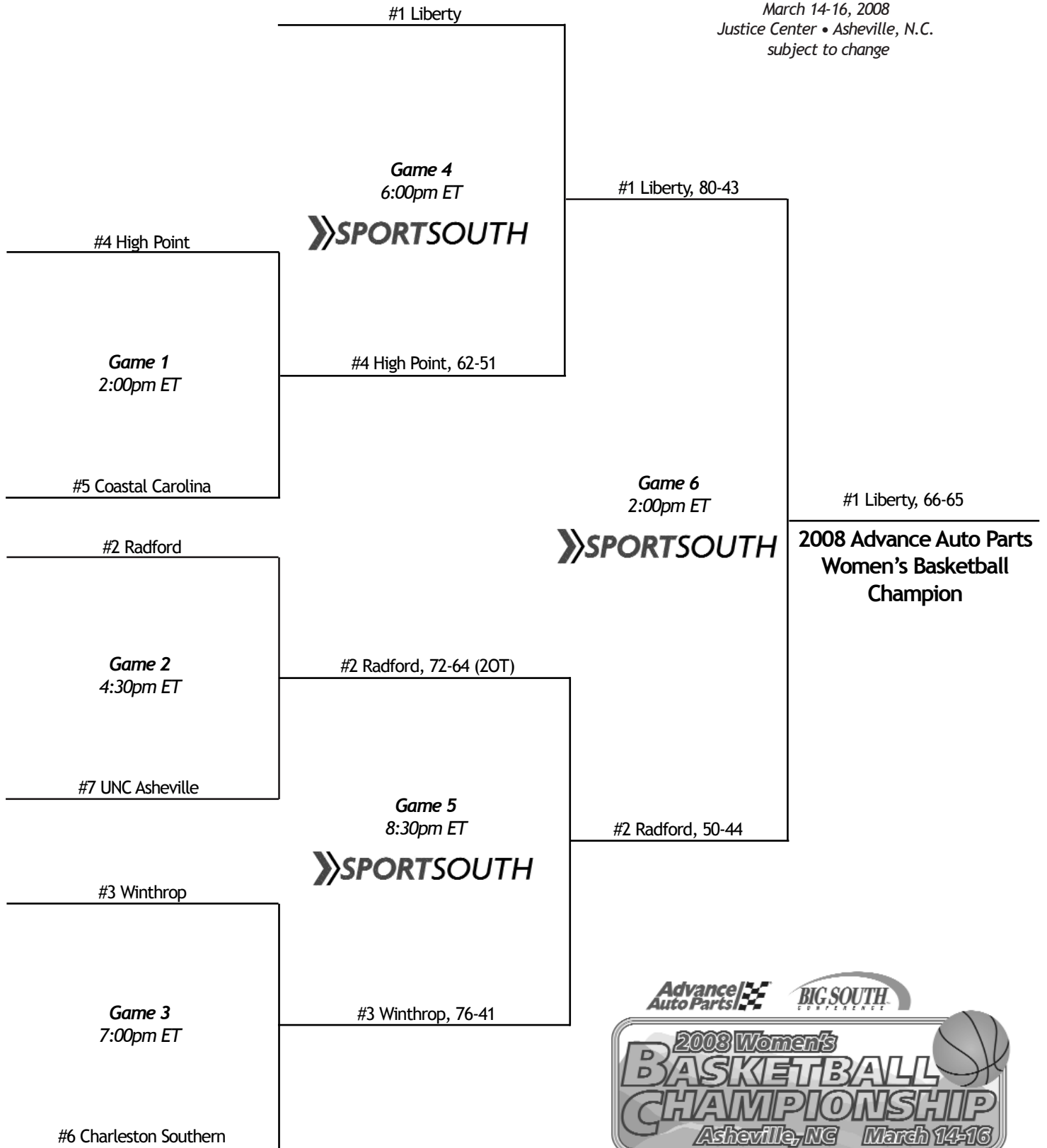
