Frazee shot 65 percent from the floor and averaged 21 points per game to lead the Lady Flames to a 2-0 record on the week, including a Big South win. She got her week started with 18 points on 7-of-11 from the floor, 3-of-4 from the line and one from downtown on Jan. 15 against George Mason. She also pulled down seven boards and came away with four assists, three steals and one block in the win over the Patriots. Four days later at Charleston Southern, Frazee shot 67 percent from the floor on 8-of-12 shooting and was perfect from the charity stripe as she connected on all seven of her tries and added one from three-point land to finish with 24 points in the win over the Lady Bucs. She also corralled nine boards and posted three assists and three steals in the win for Liberty. For the week, she was 91 percent at the line on 10-of-11 shooting. The honor marks her third Player of the Week nod this season.

IT'S A GIVE AND TAKE SORT OF THING

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** is enjoying a solid year on the hardwood for Radford. She has posted two 20-point games and one 10-rebound contest as the floor general for the Highlanders. She is also more than happy to spread the wealth to her teammates this season as she is tops in the League with 4.80 assists per game. On the defensive side, Walker leads the League and ranks 16th in the country with 3.35 steals per game to key a defense that is ranked No. 7 in Division I in steals per game with 13.35... UNC Asheville's **ANA BAKER** falls into the same category as she is second in the League with 4.78 helpers and second in the Big South with 2.78 take-aways per contest.

YOUNG GUN

In only her sophomore year **LACEY LYONS** of Coastal Carolina has established herself as one of the top scoring threats in the Big South. She has posted one 30-point game and one 20-point game this season and ranks No. 5 in the in nation and is tops in the Big South with 2.93 three-pointers made per game. Her 42 percent from beyond the arc ranks No. 3 in the League.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

The Big South has had two players finish with 30-or-more points in a single game this season. **PAM TOLBERT** of Charleston Southern was the first player to score 30-or-more as she put in 33 points against USC-Upstate on Nov. 16 ... **LACEY LYONS** from Coastal Carolina matched the season-high with 33 points against Alabama State on Dec. 20.

SCORING FRAZEE

The Liberty triplets, **MEGAN**, **MORIAH** and **MOLLY**, are one of just two sets of triplets playing in Division I. The Lady Flames are 15-2 this season thanks in large part to the Frazee's. Megan currently leads all Liberty players and is ranked first in the League with 17.8 points per game. Moriah is second on the LU squad and seventh in the Big South with 12.3 points per game. Molly is fourth on the team with 7.6 points per outing. Together the sisters are averaging 37.7 of Liberty's League-leading 71.0 points per game.

Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 200 career wins at Liberty and is the nation's 12th winningest coach. He is also on top in Conference games with 102 victories. Also moving up in the overall win category is Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LeFORCE** and **TOOEY LOY** of High Point. LeForce is currently third all-time with 154 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers. Loy has 109 wins at High Point and is currently sixth all-time in League history. UNC Asheville's **BETSY BLOSE** is 9th all-time with 85 wins while at Asheville.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

With its win over Presbyterian, CSU matched its longest winning streak of the season at two games ... Senior **SHAUNTE SMALL** is eight blocks away from tying for fifth place all-time in Big South career blocks ... Freshman **CRYSTAL ROBINSON** posted the first back-to-back double digit scoring efforts of her career, getting 11 against Presbyterian and 16 versus Liberty, both of which set career highs ... Freshman **DYNASTY GREENE** played a career-high 13 minutes against Liberty, matching her career bests in both points (4) and rebounds (3) ... Junior **PAM TOLBERT** tied her own CSU all-time record with seven made three-pointers against Presbyterian on her way to 27 points, the fourth time she has scored over 25 points this season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal allowed the second-lowest point total in school history in their 53-28 win over Savannah State Jan. 15. Savannah State shot just 22.7 percent from the field, including 11.8 percent in the second half, and were 2-of-15 from three-point range. The all-time program record for the fewest points by an opponent was 23 by Coker in 1982-83 ... Coastal was three minutes away from breaking an NCAA record for fewest points allowed in a half. The Lady Chanticleers gave up seven points in the second half of their 53-28 win over the Lady Tigers. Coastal had allowed only two points until Amber West hit two free throws with 3:08 left. The NCAA record for fewest points in a half belongs to Savannah State, as the Lady Tigers had three points in a half in a loss to Florida State in 2003 ... Coastal is now 14-9 all-time in Big South openers ... **DEVIN RIVERS** averaged 10 points in the two games this past week, including a career high 13 points against Savannah State... Coastal hosts Liberty Monday night and is at UNC Asheville Saturday afternoon. That game will be televised on SportSouth.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers opened Big South play this week with a win over defending tournament champions, UNC Asheville. High Point will face Winthrop and Radford this week.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 82-53 win at Charleston Southern on Saturday was the 200th of head coach **CAREY GREEN**'s career ... He is 200-66 in his ninth season at Liberty ... The Lady Flames have opened Big South Conference play with a victory eight-straight times ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** moved to No. 9 on Liberty's all-time scoring list, with 1,094 points ... Liberty is 14-2 in non-conference games, Liberty's best non-conference mark since going 14-1 in 1997-98 ... The Lady Flames are now 45-0 under Green's direction when shooting 50 percent or better from the field, after shooting 53.4 percent in the victory at Charleston Southern ... Liberty has held 36-consecutive opponents below 50 percent from the floor ... Liberty earned a season-high 11 votes in the most recent ESPN/USA Today Coaches Top 25 Poll, released Jan. 14.

PRESBYTERIAN

Freshman guard **KATLIN MOORE** scored a game-high 14 points, however Presbyterian College fell short of Winthrop in a 66-48 loss. Moore led the way, finishing the game by hitting 6-of-16 from the field and 1-of-2 from beyond the arc. She also forced two steals and grabbed three rebounds. Teammate **TAYLOR PRICE** led PC on the boards with seven rebounds, while **SHARIE HOPKINS** scored six points and added three boards. **AMY JONES** had three steals in the contest ... PC is playing its seventh Big South opponent of the season next weekend in Liberty. The Lady Blue Hose are currently 0-6 against their future conference opponents as they have fallen twice to both UNC Asheville and Radford. The most recent losses came to Charleston Southern and Winthrop ... PC freshman guard Moore remains on top of the team's scoring list, following her five points against Winthrop. Moore now has 204 points on the season and is averaging 9.7 points per game ... Over the last 11 games senior guard **BRIDGET TAKACH** has hit 51.4 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. Beginning with the home game at East Carolina on Dec. 18, Takach has hit 18-of-35 three-point attempts. Takach shot 4-of-5 from three-point range against Charleston Southern. She did not attempt a 3-pointer against Winthrop ... The Blue Hose have played 16 road games in its first 20 games and after tilts with Charleston Southern and Winthrop PC will have traveled 6,434 miles ... Senior guard Takach scored 16 points and teammate **LEA SMITH** added 13 points, but it was not enough as Presbyterian College fell to future Big South Conference opponent Charleston Southern 81-56 on Wednesday evening at the CSU Fieldhouse. Takach finished the game by hitting 4-of-5 from three-point range. She also dished out two assists and forced two steals. Smith was 6-of-11 from the field. She shared the team-high in rebounds with Hopkins with seven boards.

RADFORD

Radford is off to its best start under **JERI PORTER** and its best start since 1988-89 (16-4). The 14-6 start is tied for the fourth best after 20 games in school history. The Highs have started 16-4 twice, 15-5 once and 14-6 four times. Coming off its last four losses, Radford's defense has rebounded in a big way. For the fourth time this season, the Highlanders held their opponent to under 55 points after a loss. In the four losses, RU's opponents averaged 68.3 ppg and shot 46.3 percent from the field. In the following game, RU held its opponent to 45.8 ppg and 32.8 percent from the field. **KELLI DARDEN** became the 17th Highlander, the second the season, to reach the 1,000-point plateau. Fellow senior Corrie Fertitta scored her 1,000th point at American on Dec. 22. **CORRIE FERTITTA** tied a school record, going a perfect 4-4 from three-point land at Longwood. Only two other Highlanders have done this. **LORI MITCHELL** was the last Highlander to go 4-for-4 on Dec. 5, 1997. **STEPHANE HOWARD** was the first to do it on Jan. 23, 1989. Fertitta also moved into eighth on the Big South all-time rebounding list with 816.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville dropped its only game of the week 81-70 to High Point despite 21 points from senior guard **ASHTON BARTON**. **ARESCIA MOORE** set a new career high with 12 points and **KENDALL SHEPARD** matched her career best of 12 points in the game. Asheville head coach **BETSY BLOSE** will make her second try for her 200th career victory when the Bulldogs host Coastal Carolina on Saturday. The game is set for 1 p.m. and will be broadcast live on FSN South.

WINTHROP

Winthrop improved to 7-1 at home after defeating Presbyterian on Saturday. With six home games remaining the team is just two wins short of tying the Winthrop record at the Division I level with 9 home wins. The Eagles are four short of tying the school record of 11 home wins. **FRANCHESCA DAVENPORT** helped the Eagles to a 2-0 record on the week by being a stat box filler. She averaged 7.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists, 2.5 steals and 2.5 blocks per game. She had a career-best four blocks in the win over USC Upstate. The Eagles are 12-6 on the season and looking to finish above .500 for the first time since becoming a member of the NCAA Division I. Coach Childers led his young squad two years ago to a 14-15 record and the 14 victories tied a school Division I record for total wins. Defense has been a key to the Eagles success this season and they ranked among the top 10 nationally in defensive field goal percentage. Last Wednesday after a close first half with USC Upstate, the defense clamped down and held the Spartans to just one second half field (1-for-20).
