ROLL'N RIGHT ALONG

The Big South Conference is off to a good start against non-conference foes this season. As a League the Big South is 59-41 against other conferences ... The Big South is 4-2 against Conference USA and owns a 9-7 record over region-rival the Southern Conference.

The Big South has experienced some big wins so far in the 2007-08 season. Here is a look at some of the notable wins from across the League:

IT'S A GIVE AND TAKE SORT OF THING Radford's JOHNETTE WALKER is enjoying a solid year on the hardwood for Radford. She has posted one 20-point game and one 10-rebound contest as the floor general for the Highlanders. She is also more than happy to spread the wealth to her teammates this season as she is second in the League with 4.41 assists per game. On the defensive side, Walker leads the League and ranks 17th in the coutnry with 3.29 steals per game to key a defense that is ranked No. 5 in Division I in steals per game with 13.6 ... UNC Asheville's ANA BAKER falls into the same category as she is tops in the League with 4.94 helpers and second in the Big South with 3.00 take-aways per contest.

In only her sophomore year LACEY LYONS of Coastal Carolina has established herself as one of the top scoring threats in the Big South. She has posted one 30-point game and one 20-point game this season and ranks No. 4 in the in nation and is tops in the Big South with 3.33 three-pointers made per game. Her 43 percent from beyond the arc ranks No. 2 in the League.

The Big South has had two players finish with 30-or-more points in a single game this season. **PAM TOLBERT** of Charleston Southern was the first player to score 30-or-more as she put in 33 points against USC-Upstate on Nov. 16 ... **LACEY LYONS** from Coastal Carolina matched the season-high with 33 points against Alabama State on Dec.

SCORING FRAZEE

The Liberty triplets, MEGAN, MORIAH and MOLLY, are one of just two sets of triplets playing in Division I. The Lady Flames are 12-2 this season thanks in large part to the Frazee's. Megan currently leads all Liberty players and is ranked first in the League with 17.1 points per game. Moriah is second on the LU squad and seventh in the Big South with 12.6 points per game. Molly is fourth on the team with 7.5 points per outing. Together the sisters are averaging 37.2 of Liberty's League-leading 70.9 points per game.

Loy has 107 wins at High Point and is currently sixth all-time in League history. UNC Asheville's BETSY BLOSE is tied for 9th all-time with 84 wins while at Asheville.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Freshman Crystal Robinson set a career high with four steals against Miami ... With 14 field goal attempts, freshman KATIE TULL matched her career high ... Junior PAM TOLBERT posted her third 20-point game of the season, recording 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting against Miami ... Sophomore TINA DECARVALHO's pair of assists against the Hurricanes was a season high.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal opened the 2008 portion of its schedule with an 86-47 win over Coker Jan. 3 ... LACEY LYONS had a game high 19 points with 5-of-8 shooting from three-point range. VICKY BLANCHARD had a double of the standard of the ble-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds. It was Blanchard's third-career double-double... Coastal set ble-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds. It was Blanchards third-career double-double... Coastal set season highs in assists, field goal percentage and three-point field goal percentage in the win over the Cobras ... Coastal is looking for its 10th win in the game against Morris. If the Lady Chanticleers win, they would match the 1982-83 team as the fastest squad to 10 wins in a season. That team started 10-3 and finished the year with a 21-9 record ... Sophomore Lyons is third in the country in three-point field goals per game in the latest NCAA stats out Jan. 3. Lyons is averaging 3.3 three-pointers per game. She is 40-of-94 for the year, good for 42.6 percent. Sade Logan of Robert Morris is the nation's leader at 3.9 three's a contest... Coastal hosts Morris this Monday and is at Savannah State next Tuesday before opening Big South play.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers went 1-1 on the week, falling to future Big South team, Gardner-Webb and picking up a win over North Carolina Central. HPU will enjoy a week off from games as the new semester gets started and will face Presbyterian on Saturday at 3 p.m.

Liberty defeated Richmond in a defensive struggle on Saturday, 45-38 ... The Lady Flames' point total was the least points they had scored in a victory since claiming a 36-32 decision over Radford on Jan. 27, 2001 ... Liberty held Richmond to a season-low 25 percent from the field, the eighth time this season the Lady Flames have held their opponent below 35 percent ... The Lady Flames are No. 15 nationally in field goal percentage defense (.336).

PRESBYTERIAN
Freshman KATLIN MOORE led four PC players in double figures with 15 points in Presbyterian College's 68-64 loss to Big South Conference foe UNC Asheville at the Templeton Center on Saturday afternoon ... Moore knotted the game at 64-64 with 2:18, hitting a jumper that banked off the glass ... PC's LEA SMITH had 12 points in the loss. BRIDGET TAKACH scored 11 points in the game for PC and sophomore center Taylor Price added 10 points for the Lady Blue Hose ... Freshman CHELSEA WRIGHT led PC with 11 rebounds, including seven on the offensive glass. Smith pulled down nine in the contest ... Freshman Moore led all PC scorers with 15 points in a 93-49 Presbyterian College loss to seventh-ranked Georgia at Stegeman Coliseum on Wednesday evening ... Takach scored nine for the Lady Blue Hose in the loss, while Lea Smith added eight points for the PC in the contest ... Moore hit 4-of-8 shots from the floor and grabbed four rebounds. Takach led the team with two three-pointers, while also sharing a teamhigh two steals in the contest ... In each of the last two games the Blue Hose have shot 40 percent in the first half. Against UNC Asheville last Saturday, PC converted 13-of-27 (48.1 percent) of their field goals in the first half. In the loss at seventh- ranked Georgia, PC converted 11-of-27 (40.7 percent) of their field goals in the first half ... Over the last seven games senior guard Takach has hit 44 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. Beginning with the home game at East Carolina on Dec. 18, Takach has hit 12-of-27 three-point attempts. Takach was a perfect 4-of-4 from three-point range against ECU.

RADFORD

Radford has won seven of its last eight games and nine of 11 ... JOHNETTE WALKER moved into fourth at RU in career assists vs. Virginia Intermont (329) and is three steals (217) from fourth ... CORRIE FERTITTA notched her seventh double-double of the season vs. Virginia Intermont, recording her 11 points and 10 rebounds in the first half. She is now just three boards from becoming just the fourth Highlander to reach 800 rebounds ... This season, the Highs have held opponents to under 60 points 10 times and under 50 in four of the last five games, and six times this season. They have also held opponents to below 40 percent shooting in 11 games and under 30 percent four times, including three of the last four games. RU has forced 21+ turnovers in 14 of 17 games with a season best 31 vs. Towson and USC Upstate. They have also forced 29 on four other occasions. One of RU's strengths the past two seasons has been getting to the free throw line ... Through 17 games this year, the Highlanders are averaging 24.5 attempts, 8.5 more than their opponents. They have attempted more freebees in 14 of 17 games with a season high 39 vs. USC Upstate.

UNC ASHEVILLE
UNC Asheville ended a three-game losing streak with a 68-64 victory at Presbyterian on Saturday. The
Bulldogs played without its leading scorer ASHTON BARTON and LINDSEY MONTGOMERY ... JESSICA
MONROE picked up the scoring for Asheville recording the first double-double of her career with 15
points and a career-high 10 rebounds. Monroe posted double-figure points in both games for this week
for the Dogs ... KENDALL SHEPARD played 39 minutes at PC and recorded a new career-high with 12
points including the final two free throws that iced the game for Asheville. The Bulldogs win at PC ended
a six-game road losing streak, the last road win prior to Saturday was a 77-70 victory at UNC Greensboro
on Nov. 24. The win was the Dogs first win outside the state of North Carolina since winning at Liberty
on Feb. 24, 2007 ... BETSY BLOSE earned her 84th victory at Asheville tying her for 9th place on the
Big South coaching victories list. It was also the 198th victory of her career.

Winthrop has dropped three straight for the first time this season and also allowed 82 points at Charlotte on Saturday. The last time Winthrop allowed 80 or more points was Nov. 28, 2006 at Appalachian State (84). Winthrop was allowing just 57.6 ppg heading into the Charlotte game ... Junior ASHLEY FANN, who was whistled for three fouls in the first minute and 55 seconds of the first half at Charlotte, was forced to miss the remainder of the first half. She was 1-for-2 with a three-pointer made before having to leave. Fann returned in the second half and scored 13 points on 6 of 9 shooting and pulled down six rebounds in 15 minutes. In her pursuit of 1,000 points, Fann now has 916 for her career. She is now just 12 rebounds away from 500.
