OFF TO A GOOD START

The Big South Conference is off to a good start against non-conference foes this season. As a League the Big South is 41-25 against other conferences ... The Big South is 4-2 against Conference USA and owns an 8-5 record over region-rival the Southern Conference.

BIG WINS!!!

The Big South has experienced some big wins so far in the 2007-08 season. Here is a look at some of the notable wins from across the League:

SHAKE AND BAKE

UNC Asheville's **ANA BAKER** doesn't mind spreading the wealth to her teammates. Baker has had two 10-plus assist games this season and leads the League with 58 total helpers and is 18th in the country with 5.80 assists per game. Baker also is no stranger to scoring as she is second on the Asheville roster with 10.7 points per contest. Defensively, Baker is 7th in Division I with 3.9 steals per game.

SCORING FRA7FF

The Liberty triplets, MEGAN, MORIAH and MOLLY, are one of just two sets of triplets playing in Division I. The Lady Flames are 9-1 this season thanks in large part to the Frazee's. Megan currently leads all Liberty players and is ranked second in the League with 16.9 points per game. Moriah is second on the LU squad and fourth in the Big South with 13.2 points per game. Molly is fourth on the team with 7.5 points per outing. Together the sisters are averaging 37.6 of Liberty's League-leading 74.2 points per game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs shot a season-high 40 percent as a team from three-point range against Clemson ... Had a season-high 31 defensive rebounds against Clemson ... Senior NATALIE CALDWELL tied her season high with five assists versus Clemson ... Freshman DYNASTY GREENE tied her career high with three rebounds against Clemson ... Freshman KATIE TULL played a season-high 40 minutes, recording a season-high 13 field goals, including 10 three-pointers. She also tied her season high with 12 points ... Freshman LYDIA JOHNSON played a season-high 11 minutes against Clemson ... Junior PAM TOLBERT logged 40 minutes against Clemson, the second time this season she has reached the mark.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal returns from taking final exams and will play two games in the Conway/Myrtle Beach area this week ... Coastal hosts third-ranked North Carolina Monday night at Kimbel Arena. Coastal then heads to the Myrtle Beach Convention Center to face Alabama State Thursday night at 5 p.m ... This will be the second straight season North Carolina and Coastal will meet in Horry County. Last year, the Tar Heels and Lady Chants played in the Myrtle Beach Convention Center ... LACEY LYONS scored 19 points in the loss to UNC last season, including hitting five three-pointers ... After the two games this week, Coastal will not get back on the court until Jan. 3.

HIGH POINT

High Point is looking to snap a two game losing streak by picking up a win on Monday night against its oldest rival, Elon. The Panthers and the Phoenix have met 72 times since their first meeting on Feb. 3, 1972. Both teams have 36 wins each in the all-time series. Following Monday's game, the Panthers will go on a break for the holidays before returning to the court on Dec. 29-30 at St. Peter's College Tournament in Jersey City, N.J.

LIBERTY

At 9-1, Liberty is off to the second-best start in program history. Only the 1997-98 Lady Flames, which started out 28-0, had previously won nine of their first 10 games. ... Junior **MEGAN FRAZEE** is nearing a pair of milestones. She needs 39 points to reach 1,000 for her career and is 16 rebounds away from 500. ... Frazee would become the sixth player in program history with over 1,000 points and 500 boards. ... Liberty, currently on a seven-game winning streak, received one vote in the AP Top 25 Poll last week, for the first time this season. ... The Lady Flames have made a three-pointer in 81 straight games, dating back to Feb. 26, 2005. The current school record is 82 straight contests, a streak which spanned Jan. 24, 1998 and Dec. 20, 2000.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC fell 93-26 in its only game last week ... The Lady Blue Hose welcome 2006-07 Conference USA champion East Carolina to the Templeton Center for its second game home game of the season. The two teams met in the opening weekend of the season in Greenville, N.C. with the Pirates taking a 97-52 win over the Lady Blue Hose ... Sharie Hopkins and Bridget Takach finished in double figures for PC in their loss to ECU earlier this year. Both Hopkins and Takach had a team-high 11 points against ECU. aylor Price had a team-high seven rebounds in the game for the Lady Blue Hose ... PC has logged quite a few miles since the beginning of its inaugural NCAA Division I campaign in early November. The Blue Hose have played nine road games in its first 10 games and after its tilt with West Virgina PC has traveled 3,922 miles. The trip to Morgantown, W.Va. was the longest road trip of the year for the Lady Blue Hose at 969.2 miles from Clinton to Morgantown.

RADFORD

Radford's win at Wake Forest snapped the Demon Deacon's seven-game winning streak (longest in the ACC) ... Wake Forest was 28th in the AP and 35th in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. It also marked the second straight win against an ACC school. Last season, the Highlanders opened the season with a 67-60 victory at Virginia Tech. Senior KELLI DARDEN and freshman TALEIA MOTON recorded double-doubles at Wake Forest. It marked the fourth time this season that two Highlanders notched double-doubles in the same game ... When Radford hosts ETSU on Thursday it will be just the third home game of the season ... On Saturday, the Highlanders will head to American for their ninth game away from home in their first 12 games of the season. When RU returns from Christmas break, it will play five straight home games in a nine-day span. The homestand starts of with the frist ever Highlander Christmas Classic on Dec. 28 & 29. Radford will welcome future Big South foe Presbyterian, along with Kent State and UNC Wilmington for the two-day tourney.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs won their only game of te week 68-55 over Campbell. KYLA JONES led four players in double-figures with a team high 13 points. JESSICA MONROE added 12 points while ASHTON BARTON had 11 points. STACY SHEPARD recorded her second straight double-double with 10 points and 13 rebounds ... Asheville is 5-1 at home this season and have won two straight overall ... This week the Dogs will travel to Gardner-Webb on Monday before hosting Mercer on Friday in their last action before Christmas.

WINTHROP

After taking some time off for exams, the Eagles will be back in action with two games this week. Winthrop will host Georgia State on Dec. 17 at 7:00pm, and will travel to Wichita State on Dec. 20 for an 8:00pm tip.
