Fann averaged 24 points and 11 rebounds per game to lead Winthrop to two Big South wins last week. She got her week started with a 23-point, 10-rebound double-double in Winthrop's win at High Point, adding two assists and one steal in the contest. Three days later against Charleston Southern, Fann shot 64 percent from the floor as she connected on 9-of-14 shots and added a perfect 6-for-6 at the line and one from downtown to finish with 25 points. She also chipped in nine rebounds and two assists in the win over the Lady Bucs. Her 48 total points on the week put her into the Big South's 1,000-point club as she now has 1,003 points for her career.

The Winthrop Eagles are having a break year mid-way through the season. Right now Winthrop is on a six-game winning streak, marking just the second time Winthrop has won six-straight since moving to Division I. The Eagles are 2-0 in League play for the second time since the 2005-06 season.

NOT IN OUR HOUSE!!!

The Big South has done an outstanding job of protecting the home court. Every school in the League has a winning record at home and as a whole are 42-12 when playing in their home gym. Liberty leads the way at 7-0. Radford and Winthrop are 8-1 and UNC Asheville is 8-2 at home. At home in High Point, the Panthers are 7-2, while Coastal Carolina is 7-3 in Conway. Charleston Southern rounds out the list at 5-4 in home games.

DIAPER DANDIES!!!

High Point has arguably the youngest team in the Big South. However, the Panthers have gotten alot out of their new faces thus far this season. The Panthers have earned four Big South Freshman of the Week honors this season. JURICA HARGRAVES is tied for tops on the HPU squad with 10.9 points per game has earned the honor twice this season. Teammates MACKENZIE MAIER and AMY DODD join Hargraves on the list as Freshman of the Week honorees ... Radford's TALEIA MOTON is tied for No. 1 on the squad in scoring with 11.8 points per game and has earned Freshman of the Week honors three times this season.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

The Big South has had two players finish with 30-or-more points in a single game this season. PAM TOLBERT of Charleston Southern was the first player to score 30-or-more as she put in 33 points against USC-Upstate on Nov. 16 ... LACEY LYONS from Coastal Carolina matched the season-high with 33 points against Alabama State on Dec. 20.

SCORING FRAZEE

The Liberty triplets, MEGAN, MORIAH and MOLLY, are one of just two sets of triplets playing in Division I. The Lady Flames are 15-2 this season thanks in large part to the Frazee's. Megan currently leads all Liberty players and is ranked first in the League with 17.5 points per game. Moriah is second on the LU squad and sixth in the Big South with 12.6 points per game. Molly is fourth on the team with 7.5 points per outing. Together the sisters are averaging 37.6 of Liberty's League-leading 71.9 points per game.

MOVE'N ON UP

Liberty's CAREY GREEN is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 202 career wins at Liberty and is the nation's 12th winningest coach. He is also on top in Conference games with 103 victories. Also moving up in the overall win category is Coastal Carolina's ALAN LeFORCE and TOOHEY LOY of High Point. LeForce is currently third all-time with 154 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers. Loy has 109 wins at High Point and is currently sixth all-time in League history. UNC Asheville's BETSY BLOSE is 9th all-time with 86 wins while at Asheville.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs set season highs in both points scored (86) and field goal percentage (.545) in their victory over Radford ... CSU connected on a season-high 20 free throws against the Lady Eagles ... Senior **NATALIE CALDWELL** has reached double figures in scoring in 10 games this season, recording back-to-back double digit performances this week ... Caldwell made a season-high nine trips to the charity stripe and tied her season high with 19 field goal attempts against Winthrop on her way to 19 points ... Freshman **WHITNEY WILEY** has seen double-digit minutes in the last five games ... Freshman **CRYSTAL ROBINSON** set career highs in points (24), field goals attempted (14), and field goals made (11) in the Lady Bucs victory over Radford ... it was her third straight game in double figures ... Freshman **DYNASTY GREENE** tied her season high with 13 minutes played against Radford, scoring a career high nine points in the win ... Hitting a career-high five three-pointers, freshman Katie Tull set a career-high with 15 points against Winthrop ... it was the sixth time this season she reached double figures ... Junior Pam Tolbert set a career high with 11 trips to the free throw line against Radford, making a career-high 10 of the attempts

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal received a double-double from **VICKY BLANCHARD** and a career high in points from **AMANDA STULL**, but fell to UNC Asheville 63-54 ... Coastal also started 0-3 in 2005-06 but came back to earn the number three seed in the Big South Tournament ... Blanchard has averaged 14.5 rebounds in the last two games vs. UNCA ... Coastal has had two separate three-game losing streak to go along with a seven-game and a four-game winning streak ... Coastal has two games this week, travelling to Winthrop on Wednesday and hosting Savannah State on Saturday. The Savannah State game is the "Think Pink" game supporting breast cancer awareness.

HIGH POINT

After picking up a win in their conference opener the Panthers have dropped the following two games. A bright spot is the return of freshman **MACKENZIE MAIER** who set out nine games with injury. She posted 18 points against Winthrop and followed that up with a 17 point performance at Radford. This week HPU travels to Lynchburg to face Big South rival Liberty. On Saturday the Panthers return home to host Charleston Southern.

LIBERTY

Liberty enters the week on a six-game winning streak, having won its last four games by an average of 29.5 points per game ... The Lady Flames held their two opponents this past week (Coastal Carolina and Presbyterian) to a combined 27 first-half points. Liberty has now limited foes to fewer than 20 first-half points six times this year ... Liberty is 7-0 at home and is shooting 52.4 percent from the field at the Vines Center, as opposed to 31.0 percent for the opposition ... One of the **FRAZEE** triplets has led the Lady Flames in scoring in 18 of 19 games this season (**ALLYSON FASNACHT**, at UNLV) ... Liberty is one of five teams to rank in the top 15 nationally in both field goal percentage and field goal percentage defense (also Baylor, Connecticut, North Carolina and Utah).

PRESBYTERIAN

The Lady Blue Hose meet the Phoenix of Elon for the 18th meeting between the two schools. Presbyterian College holds a 12-5 series record, including winning each of the last nine meetings between the two schools. PC prevailed 65-57 in the 1995-96 season, marking the last meeting on the hardwood ... PC has played six Big South Conference opponents following the match up with Liberty. The Lady Blue Hose are currently 0-8 against their future conference opponents. They have fallen twice to both UNC Asheville and Radford and lost to High Point, Liberty, Winthrop and Charleston Southern once ... The Lady Blue Hose have hit at least two three-point baskets in each of the last 12 games, dating back to a home contest with East Carolina (Dec. 18). PC has been successful on 34 three-pointers since that game, including four games in which they had four or more 3-pointers. Those games include: East Carolina, 5; Georgia, 4; High Point, 4; Charleston Southern, 7 ... PC freshman guard **KATLIN MOORE** remained at the top of the team's scoring list with her 11th double digit performance at Liberty. Moore, who scored 10 points against the Lady Flames now has 214 points on the season and is averaging 9.7 points per game. Moore had a career-high and team season-high tying seven assists against High Point ... Over the last 11 games senior guard **BRIDGET TAKACH** has hit 47.4 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. Beginning with the home game at East Carolina on Dec. 18, Takach has hit 18-of-38 three-point attempts. Most recently, Takach shot 4-of-5 from three-point range against Charleston Southern.

RADFORD

Radford improved to 8-1 at home this season with its victory over High Point. The Highlanders are 20-3 at the Dedmon Center the past two seasons and have won 23 of their last 26 at home. **KELLI DARDEN** had six blocks last week and is now just two blocks from becoming the Big South's all-time leader in that category. **CORRIE FERTITTA** is 12 rebounds from third all-time at Radford and seven in the Big South. Also, Darden moved into a tie for ninth on RU's board chart with 679. Against High Point, Fertitta and **JOHNETTE WALKER** reached the 1100 and 800-point plateaus.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville Head Coach **BETSY BLOSE** recorded her 200th career victory as UNC Asheville defeated Coastal Carolina 63-54 in its only action of the week ... **ASHTON BARTON** moved into 12 place on the Bulldogs' all-time scoring list with a 19 point effort. She now has 993 career points ... **KENDALL SHEPARD** scored a career-high 15 points against Coastal, she has now been in double-figures in three of the last four games ... **STACY SHEPARD** had 11 points and 14 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the year ... Asheville is 8-2 at home this season but will hit the road for two games this week. The Dogs travel to Charleston Southern on Tuesday and Radford on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** became just the fourth Eagle in school history to reach 1,000 points for a career before her senior season. Fann scored 25 points in the win over Charleston Southern on Saturday to reach 1,003 points in her career. She also reached the 500 rebound mark earlier this year and is just the 7th player in Winthrop history to reach 1,000 points and 500 rebounds ... **TIFFANY RODD** had one heck of a week. She started off by hitting the game-winning three-pointer with 11 seconds to go at High Point and then followed that up by scoring a career-high 27 points. Rodd is also trying to reach the 1,000 point mark in her career before she becomes a senior. She currently has 862 points. Winthrop improved to 2-0 in the Big South for just the second time in school history. The 2005-06 team was the only other team to start 2-0. Both teams have been under the direction of head coach **BUD CHILDERS**. His 2005-06 squad with four the Eagles improved to 14-6 on the season and the 14-wins ties the school record for wins at the NCAA Division I level. The 2005-06 set the mark with a 14-15 record. The current win streak is at six games. It is just the second time in school history that the Eagles have won six games in a row since their move to Division I. The only other time came in 1996 as the Eagles won six straight before falling in the Big South Conference Tournament championship game.
