The Conference schedule starts up on Jan. 19 with six teams playing League games ... High Point is at UNC Asheville at 2:00pm, Radford is at Coastal Carolina at 2:00pm and Liberty plays at Charleston Southern at 5:30pm.

ROLL'N RIGHT ALONG

The Big South Conference is rolling right along against non-conference foes this season. As a League the Big South is 67-43 against other conferences ... The Big South is 4-2 against Conference USA and owns a 9-8 record over region-rival the Southern Conference.

GOOD WINS!!!

The Big South has experienced some big wins so far in the 2007-08 season. Here is a look at some of the notable wins from across the League:

IT'S A GIVE AND TAKE SORT OF THING
Radford's JOHNETTE WALKER is enjoying a solid year on the hardwood for Radford. She has posted two 20-point games and one 10-rebound contest as the floor general for the Highlanders. She is also more than happy to spread the wealth to her teammates this season as she is second in the League with 4.78 assists per game. On the defensive side, Walker leads the League and ranks 14th in the coutnry with 3.50 steals per game to key a defense that is ranked No. 5 in Division I in steals per game with 13.78... UNC Asheville's ANA BAKER falls into the same category as she is tops in the League with 5.00 helpers and second in the Rig South with 2.94 take. aways per contest. ond in the Big South with 2.94 take-aways per contest.

YOUNG GUN

In only her sophomore year LACEY LYONS of Coastal Carolina has established herself as one of the top scoring threats in the Big South. She has posted one 30-point game and one 20-point game this season and ranks No. 3 in the in nation and is tops in the Big South with 3.31 three-pointers made per game. Her 42 percent from beyond the arc ranks No. 3 in the League.

CATCH ME SCORING 30

The Big South has had two players finish with 30-or-more points in a single game this season. **PAM TOLBERT** of Charleston Southern was the first player to score 30-or-more as she put in 33 points against USC-Upstate on Nov. 16 ... **LACEY LYONS** from Coastal Carolina matched the season-high with 33 points against Alabama State on Dec.

SCORING FRAZEE

The Liberty triplets, MEGAN, MORIAH and MOLLY, are one of just two sets of triplets playing in Division I. The Lady Flames are 12-2 this season thanks in large part to the Frazee's. Megan currently leads all Liberty players and is ranked first in the League with 17.3 points per game. Moriah is second on the LU squad and seventh in the Big South with 12.5 points per game. Molly is fourth on the team with 7.3 points per outing. Together the sisters are averaging 37.1 of Liberty's League-leading 70.4 points per game.

Liberty's CAREY GREEN is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 198 career wins at Liberty and is the nation's 12th winningest coach. He is also on top in Conference games with 101 victories. Also moving up in the overall win category is Coastal Carolina's ALAN LeFORCE and TOOEY LOY of High Point. LeForce is currently third all-time with 153 wins at the helm of the Lady Chanticleers. Loy has 108 wins at High Point and is currently sixth all-time in League history. UNC Asheville's BETSY BLOSE is 9th all-time with 85 wins while at Asheville.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN
Held Savannah State to 41 points, the fewest recorded by a CSU opponent this season. It was the lowest total for a Lady Buccaneer opponent since CSU held Savannah State to the same total in the 2004-05 season. ... The Lady Bucs held SSU to 25 percent shooting from the field, the lost mark for a CSU opponent since Covenant College shot 21 percent on Feb. 7, 2006. ... After not reaching double digits for a three-game stretch, senior Natalie Caldwell has scored 11 points in each of the last two games. ... Freshman WHITNEY WILEY went of 5-of-14 from the field, the most attempts of her career, for a career-high 13 points against Savannah State. She also reached a career high with six rebounds in the win. ... Freshman CRYSTAL ROBINSON went 5-of-6 from the field en route to recording 10 points against Furman, matching her season high. She pulled down a team-high 11 rebounds against Savannah State, which equaled her career high. ... With 14 points against Savannah State and 16 versus Furman, junior PAM TOLBERT has led the Lady Bucs in scoring for three consecutive games.

Coastal earns its 10th win of the season and is now 10-3. The 10th win ties the 1982-83 team for the fastest to 10 wins in a season. That squad ended the year with a 21-9 record ... The 99 points in the win over Morris were the most by Coastal since the Lady Chants scored 119 points against Southern Virginia in 2002-03 ... The 27 assists by the Lady Chants were the most this season ... Coastal also shot above 50 percent for the first time since Nov. 16, 2006 against the College of Charleston ... VICKY BLANCHARD gave CCU its third straight double-double. Coastal also had three straight double-doubles last year from Jan. 15-22. Blanchard was involved in two of the double-doubles in both years ... Coastal opens the Big South schedule this Saturday hosting Radford at 2 p.m.

High Point defeated future Big South foe Presbyterian this past week following a week off. The Panthers will have another week off to prepare for the start of conference play on Saturday at UNC Asheville.

LIBERTY
Liberty is now 13-2, the Lady Flames' second-best start in school history, behind the 1997-98 squad, which opened the year with 28-straight wins ... Head coach CAREY GREEN opens the week needing two victories to join the career 200-win club ... Liberty is 6-1 in games decided by 10 points or less, after going 6-10 in such contests last season ... MEGAN FRAZEE has posted 27-consecutive double-digit scoring efforts, dating back to last season. This is the longest streak by a Liberty player since ELENA KISSELEVA notched 62-straight games of 10 points or more between the 1996-97 and 1998-99 seasons.

PRESBYTERIAN

PRESBYTERIAN

The Lady Blue Hose outrebounded an opponent for the first time in their NCAA Division I history last Tuesday against Radford. PC had five more rebounds than the Highlanders (40-35). Presbyterian followed that performance by out rebounding High Point (48-47) on Saturday ... SHARIE HOPKINS led the Lady Blue Hose on the boards against the Panthers, ending the contest with a nine rebounds ... PC is playing its fourth Big South opponent of the season in Charleston Southern. The Lady Blue Hose are currently 0-5 against their future Conference opponents as they have fallen twice to both UNC Asheville and Radford ... PC freshman guard KATLIN MOORE remains on top of the team's scoring list, following her five points against High Point. Moore now has 182 points on the season and is averaging 9.6 points per game ... Over the last nine games senior guard BRIDGET TAKACH has hit 46-7 percent of her shots from beyond the arc. Beginning with the home game at East Carolina on Dec. 18, Takach has hit 14-of-30 three-point attempts. Takach was a perfect 2-of-2 from three-point range most recently against High Point ... The Blue Hose have played 15 road games in its first 19 games and after its tilt with Charleston Southern University PC will have traveled 6,300 miles ... Senior AMY JONES led three PC players in double figures with 12 points in Presbyterian College's 76-58 loss at the Millis Athletic Center to future Big South Conference rival High Point University on Saturday afternoon. Lea Smith (Marion, N.C.) added 11 points and senior guard Takach scored 10 points in the game for the Lady Blue Hose. Junior forward points and senior guard Takach scored 10 points in the game for the Lady Blue Hose. Junior forward Hopkins led PC with nine rebounds, including six on the defensive glass. The best shooting performance for PC came from Takach (3-for-7), who was a perfect 2-for-2 from beyond the arc. The Lady Blue Hose finished by hitting 27.7 percent (18-of-65) of their shots from the floor, scoring 20 points off turnovers.

RADFORD With its victory over Presbyterian, Radford tied the school record for non-conference wins at 13. They tied the 1988-89 team that finished 25-7. RU began its season-long four-game road swing at Presbyterian. They conclude the swing with three games in five days. CORRIE FERTITTA reached the 800-rebound plateau on Jan. 8 vs. Presbyterian. She becomes the fourth Highlander and ninth Big South player to reach this milestone ... JOHNETTE WALKER moved into fourth on RU's career steals chart with seven vs. Presbyterian ... KELLI DARDEN is just 10 points shy of becoming the 17th Highlander to reach 1,000 points. She will join teammate Fertitta (Dec. 22), becoming the fourth pair of Highlanders to reach the milestone in the same season ... Defensively, Radford has forced 29 or more turnovers in five of its last six games and 30+ in three of its last four. They have also blocked five or more shots in 13 games this year, reaching double-digits three times. RU blocked a season high 12 vs. Virginia Intermont Intermont.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville won its final non-conference game of the season 62-52 over USC Upstate this week. The Dogs complete the non-conference season with a 9-8 record. JESSICA MONROE scored a career-high 23 points in the victory over Upstate going 9-for-11 from the floor ... STACY SHEPARD had a career-high 16 rebounds to give her 634 for her career. She is 26 shy of fifth place all-time at Asheville.

JESSICA FANSLER came off the bench to score a career-best 20 points in the win over Converse. She also pulled down a career-high 8 rebounds ... After playing 10 of 12 games on the road, Winthrop finally returned home and defeated Converse College in its first trip back to Rock Hill since Dec. 17. The game vs. Converse was the start of a three-game home stand before the Eagles hit the road to High Point for their conference opener.
