# CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

REGGIE WILLIAMS Sr. • Forward • VMI Prince George, Va.

Williams averaged 30.5 points and 15.5 rebounds in two Conference games last week, and also averaged 5.0 assists, .585 percent from the floor (24-of-41) and .714 percent from the charity stripe (10-of-14). He scored a game-high 38 points along with his 12 rebounds in a 107-100 win at Coastal Carolina, VMI's first in Kimbel Arena. Williams accounted for 23 points over the final eight minutes as the Keydets rallied from a 17-point deficit. In a three-point overtime loss against League-leading UNC Asheville, Williams scored 23 points and grabbed a career-high 19 rebounds. He was 9-of-14 from the field and also had four assists, one block and one steal

# NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Carter averaged 23.0 points and 7.0 rebounds in helping the Buccaneers to a 1-1 week. He led CSU in scoring with a career-high 25 points in a 90-74 win over Radford, and tossed in a team-high 21 points in a loss at Liberty. Against the Highlanders, Carter connected on 6-of-8 field goal attempts en route to 17 second-half points in 14 minutes. He also paced the squad with nine rebounds in the win. At Liberty, Carter made three threepointers and added five rebounds and two assists. On the week, Carter was 17-of-30 from the field ( =.567), 4-of-10 from three-point range (=.400), 8-of-12 from the line ( =.667) and added three assists, two steals and one blocked shot in the two games.

## ASHEVILLE JUMPS OUT TO 3-0 BIG SOUTH START

UNC Asheville is 3-0 in the Big South for the first time since the 2001-02 season when the Bulldogs opened Conference action 5-0. It is the sixth time that UNC Asheville has started League play at least 3-0, a Big South record for most 3-0 Conference starts. Asheville also started 3-0 in 1996-97 (7-0), 1997-98 (8-0), 1998-99 (3-0), 2000-01 (5-0) and 2001-02 (5-0). The Big South has had a team start League play 3-0 every year except 2002-03.

#### **BOARD GAMES**

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ARIZONA REID** became the sixth player in Big South history with 800 career rebounds when he eclipsed the total Jan. 8 vs. Florida Christian, and he also became the third in League annals with 1,600 points and 800 caroms. Reid is now the third all-time leading rebounder at 849, and he is 105 rebounds shy of tying the Conference career record of 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**. Reid, who is averaging 11.1 rebounds per game, would need to average 7.50 rebounds in High Point's 14 remaining scheduled games to reach the mark. #### **GAYNOR JOINS EXCLUSIVE GROUP**

Winthrop's CHRIS GAYNOR became the eighth player in Big South history with 500 career assists when reached the milestone last week against Liberty on Jan. 15. Gaynor is now just one of four players in Big South history with 500 career assists and 200 career steals, as he enters this week with 509 assists and 212 steals. Meanwhile, Gaynor is challenging the Conference career records in both categories. BRIAN SCHMALL owns the assists record with 563, while BRAD CHILDRESS set the career steal mark at 243. #### BIG SOUTH TV PACKAGE CONTINUES THIS WEEK

The Big South's men's basketball television package continues this week with two games on the tube. SportSouth will broadcast the Coastal Carolina at Winthrop game live at 7:00pm on Saturday, Jan. 26, with MATT HOGUE (play-by-play) and SHAUN GOLDEN (analyst) providing the call. Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) will simulcast the Flames Television Network's broadcast of High Point at Liberty Saturday night live at 9:00pm.

## REGGIE WILLIAMS -- ALL-TIME LEADING SCORER IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY

With a free throw with three seconds remaining in the first half vs. Southern Virginia on Tuesday, Jan. 8, VMI senior forward **REGGIE WILLIAMS** passed Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR** as the all-time leading scorer in Big South Conference history. Williams finished with 43 points in the game -- his sixth career 40-point game, and is currently at 2,325 points with 12 scheduled games remaining. Blair held the mark for less than a year, as he finished with 2,211 points at end of the 2006-07 season. Williams, who became the fourth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 28 vs. Columbia Union, has scored 1,392 points since the beginning of the 2006-07 campaign (50 games), an average of 27.9 points.

#### **BULLDOGS UNLEASHED**

UNC Asheville, which won 10 games before January for the first time under head coach EDDIE BIEDEN-BACH, stands at 14-4 entering the week and are currently ranked No. 19 in the latest *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. UNC Asheville's 14 wins are its most since winning 15 games in 2002-03, while it is the most regular-season victories since 1997-98 (18 wins prior to the Big South Tournament).

## THREE'S COMPANY

Coastal Carolina senior JACK LEASURE continues to challenge the Big South career three-point record. He is currently second all-time with 364 and needs 38 treys to break DOUG DAY's career Conference record of 401. Leasure is averaging 4.00 threes per game this season, and would need to average 3.17 triples in Coastal's 12 remaining scheduled games to surpass the mark. He has five games this season with at least five three-pointers (33 in his career) and has made a three-pointer in 99 of his 105 career games. Leasure is looking to join the exclusive NCAA Division I 400 career three-point field goal club, which boasted six members entering the 2007-08 season.

#### LEASURE WORLD

Coastal Carolina senior JACK LEASURE is the current active leader in Division I in career three-pointers and three-pointers per game. He enters the week with 364 career treys, just ahead of Tennessee's CHRIS LOFTON (362), and his 3.467 per game average in 105 career appearances is ahead of Lofton's average of 3.321 (362 in 109 games). Leasure and Lofton were the only two players to start the 2007-08 season with at least 300 career three-pointers.

#### **GOAL ORIENTED**

In addition to becoming the Big South's all-time scorer Jan. 8, VMI's REGGIE WILLIAMS broke LARRY BLAIR's Big South career mark for most field goals (801) during his record-breaking game. Williams now has 842 career field goals, and is within reach of three additional Big South career records. He needs 228 field goal attempts to break the mark of 1,926 (Blair); he is 51 free throws shy of the career record of 513 (Radford's WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE); and he stands 24 free throw attempts from breaking the record of 677 (Liberty's PETER ALUMA).

#### ROCK AROUND THE BLOCK

UNC Asheville center KENNY GEORGE has 74 blocks in his 16 appearances (4.63 per game) and is challenging the Big South single-season record of 4.6, set by UMBC's PASCAL FLEURY in 1994-95. Fleury set the Big South season record with 124 blocked shots that year. George's 74 blocks this season already rank tied for 10th most in a Big South campaign, and he is 26 swats away from recording just the third 100 blocked shot season in League annals. Meanwhile, George -- who is averaging just 20.3 minutes off the bench for Asheville, became the 21st player in Big South history with 100 career blocked shots when he eclipsed the mark vs. Buffalo on Dec. 29. He is currently 17th all-time with 121.

#### MID-MAJOR MANIA

UNC Asheville is ranked in the Collegeinsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 poll for the third-straight week this week and is currently at No. 19. Winthrop has either been ranked in the poll or has received votes all season. Below is a week-by-week look at where the Big South has been ranked in the poll:

#### STEALING THE SHOW

Winthrop's CHRIS GAYNOR and VMI's TRAVIS HOLMES have each cracked the Top 10 on the Big South's career steals chart. Gaynor is eighth all-time in League history with 212 steals, while Holmes is 10th with 197. The career record is 243, held by BRAD CHILDRESS (1986-90) of former member Campbell.

#### WILLIAMS LOOKING FOR BACK-TO-BACK TITLES

VMI senior REGGIE WILLIAMS currently leads the Big South with a 27.3 scoring average, and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in consecutive seasons. Williams paced the League (and the nation) with a Big South-record 28.1 scoring mark in 2006-07. Coastal Carolina's KEKE HICKS led the Big South in scoring in back-to-back years in 1993-94 (22.4) and 1994-95 (21.1). Meanwhile, Williams has scored in double figures in his last 42 games and has reached 20 points 36 times in that span.

## SPREADING THE LOVE

UNC Asheville's K.J. GARLAND, who became the 16th player in Conference history with 400 assists when he reached the milestone against Buffalo on Dec. 29, is tied for 11th all-time with 430. Asheville's JOSH KOHN tallied 430 helpers during his career from 1992-96.

## TRAVIS HOLMES GAINS MEMBERSHIP INTO BIG SOUTH'S 1,000-POINT CLUB

VMI junior guard TRAVIS HOLMES became the 85th player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 at Coastal Carolina. Travis (1,028 points) and his twin brother CHAVIS (1,140) became just the fourth set of twins with 1,000 points each, according to NCAA research. In fact, it is the second time that VMI had twins with more than 1,000 points each as RAMON (1,630) and DAMON WILLIAMS (1,622) combined for 3,252 points for the Keydets from 1987-90. The Holmes' current combined total of 2,168 ranks sixth all-time in NCAA history among twins.

#### 7-UP

High Point senior guard **MIKE JEFFERSON** continues to lead the Big South in assists per game, averaging 7.13, just ahead of Liberty's **TEEJAY BANNISTER** (7.12). The duo could become just the third and fourth players in League history to average 7.00 assists in a season, which was previously accomplished by Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87 (9.64) and Campbell's **DAN POGUE** in 1993-94 (7.39). Jefferson led the Big South in assists last season and is looking to become the first player since Charleston Southern's **ED O'NEIL** (2002, 2003) to lead the League in assists in consecutive seasons. The last time a Liberty player led the Conference in assists was **BEAU WALLACE** in 2000-01 with a 4.5 average.

#### ARIZONA'S HIGH POINTS

High Point senior **ARIZONA REID** is second in the League in scoring at 23.4 points per game, and has nine games with at least 25 points. In those games, Reid is averaging 29.0 points, including five games with 29 points and one with a career-high 37. He is currently averaging 11.1 boards through 16 games and is looking to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in the same season. Reid and Kansas State's **MICHAEL BEASLEY** (24.6, 12.6) are the only players in the nation currently averaging 23.0 ppg and 11.0 rpg and are ranked among the Top 10 nationally in both categories. Last year, Reid was the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same campaign.

#### WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE

Liberty now owns the longest home winning streak in the Big South, having won its last eight games at the Vines Center. The Flames are the last remaining undefeated Big South team at home this season, as High Point's 10-game home win streak was snapped this past Saturday by Coastal Carolina. The Chanticleers' eight-game home win streak came to an end last Monday vs. VMI. Meanwhile, Winthrop has won 18-straight at home against Big South opponents and is 62-6 (=.912) at Winthrop Coliseum since the 2003-04 season. High Point is 51-11 (=.823) overall at the Millis Center in the same span, has won its last 18 non-Conference home games and has won 25 of its last 27 at home.

#### **GAYNING GROUND**

If Winthrop senior guard CHRIS GAYNOR plays 29 games this season, he will become the League's all-time games played leader with 124. The current record of 123 is held by Gaynor's former teammates CRAIG BRADSHAW and BILLY HOUSTON. Gaynor has played in 113 of Winthrop's 116 games during his tenure, all starts, and is on pace to break the record Feb. 26 at home against Charleston Southern.

## STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville leader **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the third coach in Big South history with 150 wins when Asheville defeated Campbell on Dec. 13. He is the longest-tenured coach in Big South history at 12 years, surpassing former Radford head coach (and current Clemson assistant) **RON BRADLEY**, who coached the Highlanders for 11 seasons. Biedenbach's career record at UNC Asheville is 157-180, and he will remain in the third spot on the League's career win list for a while, as Bradley is second all-time with 193 victories. Biedenbach and Bradley are the only coaches to coach at least 10 years in the Big South.

#### SECOND IN COMMAND

High Point head coach **BART LUNDY**, who is the second-longest tenured Big South coach at five years, is in sole possession of eighth-place on the Big South's all-time coaching win list with 78 victories. Lundy surpassed former Liberty coach **RANDY DUNTON** (77 wins) on Jan 12 with HPU's 62-61 home win over Winthrop. Former Liberty head coach **JEFF MEYER** holds the seventh spot with 108 wins from 1991-97.

#### WINTHROP UPENDS #19 MIAMI, 76-70

The Winthrop Eagles defeated No. 19 Miami, 76-70 in the MetroPCS Orange Bowl Classic on Dec. 29. It was Winthrop's second win over an ACC opponent this season (Georgia Tech was the first) and is the Big South's first win over a nationally-ranked opponent since Winthrop defeated No. 17 Notre Dame in last year's NCAA Tournament. The win moved the Eagles back into the Mid-Major Top 25 poll, as Winthrop was No. 24 the week of Dec. 31.

#### UNC ASHEVILLE PULLS OFF BIG SOUTH'S SECOND UPSET IN A WEEK

UNC Asheville used a 10-0 run over the final 3:56 to come back and defeat SEC member South Carolina, 61-58 in Columbia, S.C. on Jan. 5 It was the second-straight week a Big South team pulled an upset of a power Conference (Winthrop defeated No. 19 Miami on Dec. 29), and it marks the second consecutive season that the Big South Conference defeated an SEC squad (Winthrop won at Mississippi State in 2006-07).

#### IN A CLASS ALL BY HIMSELF

Coastal Carolina senior JACK LEASURE was named one of 30 men's basketball candidates for the 2007-08 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The award is presented annually and focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School (CLASS), the award was launched in 2001-02 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who remain committed to their university and pursue the many rewards that a senior season and complete college education brings. The award winner will be announced and presented a trophy during the 2008 NCAA Final Four.

## VMI'S REGGIE WILLIAMS NAMED TO PRESEASON WOODEN AWARD WATCH LIST

VMI senior forward **REGGIE WILLIAMS** is among the 50 preseason candidates for the 2007-08 John R. Wooden Award, the nation's most coveted college basketball award. Last year's national leading scorer, Williams was the lone Big South player on the preseason listing. In addition, Williams was honored during the preseason as a *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major All-American, a *Collegehoops.net* First-team Mid-Major All-American, and has been named to *Collegehoops.net*'s Top 100 college basketball players in the country.

#### BIG SOUTH TO MAKE THIRD APPEARANCE IN ESPNU BRACKETBUSTERS EVENT

The Big South will again participate in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event this season during the weekend of February 22-23. Winthrop (home) and High Point (road) will be the League's participants. In two years of participation in the event, the Big South is 4-2 overall.

#### LOOKING AHEAD TO 2008-09...

Gardner-Webb University, which upset nationally-ranked Kentucky in the first week of the season, will join the Big South Conference in 2008-09 as a full member. The Bulldogs are already an associate Big South member in football, and are in their final season in the Atlantic Sun. Gardner-Webb played five games against future Big South opponents this season, finishing 3-2. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College is transitioning to Division I and will join the Big South in 2008-09.
