Williams scored a season-high 43 points and posted 10 rebounds in VMI's 112-96 win over Newport News Apprentice. He hit 17-of-22 field goals (= .773 percent) and was 9-of-10 from the free throw line in recording his fifth career 40-point game. Williams also collected his 20th career double-double and helped VMI rally from an eight-point first half deficit, as his dunk at the 2:43 mark of the first half put the Keydets up for good. Williams also added four assists and two blocked shots in the victory.

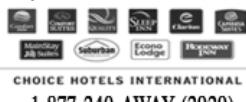

Carter helped Charleston Southern defeat future Big South member Gardner-Webb Saturday, 80-69, with 19 points and six rebounds. He scored CSU's first six points on two three-pointers and tallied 10 first half points. He also added several key baskets in the final minutes, including the Buccaneers' last field goal with 2:08 left to give CSU a seven-point lead. Carter had several clutch rebounds and made two free throws in the final minute to ensure the victory. On the night, Carter was 3-of-8 from three-point range, 4-of-4 from the line, and recorded three steals.

WILLIAMS CONTINUES PURSUIT OF BIG SOUTH CAREER SCORING RECORD

VMI senior **REGGIE WILLIAMS**, who became the fourth player in Big South history with 2,000 career points when he surpassed the milestone Nov. 28 vs. Columbia Union, stands third all-time with 2,125 points following his fifth career 40-point game last week. He needs 27 points to move into second-place and 87 points to become the Big South's all-time leading scorer. Former Liberty guard **LARRY BLAIR** is the Conference's record holder with 2,211 career points, which he established just last year. Williams is currently on pace to break the scoring record Jan. 8, 2008 at home vs. Southern Virginia. Meanwhile, Williams and Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** are the only two players in Big South history with 2,000 points and 600 career rebounds. Dunkin tallied 2,151 points and 725 rebounds during his career, and Williams sits at 2,125 points and 665 boards. Below are the Big South's 2,000-points scorers:

WILLIAMS LOOKING FOR BACK-TO-BACK TITLES

VMI senior **REGGIE WILLIAMS** currently leads the Big South with a 26.4 scoring average, and is looking to become just the second player in Big South history to lead the Conference in scoring in consecutive seasons. Williams paced the League (and the nation) with a Big South-record 28.1 scoring mark in 2006-07. Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** led the Big South in scoring in back-to-back years in 1993-94 (22.4) and 1994-95 (21.1). Meanwhile, Williams has scored in double figures in his last 35 games and has reached 20 points 30 times in that span.

ARIZONA'S HIGH POINTS

High Point senior **ARIZONA REID** is second in the League in scoring at 24.8 points per game, and has a Conference-best six games with at least 25 points. In those games, Reid is averaging 29.8 points, including four games with 29 points and one with a career-high 37. Reid leads the Big South with 10.0 rebounds per game, and is looking to become the first player in Big South history to average 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds in the same season. Last year, Reid was the first player in League history to average 20.0 points and 9.0 rebounds in the same campaign.

MID-MAJOR MANIA

Winthrop remains on the cusp of re-joining the *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 ranking, as the Eagles were in the 27th spot in the latest poll released Dec. 10, nine points from the No. 25 position. Winthrop fell out of the Top 25 on Dec. 3, the first time since before the 2004-05 season that Winthrop was not among the Top 25 teams in the poll. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville has garnered votes the past five weeks and preseason Big South favorite High Point received votes in the preseason poll. Below is a week-by-week look at the poll:

HOLMES BECOMES 83rd PLAYER IN BIG SOUTH HISTORY WITH 1,000 POINTS

VMI junior guard **CHAVIS HOLMES** became the second player this season and 83rd overall to surpass 1,000 career points in the Big South when he reached the milestone last week with 30 points against Newport News Apprentice. Holmes currently sits in a tie for 78th place with Towson State's **SCOOTER ALEXANDER** (1992-95) at 1,026 points.

JEFFERSON STARSHIP

High Point senior guard **MIKE JEFFERSON** tallied 15 assists Saturday vs. Anderson, the highest single-game assist total in the Big South since **DAN POGUE** of former member Campbell had 16 assists against UNC Asheville on Feb. 8, 1993. Jefferson's 15 helpers are tied for fourth-most in a game in League annals. Jefferson, who has three 10-assist nights, leads the Big South in assists per game with an average of 7.56, which would be the second-highest single-season per game clip in Big South history. The Conference has had just two players average 7.00 assists in a season: Charleston Southern's **TONY FAIRLEY** in 1986-87 (9.64) and Pogue in 1993-94 (7.39).

BIG SOUTH HAS THREE AMONG TOP NCAA DIVISION I ACTIVE SCORERS

VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** is the active leading scorer in Division I at 2,125 career points, just ahead of New Orleans' **BO MCCAULEBB** (2,102 points). In addition, Coastal's **JACK LEASURE** is 10th on the list at 1,578, while High Point's **ARIZONA REID** is 13th at 1,550. Reid is the ninth active career rebounder in the NCAA at 761. Memphis' **JOEY DORSEY** is tops at 905.

IN A CLASS ALL BY HIMSELF

Coastal Carolina senior **JACK LEASURE** was named one of 30 men's basketball candidates for the 2007-08 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The award is presented annually and focuses on the "Four C's" of classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School (CLASS), the award was launched in 2001-02 to honor the attributes of college basketball seniors who remain committed to their university and pursue the many rewards that a senior season and complete college education brings. The award winner will be announced and presented a trophy during the 2008 NCAA Final Four.

THREE'S COMPANY

Coastal Carolina senior **JACK LEASURE** has made a three-pointer in nine consecutive games, and is one game from his fifth career streak with a three-point field goal in 10-straight games. Leasure, who had a career-high 34-consecutive game streak with a trey during his freshman and sophomore seasons, as made a three-pointer in 93 of his 98 career games. This season, he is hitting .515 percent of his three-point shots (34-of-66), and is challenging the Big South career record. Leasure is currently second all-time in Big South history with 334 career three-point field goals, and needs 68 treys to break **DOUG DAY's** career Conference record of 401. Leasure is looking to become just the seventh player in NCAA Division I history with 400 career three-point field goals.

REACHING HIS GOAL

In addition to his pursuit of the Big South's scoring record, VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** is approaching the League's all-time record of 801 career field goals, held by Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR**. Williams is currently at 764, third all-time and 12 away from moving past Coastal Carolina's **TONY DUNKIN** (775) for second-place. Williams is averaging 10.00 field goals made per game this season, and is on pace to break the all-time record Jan. 8, 2008 at home against Southern Virginia.

LENDING A HELPING HAND

Winthrop's **CHRIS GAYNOR** and UNC Asheville's **K.J. GARLAND** are quietly climbing the League's all-time assist leaderboard. Gaynor is now ninth all-time in Big South history with 466 career assists, and needs four to move into the eighth spot past Winthrop's **TYSON WATERMAN** (469). Gaynor also is 34 assists shy of becoming the seventh player in League history with 500. Garland's career total stands at 382 (16th all-time), and he is 18 helpers away from becoming the 16th player in Conference annals with 400.

GARLAND BECOMES 82nd PLAYER IN LEAGUE HISTORY WITH 1,000 POINTS

UNC Asheville senior guard **K.J. GARLAND** became the 82nd player in Big South history to score 1,000 career points when he reached the milestone at Western Carolina, Nov. 20. Garland's career total now stands at 1,067, good for 74th place all-time.

MOVIN' ON UP

The Big South has five active 1,000-point scorers on the court this season, which are listed below. Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** needs 81 points to move into the League's Top 10, while High Point's **ARIZONA REID** became the 20th player with 1,500 points Dec. 8 vs. Johnson & Wales. Several others may crack the list before the 2007-08 season is complete.

REID ALL ABOUT IT

Big South Preseason Player of the Year **ARIZONA REID** became the sixth player in Big South history with 1,500 points and 700 rebounds Dec. 8 when he surpassed the scoring milestone vs. Johnson & Wales. He is currently seventh in League history with 761 career rebounds, and needs 25 to move past Charleston Southern's **HEDER AMBROISE** (785) for sixth-place. Reid is 193 rebounds shy of tying the Conference career record of 954, held by Campbell's **JOE SPINKS**, and would need to average 9.19 rebounds per game the remainder of the 2007-08 season to reach the all-time mark, based on him playing all 30 games High Point has scheduled this season. He is currently averaging 10.0 boards through nine games.

ROCK AROUND THE BLOCK

UNC Asheville center **KENNY GEORGE** has 44 blocks in his seven appearances (6.29 per game), pacing well ahead of the Big South single-season record of 4.6, set by UMBC's **PASCAL FLEURY** in 1994-95. The NCAA season record for blocked shots per game is 6.5, established by Northeastern's **SHAWN JAMES** in 2005-06. Meanwhile, George is just three blocks away from matching his season total from last year (47 in 23 games) and stands at 91 blocked shots in his career. He needs nine blocks to become the 21st player in Big South history with 100 in a career.

ASHEVILLE ENJOYING EARLY FIRST-PLACE STANDING

UNC Asheville, which started the season 5-0 for the first time in school history, remains atop the Big South standings with a 7-2 overall record, its best start in 23 years. Asheville is the lone Big South squad shooting better than .500 percent from the floor (.502), and if the Bulldogs can remain at .500 or above, they would become the first Big South member to shoot better than .500 percent from the floor since Radford in 1993-94 (.502). Asheville also leads the Big South this season in field goal defense (.375), three-point field goal percentage (.439), blocked shots (9.11) and defensive rebounds (27.33).

GAYNING GROUND

If Winthrop senior guard **CHRIS GAYNOR** plays 29 games this season, he will become the League's all-time games played leader with 124. The current record of 123 is held by Gaynor's former teammates **CRAIG BRADSHAW** and **BILLY HOUSTON**. Gaynor has played in 104 of Winthrop's 107 games during his tenure, all starts.

HOME FOR THE HOLIDAYS

High Point owns the longest current home winning streak in the Big South, having won its last seven games at Millis Center and 22 of their 23 at home. In addition, the Panthers have won their last 16 non-Conference home games. Liberty and Coastal Carolina are next at four-straight home wins. Meanwhile, Winthrop is 58-6 (= .906 percent) at Winthrop Coliseum since the 2003-04 season, and has won 17-straight at home against Big South opponents. High Point is 48-10 (= .828) at Millis Center in the same span.

FOUR SCORE

Liberty's **ALEX McLEAN** and UNC Asheville's **BRYAN SMITHSON** have performed well in each of their last four games. McLean is averaging 22.8 points and 9.8 rebounds in his last four outings, helping Liberty to three-straight wins during the timeframe. Smithson is averaging 18.0 points in his four games since returning from an injury.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville leader **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became the third coach in Big South history with 150 wins when Asheville defeated Campbell last Thursday. He is the longest-tenured coach in Big South history at 12 years, surpassing former Radford head coach **RON BRADLEY** (11 seasons). Biedenbach's career record at UNC Asheville is 150-178, and he will remain in the third spot on the League's career win list for a while, as Bradley is second all-time with 193 victories. Biedenbach and Bradley are the only coaches to coach at least 10 years in the Big South.

SECOND IN COMMAND

High Point head coach **BART LUNDY**, who is the second-longest tenured Big South coach, moved into sole possession of ninth-place on the Big South's all-time coaching win list with his 75th win at High Point Friday vs. Anderson. Lundy, who was tied with former Winthrop coach **STEVE VACENDAK** (74 victories from 1986-92), needs three wins to surpass former Liberty coach **RANDY DUNTON** for eighth-place.
