He was 5-9 with six RBI in the two games against Ball State. Doyle was 3-4 with a double and a home run in the 6-1 win March 8, and then went 2-5 with a double, home run and four RBI in the 10-8 win. His tworun double in the eighth inning brought in the game-winning runs. Doyle also slugged 1.188 on the week, had a .550 on-base percentage and threw out 2-of-3 runners trying to steal.

DeRatt continued his early season mastery on the mound as he blanked Wright State, 2-0 on Saturday in recording his first complete game shutout since the opening game of the 2006 Big South Baseball Tournament. He went the full nine innings, allowing six hits, walking one and fanning eight batters. The Raiders hit .200 against him. DeRatt is 3-0 this season and has not allowed a run in 23.0 innings, and opponents are batting just .114 against him with eight hits.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU racked up a season-high 15 hits in series-sweeping victory over Maryland-Eastern Shore, and drew a season-high 10 walks in the game as well ... STEVE ANTOLIK continued his hot streak, stretching his hitting streak to nine games ... KORY MORIAN has a five-game hit streak going, totaling 10 hits in that span ... Since becoming the Bucs' DH eight games ago, DEREK SMITH has recorded a hit in each contest ... TYLER THORNBURG recorded the first win of his collegiate career, going 5.2 innings with five strikeouts in the series finale against UMES ... PAYTON TWEDDALE went the final three innings of CSU's 8-6 victory over the Hawks for his second save of the season. He is the Bucs' career leader in saves with 15.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 4-0 on the week, sweeping the Springmaid Beach Resort Tournament at Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field ... Coastal completed a triple play in the 6-1 win over Ball State on Saturday. With two on and no one out, Matt Stoeklen hit a shot to second that **RICO NOEL** skied for and grabbed. He then stepped on second to force out Justin Rogers and threw to first to retire Dean Anna for a triple play. It was the first triple play at Watson Stadium since 2005 ... The best starting pitching performance came from **AUSTIN FLEET** on Saturday. Fleet struck out five in six innings in the 6-1 win. He only allowed one run and four hits to move his record to 2-0 on the year ... Coastal will face two nationally-ranked teams this week. Coastal heads to Cary, N.C., to face North Carolina Tuesday and then hosts Michigan and Ball State in the Centex Homes Invitational this weekend.

HIGH POINT

High Point began a stretch of nine of 11 road games with some tough losses against in-state foes ... Against Appalachian State, HPU scored eight runs in the bottom of the ninth inning ... TUCKER STOBBE blasted the Panthers' first grand slam homer of the season vs. ASU ... High Point's lineup features seven every day players batting over .300, led by senior RANDY SCHWARTZ at .417 ... HPU has swiped 18 bases in 22 attempts with PABLO ROSARIO topping the squad with 7 steals ... The Panthers host ACC foe Wake Forest on Tuesday for the first home night game of the year at Williard Stadium before hitting the road for a game at North Carolina A&T on Wednesday and a four-game series at Furman over the weekend.

LIBERTY

Liberty completed the week by sweeping a three-game series from Army ... The Flames batted .354 in the three-game set, scoring double-digit runs in each contest for a total of 39 ... In Saturday's 11-5 win game one win, the Flames hit three home runs at Worthington Stadium for the first time since March 31, 2006 in an 8-5 victory over VMI ... Freshman left fielder **DOUG BREAM** hit his first home run in a Liberty uniform in the contest, a grand slam, in the seventh inning ... Liberty travels to Hattiesburg, Miss., this weekend for the Coca-Cola Classic. The Flames will square off with Cal. State-Northridge on Friday and face host Southern Miss on Saturday. Following their game with Southern Miss, the Flames will then play Cal. State-Northridge to end the tournament Saturday afternoon.

RADFORD

RAPHAEL TURNER has hit in 10 of his last 11 games ... TYREN RIVERS has a hit in 10 of 11 games this season (one game without a hit had only one AB) ... ABRAM WILLIAMS picked up his first college win versus Seton Hall ... ALEX GREGORY has hit safely in 24 of his last 27 games. Gregory was held hitless in two straight games for only the fifth time in three years and only the third time when he recorded more than one at bat in the two games. He has never been held hitless in three straight games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

ALAN DeRATT continued his outstanding start as he threw a complete game, six-hit shutout against Wright State on Saturday. In three starts this season, DeRatt is 3-0 with a 0.00 ERA. He has not allowed a run and only eight hits in 23 innings and has 17 strikeouts ... Three of the Bulldogs' five wins this season are by shutout. Asheville had only one shutout all of last season ... Junior **KEVIN WIENBACHER** is off a a good start as well. He is has an eight game hitting streak and is batting .365 through the first 13 games. He has scored 11 runs and is third on the team in RBI with seven ... Junior **REED KREISER** has four home runs already and has eight RBI.

Sophomore **TANNER BIAGINI** extended his career-best hitting streak to 11 games this season, 12 games dating back to last season, by hitting 7-for-14 with a home run in a four-game series at Auburn ... The Keydets have excelled on the basepaths this season, being thrown out only three times in 21 attempts ... Walters is yet to allow a run in 6.2 innings of work this season ... This week, the Eagles travel to Elon on Tuesday before hosting College of Charleston on Wednesday and traveling to Rice to play a four-game series over the weekend.
