Sandridge had three multiple-hit games and hit a three-run, walk-off home run in the bottom of the 11th inning in game one against Radford to give VMI a 4-3 win. Sandridge drove in runs in all four games last week as VMI went 4-0 against four in-state opponents. He went 3-4 with two doubles and two runs scored against Richmond, and had a 3-4 game with three RBIs in Sunday's game against the Highlanders, driving home the tying run in the fifth inning. Sandridge was 8-17 (-.471) with three runs scored, eight RBI, two doubles, one home run and two walks last week, in addition to a .765 slugging percentage and .526 on-base average.
