UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville set a school record for runs in a game as it defeated Hartford 33-8 this past weekend ... The Bulldogs went 3-3 on the week despite batting .361 as a team and hitting six home runs ... **REED KREISER** hit two home runs against Brown on Sunday, giving him seven for the year. Last year, the 'Dogs home run leader for the season hit only eight long balls ... Asheville only hit 30 home runs all of last year, but have already hit 18 in 24 games this season ... **KEVIN WIEDENBACHER** had a hit in all six games last week, extending his hit streak to 19 games, which is the second-longest in UNC Asheville history. **ROB VERNON** hit in 21-straight games last season ... **ALAN DeRATT** had another solid start for the Bulldogs against Hartford, allowing no earned runs in seven innings. He is now 5-0 on the year ... **MICHAEL BOGAERT** is 4-1 on the year after getting a win against Brown. VMI's doubleheader sweep of a Conference team is only the second time that the Keydets has swept a doubleheader from a Big South opponent since joining the League. VMI swept a twinbill in the opening series of last year's League opener against Charleston Southern, which also marked the last series sweep for the Keydets in the Big South ...
