UNC Asheville set a school record for runs in a game as it defeated Hartford 33-8 this past weekend ... The Bulldogs went 3-3 on the week despite batting .361 as a team and hitting six home runs ... REED KREISER hit two home runs against Brown on Sunday, giving him seven for the year. Last year, the 'Dogs home run leader for the season hit only eight long balls ... Asheville only it 30 home runs all of last year, but have already hit 18 in 24 games this season ...
