Arrington batted .526 (10-19) in five games last week, helping the Bulldogs to three wins. He scored six runs, knocked in six runs, had five doubles, three walks, a .789 slugging percentage and .609 on-base average. Arrington became UNC Asheville's all-time leader in career doubles as five of his 10 hits last week went for two bases. He also posted three multi-hit games, went 2-4 with two runs scored at North Carolina A&T, was 7-11 (.636) in the three-game series with Marist, and had three RBI at Furman. Arrington had a hit in all five games last week.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU and Richmond combined for 38 hits on Sunday, one shy of the Buccaneer record ... Freshman **STEVEN ANTO-LIK** had another home run on Sunday against Richmond, giving him a team-leading five on the season. He is on pace to break the Buccaneer record for home runs in a season (15) ... The Bucs set a season-high with 17 hits against Ball State on March 12 ... CSU has recorded double-digit hits in 11 out of 17 games this season ... CSU had a season-high three home runs against Richmond on March 14 ... Freshman **TYLER THORNBURG** tied the season-high RBI total among the Bucs with five driven in against Richmond on March 14 ... **TOM BURKETT** is the only Buccaneer to record a triple this season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal faced ranked opponents in three of its four games last week ... The Chanticleers went 3-1 in those games, defeating No. 3 North Carolina and No. 25 Michigan ... Coastal peaked at No. 20 in the NCBWA poll last week ... **DAVID ANDERSON** earned the win over the Tar Heels, striking out two and allowing three runs in 6.1 innings to improve his record to 3-0 on the year ... **NICK McCULLY** has now struck out 30 batters in 25.2 innings this season (10.52 K per nine innings) ... Freshman **SCOTT WOODWARD** is 17-of-18 in stolen bases this season, including three swipes last week ... **DOCK DOYLE** is slugging .787 in 16 games this year ... HIGH POINT

RHP **DAVID STOKES** allowed his first earned run of the season this past Saturday at Southern Miss. The senior did not allow an earned run over his first 22.1 innings to begin 2008 ... Over his last nine games, junior 3B **CODY BROWN** has hit .531 with 11 RBIs. This past weekend, he batted .600 in three games ... Liberty hosts intra-state rival James Madison on Tuesday, followed by a four-game series with Columbia on the weekend (Thursday-Saturday).

PRESBYTERIAN

In one of its hardest weeks of the year, future Big South Conference member Presbyterian went 0-4 ... The Blue Hose opened the week with two games against SEC opponents in South Carolina and Tennessee ... PC lost both games, but took both teams to extra-innings, losing 2-1 to USC in the 10th and 8-7 to Tennessee in the 10th on Wednesday ... The Blue Hose ended the week by falling to No. 25 Michigan and Ball State in the Centex Homes Invitational ... **JESSE HARMON** ended his career-best 11-game hitting streak by going 0-4 in the 5-2 loss to the nationally-ranked Wolverines.

RADFORD

Radford broke a four-game losing streak with a win over North Carolina A&T on Sunday ... The Highlanders have five games on the schedule this week. They host Rhode Island Monday, visit East Tennessee State Tuesday and return home to host Yale in a three-game series beginning Friday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 3-2 last week, as four of the five games were decided by one run ... The Bulldogs are now 2-2 in one-run games this season ... **KEVIN WIEDENBACHER** continues his fine hitting as he has extended his hitting streak to 13 games. He has hit in 17 of 18 games thus far this season ... **ALAN DeRATT's** scoreless inning streak was snapped at 24 as Marist scored a run in the second inning against him. He still recorded the victory and is 4-0 on the season ... **ELLIOTT ARRINGTON** became UNC Asheville's all-time doubles leader as he now has 56, breaking the previous mark of 52 by **BRIAN SHEHAN** ...
