Schumer went 10-for-21 (.476) from the plate last week to lead Asheville to four wins. He also picked up a win on the mound. The week started in heroic fashion as not only did he pitch the final four innings of the game (all scoreless) against future Big South member Gardner-Webb, but he also went 4-for-4 from the plate with four RBI. The biggest hit was a lead-off, walk-off home run to start the bottom of the 12th inning, which also made him the winning pitcher. He came back with two hits the next night against North Carolina A&T with two runs scored and a RBI. In two wins against Radford, Schumer went 4-for-9 with two more RBI and five runs scored. For the week, Schumer drove in seven runs, scored nine times, had three doubles, one home run, four walks, slugged .762, a .500 on-base average, three multi-hit games and RBIs in four of his five outings.
