Doyle batted .571 (8-14) with three home runs and 10 RBI to lead Coastal to a perfect 4-0 week. He had all the home runs and RBI in the series against Charleston Southern. His grand slam in the 14-7 win over the Bucs on Friday catapulted a seven-run second inning. For the second straight game, Doyle drove in four runs in the 15-5 win in the first game Saturday. This time, Doyle had two home runs and went 3-for-5 with four runs scored and a walk. Doyle concluded the series by going 2-for-3 with two doubles, two runs scored and two RBI in the 11-1 win. He opened the week by going 1-for-3 with a run scored in the 5-4 win at N.C. State. For the week, Doyle scored eight runs, walked five times, posted a 1.429 slugging percentage and .684 on-base average. The junior also threw out a runner trying to steal and had a pickoff in the N.C. State win.
