Woodward batted .444 (8-18) in five wins last week for the Chanticleers. He recorded hits in all five games and drove in runs in four. The freshman opened the week by going 1-for-4 with two runs scored and a walk in the 8-3 win over No. 16 Virginia. He then had two hits, including his first triple of the season, in a 12-0 win over Elon. Woodward had five hits and seven RBI in the three-game sweep of UNC Asheville. His big day came on Saturday, going 3-for-3 with two runs scored and five RBI in the 10-4 win. He also had his third home run of the season in the Saturday win. Woodward also extended his hitting streak to 10 games and stole his 27th base of the year. On the week, Woodward slugged .722, posted a .600 on-base percentage, walked seven times, knocked in eight runs and hit .556 against UNC Asheville.

Sunday, Page pitched the second complete game of the season by the Liberty pitching staff in a 6-1 victory. It was the first complete game for the lefthander since a 3-0 shutout at George Washington on March 11, 2006 ... Saturday's 16-inning, 6-5 setback to VMI was the longest game in innings in Liberty baseball history. The 16-inning contest, eclipsed a 14-inning, 5-4 loss to Virginia Tech in Blacksburg, Va., on April 9, 1990 ...
