Rosario batted .455 (5-11) in High Point's three-game sweep of Conference foe UNC Asheville and .333 overall in five games, helping the Panthers to four wins last week. He had a team-high seven hits, including at least one in each game and two multi-hit affairs. Rosario doubled home the game-tying run in the 3-2 series opening win over UNC Asheville Friday. He followed that with a pair of hits and scored the game-winning run in Saturday's 2-1 victory over the Bulldogs. In the finale on Sunday, Rosario belted a three-run homer that broke open the eventual 11-2 win. He posted a team-best 11 total bases and a .524 slugging percentage, in addition to drawing two walks, stealing a base and finishing with a .391 on-base average.
