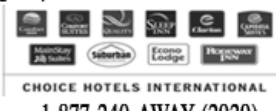

Coastal Carolina won its first-ever regional by defeating Columbia, Alabama and East Carolina in the 2008 NCAA Conway Regional, and became the first Big South Conference baseball program to advance to the Super Regionals ... The Chanticleers scored 47 runs in the three games, including a 24-11 win over East Carolina in the championship game ... Coastal scored 13 runs in the second inning. That is the second-most runs scored in an inning in NCAA postseason play. LSU scored 16 runs in an inning in a win over Georgia Tech in 1996 ... **DAVID ANDERSON** and **TOMMY BALDRIDGE** were named co-MVP's of the regional. They were joined by **DOCK DOYLE**, **SCOTT WOODWARD**, **DAVID SAPPELT** and **NICK MCCULLY** on the All-Regional Team ... Coastal had eight home runs in the three games, including three from Anderson ... Baldridge had the game-winning home run in the seven-run eighth inning in the 13-10 win over Alabama. His three-run home run broke a 10-10 tie ... **PETE ANDRELCZYK** earned the win against the Crimson Tide. He struck out six in 2.1 innings of relief ... Coastal has now won 50 games in a season three of the last four years ... Coastal will now face North Carolina in the Super Regionals. The two teams met March 11 in Cary, N.C., with the Chanticleers coming out on top 11-4. Anderson earned the win on the mound, while **ADAM RICE** went 3-for-4 with two runs scored ... 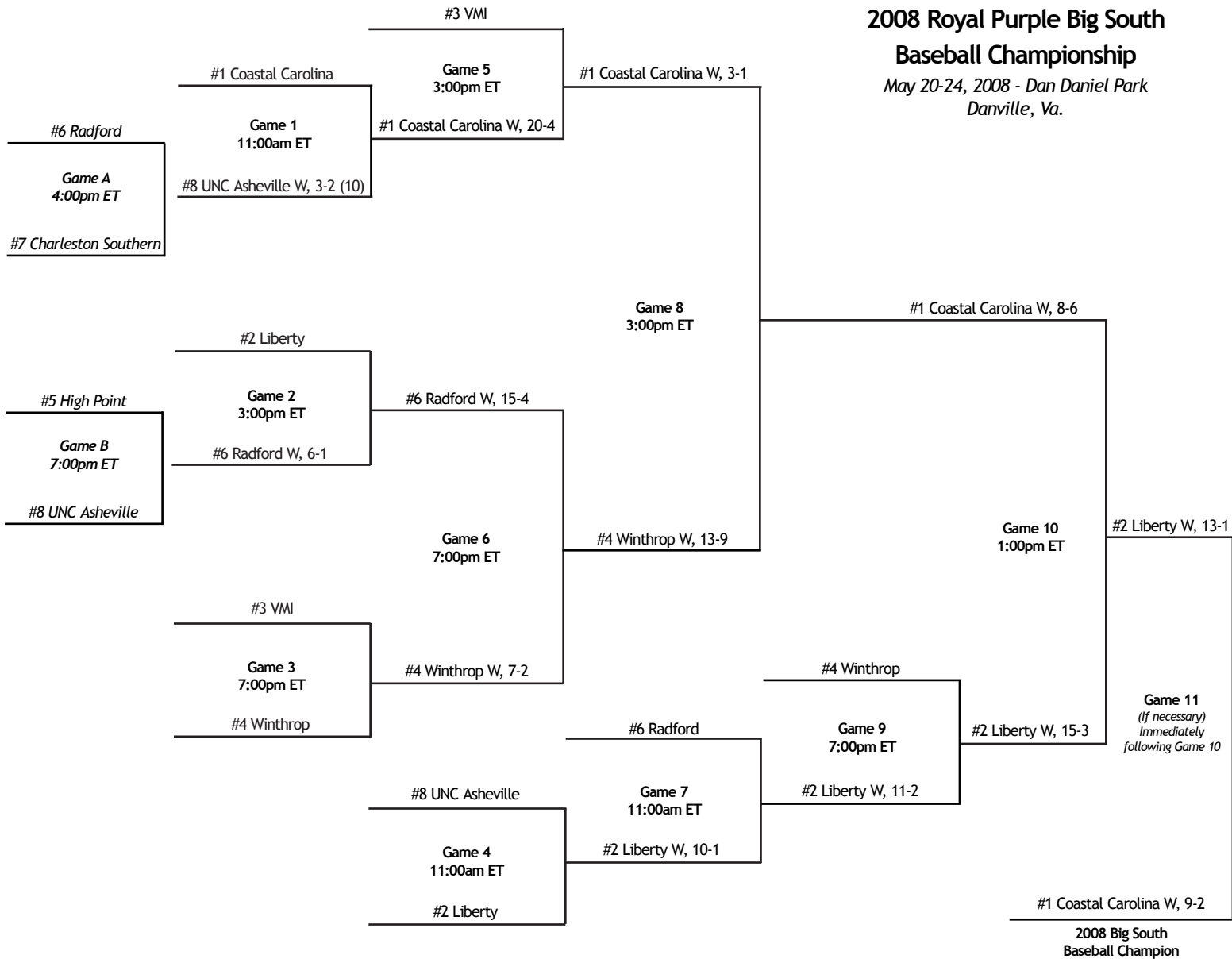
