Anderson had a monster power weekend in the Chanticleers' three-game sweep of High Point, going 8-15 with five home runs, nine RBI and a .1533 slugging percentage. Although hitless in the opener, he was intentionally walked in the 11th inning, a move that set up Tommy Baldrige's game-winning single. Anderson then went 4-5 with three home runs, three runs scored and seven RBI in game two, and came back with a 4-5 effort with two homers and two RBI in the series finale. Anderson, believed to be the first Coastal player to hit three home runs in a game in the Chanticleers' Division I history, also pitched two scoreless and hitless innings on Sunday with one strike-out. For the week, Anderson batted .533, posted a .563 OBA and tallied 23 total bases.

2008 BIG SOUTH TELEVISION GAMES

ESPNU televised a regular-season Big South baseball game for the third consecutive year, as the network aired the April 20 UNC Asheville at Coastal Carolina baseball game live from Charles L. Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field.



ESPNU aired two ballgames in 2006 and one contest in 2007. It also will be the fourth-straight year that Big South baseball will be televised. Meanwhile, Coastal's out-of-conference games at Georgia Tech on May 2 and 3 were televised live on SportSouth.



CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU has won two out of its last three Big South Conference series ... The Bucs posted back-to-back double digit run totals in their wins over UNC Asheville, the second time they reached double figures consecutively this season ... Freshman **TOM BURKETT** had the best week of his young career. He hit three home runs against Asheville and tallied 10 RBI for the week. He also scored 12 times in five games, more than double any other player's total ... Junior **MARK PERRY** hit for average and power in the leadoff spot for CSU. He led the team with a .444 batting average in five games last week, and also hit a pair of home runs, including a grand slam ... Freshman **DEREK SMITH** hit his team-high 11th home run in a loss to the College of Charleston ... Freshmen **TYLER THORNBURG** (4) and **KEITH HUSTEDT** (2), along with junior **KORY MORIAN** (3) also had home runs last week ... After going winless in his first 15 appearances this season, junior **BRANDON ROBERTS** earned victories in both his trips to the mound last week. He is now 2-3 on the season, and has lowered his ERA to 7.64 ... Coastal earned a share of the 2008 Big South regular-season title and the top seed in the upcoming Big South Tournament with a three-game sweep of High Point this past weekend ... It is the 11th Big South regular-season crown that the Chanticleers have been a part of ... Coastal has now won 40 games in a season for the 11th time in school history ... Coastal had 12 home runs in the three-game series, led by junior **DAVID ANDERSON's** five. Coastal now has 76 home runs in 52 games this season ... Coastal honored seniors **DEREK MARTIN**, **TOMMY BALDRIDGE** and **JOEY HAUG** on Sunday. Each player contributed in the 12-3 win. Martin was 3-for-4 with a two-run home run. Baldrige had a home run and two RBI and Haug had a pinch-hit single in the eighth ... Coastal earned its first win of the season when trailing after eight innings on Friday. Coastal was down 6-4 heading into the bottom of the ninth, but scored two runs in the ninth and one in the 11th for the come-from-behind win ... High Point played four of its five games last week on the road ... After not playing in extra innings for the first 40 games of the season, HPU has now gone to extra frames in three of its last eight games, including a pair of heart-breaking one-run losses last week ... The Panthers close their regular season slate this week with their home finale on Tuesday night against USC Upstate and a their Big South series finale at Liberty beginning on Friday night ... HPU trails Winthrop by one game in the standings in the battle for the #4 seed at next week's Big South Tournament (with the top 4 teams earning a bye on the opening day of play) ...
