Henderson batted .588 (10-17) and slugged 1.059 in four games last week. He opened his week with a 2-4 effort and two stolen bases against No. 2 North Carolina. At UNC Asheville, Henderson helped the Eagles to a 2-1 series win with a .615 batting average against the Bulldogs, and posted 11 RBI, two homers and two doubles in the three games. He drove in four runs in the series opener, knocked in another three runs in game two, and concluded the weekend with four hits and four RBI in the finale. Henderson also recorded three sacrifice flies.

Anderson continued his torrid hitting for the Chanticleers, as he hit .818 (9-11) and slugged 1.545 in Coastal's two games last week. Anderson also recorded his first save of the year as he tossed 4.0 innings with two strikeouts and one earned run in Friday's victory against the Highlanders.

2008 BIG SOUTH TELEVISION GAMES

ESPNU televised a regular-season Big South baseball game for the third consecutive year, as the network aired the April 20 UNC Asheville at Coastal Carolina baseball game live from Charles L. Watson Stadium/Vrooman Field.



ESPNU aired two ballgames in 2006 and one contest in 2007. It also will be the fourth-straight year that Big South baseball will be televised. Meanwhile, Coastal's out-of-conference games at Georgia Tech on May 2 and 3 were televised live on SportSouth.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern finished the regular-season with a 6-15 record in Big South Conference action after getting swept by VMI for the second straight year ... The Bucs also had a 6-15 mark in regular-season league play in 2007 ... Three teams finished with six Conference wins, forcing a tie breaker. CSU lost the tiebreaker to Radford (Conference win percentage) and won the tiebreaker over UNC Asheville (head-to-head record) ... Freshman **TOM BURKETT** holds the team's longest current hitting streak, recording a hit in each of the last eight games. He had a pair of home runs and four runs batted in last week, and now has six home runs in the last eight games, giving him eight homers on the season, which ranks third on the team ... Freshman **STEVE ANTOLIK** also had a pair of home runs in four games last week. He now has 11 on the season, tying him with freshman **DEREK SMITH** for the team lead ... The Bucs had not had a player reach double figures in home runs since 2004, when three players accomplished the feat. *Updated team leaders:*

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal won two games at Radford last week, scoring 28 runs in the two contests ... Sunday's game was cancelled due to rain and will not be made up ... Coastal will be the top seed for the 2008 Big South Baseball Tournament May 20-24 in Danville, Va. Coastal will start the tournament Wednesday, May 21 against either UNC Asheville, Radford or Charleston Southern ... Coastal is the defending champion in the tournament, going 4-0 last season in Rock Hill, S.C. ... **DAVID ANDERSON** is 17-for-21 in his last four games with a 1.905 slugging percentage ... A week after Anderson hit three home runs in a win over High Point, **DAVID SAPPELT** accomplished the same feat in the 18-8 win over Radford. It was Sappelt's second multi-home run game of his career and his seven RBI was a career high ... Coastal head coach **GARY GILMORE** earned his 500th win at CCU on Saturday. HPU also got a series finale win on the road at Liberty on Sunday ... High Point earned the No. 5 seed in the Big South Tournament for the second consecutive season ... 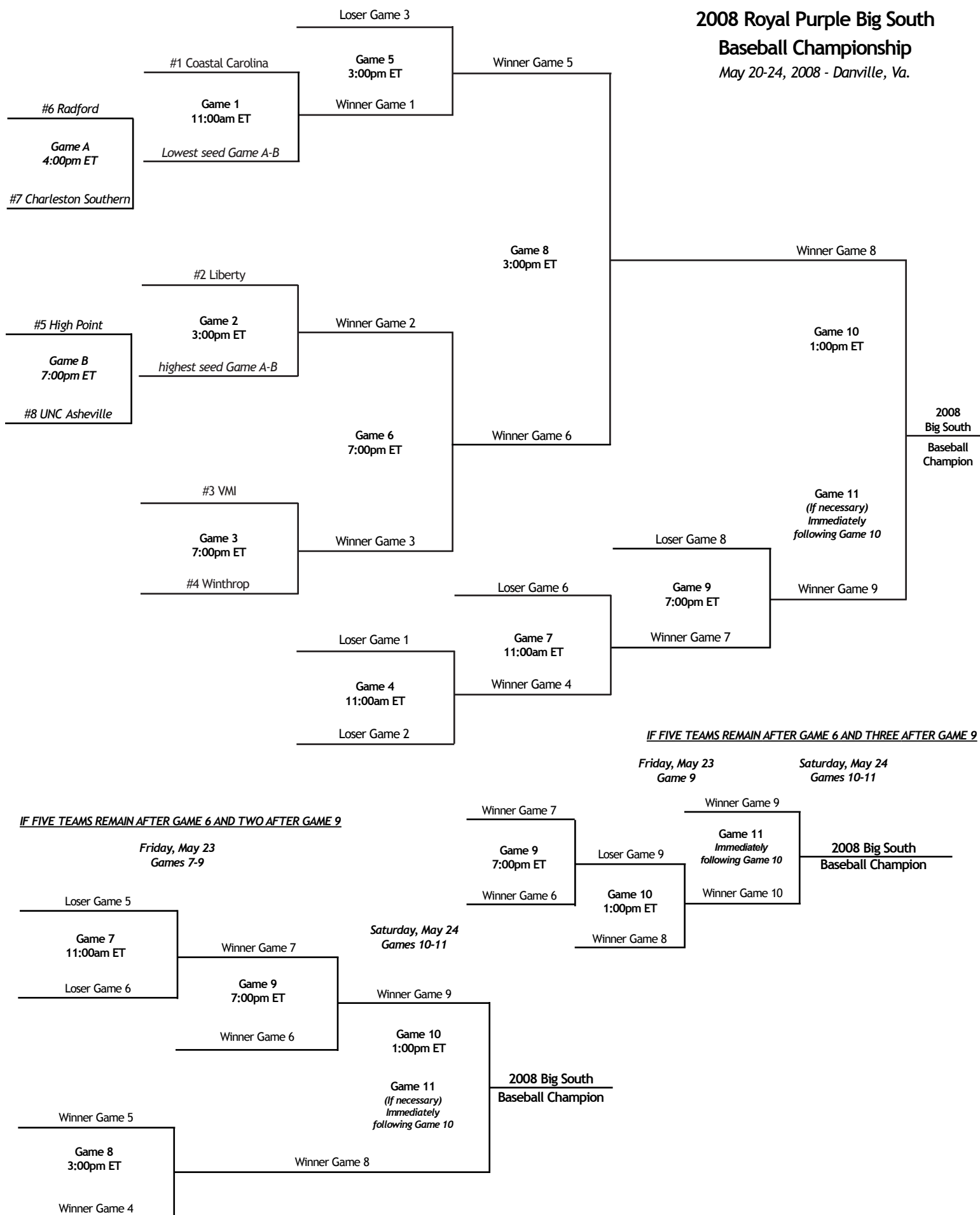
