CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

After combining for seven hits in the first two games against Ohio, the Buccaneers recorded 11 hits in a 7-1 victory in the third game ... CSU recorded 22 strikeouts in three games against Ohio ... Junior starting pitchers **BRANDON ROBERTS** and **ANDREW WHITE** each recorded seven strikeouts in their starts.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal has stolen 11 bases in 15 attempts in its first four games ... Freshman SCOTT WOODWARD leads the team with seven swipes in as many attempts ... Last season, Coastal was 65-of-89 in stolen bases ... DAVID SAPPELT belted his third career grand slam in the Chanticleers' opening day win over Maryland ... DOCK DOYLE knocked in the game-winning run Monday in the 10th inning against Virginia Tech.

HIGH POINT

High Point posted a season opening series victory over Big Ten foe Penn State ... The Panthers dropped the opener before pounding the Lions 14-1 in the second game of a doubleheader and then posted a come-from-behind 7-4 victory in the rubber game on Sunday ... HPU belted three homers in its win on Saturday ... Senior hurler BUBBA O'DONNELL recorded a career-best 12 strikeouts in Sunday's victory ... High Point is scheduled to play eight of its first 10 games at home this season, including a game with Campbell on Tuesday and a weekend set versus Dayton ... HPU will also play its first road game of the season on Wednesday at nationally-ranked Clemson.

LIBERTY

Liberty opened the season with three wins at the Clearwater Invitational in Clearwater, Fla. ... The Flames pitching staff keyed the weekend victories with a 2.00 team ERA. Liberty pitchers allowed 6 ER over 27 innings ... Liberty starters CLARENCE NICELY and DAVID STOKES had solid opening outings ... Nicely, in his first start in a Liberty uniform, allowed one run in six innings of work, earning the victory against Notre Dame ... Stokes was equally as strong, allowing no earned runs in 7.1 innings against lowa Sunday for the victory ... The Flames travel to Norfolk State on Wednesday, before hosting Rider for a three-game series on this weekend.

Presbyterian College opened its 2008 season by going 1-2 against UNC Asheville at the PC Baseball Complex ... The 4-2 win by PC in game two on Saturday was its first ever NCAA Division I victory ... Freshman **NATE HORTON** led PC in its first weekend, going 4-for-8 from the plate with 2 RBI ... **STEVEN HENRY** found a hit in each game in the three-game set, scoring one run and collecting a double.

ALEX GREGORY had his 16-game hitting streak snapped in game one against Davidson ... Both REGGIE KEEN and BEN TOTH had five hits in the second game versus Davidson ... It is Radford's first 2-1 start since 2000 ... RU scored 30 runs in three games and scored 20 runs in a game for the first time since March 4, 2006 vs. North Carolina A&T ... New head coach JOE RACCUIA's first victory in Highlander uniform ... Keen and Ben Toth each finished the weekend with eight hits, including two doubles and a home run ... ADAM HOYT pitched six scoreless innings in start versus Georgetown ... Freshman ABRAM WILLIAMS picked up his first collegiate save.

UNC Asheville took two out of three from Presbyterian on opening weekend ... ALAN DeRATT got the season started throwing seven no-hit innings in his first start ... JEREMY HALL allowed the only PC hit of the game with two out in the ninth inning ... REED KREISER and ELLIOTT ARRINGTON each had six hits on the weekend ... Arrington had two hits in all three games while Kreiser had three hits in game one and three hits in game three ... Kreiser had two home runs, a double, and drove in four runs on the weekend ... MICHAEL BOGAERT struck out a career-high nine Blue Hose while earning the win on Sunday ... This is the second time in the last three years that the Bulldogs opened the season with a victory.

VMI opened its season on post for the first time in 27 years, and defeated Lafayette 7-1, as senior TREY BARHAM and junior CHRIS HENDERSON combined to allow only one run while striking out 11 ...
