NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-2 this week, sweeping Jackson State at home, Tuesday, and going 1-2 against Liberty on the road. In the second game against Jackson State, senior pitcher BÉTHNEY REYNOLDSON was impressive with a single-game-record 17 strikeouts. She broke the old record of 16, which she herself set last season and tied earlier this season. Against Liberty, BSC dropped both games of Friday's doubleheader but rebounded with a 9-5 win on Saturday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs went 1-2 in the past week, winning the home portion of a home-and-home series with Coastal Carolina on Friday 4-3 while dropping both games of Sunday's doubleheader at Coastal, 8-1 and 3-2 ... After falling behind CCU 3-0 through 2 1/2 the Bucs fought back with three runs in the bottom of the third ... One of the key hits CCU 3-0 through 2 1/2 the Bucs fought back with three runs in the bottom of the third ... One of the key hits in the inning was a bunt single by JILL SHONDEL ... Shondel recently has become the all-time career hits leader in CSU softball history, surpassing A.J. ROBINSON'S previous record of 188 hits set just two years prior (Shondel currently has 192 hits in her career) ... ASHLEY CONWAY, GAIL MATSUSHIMA and TATJANA SLAWSON all drove in runs in consecutive at bats to even the score ... The Bucs then surged ahead with a two-out rally in the fifth inning, capped by a JENN BROOKS single to center field that allowed the go-ahead and eventual winning run to score ... Brooks is now batting .325 with runners in scoring position, one of the best averages on the team ... JAMIE WELLONS shut down Coastal the rest of the way to pick up her 11th win on the year ... The complete game pitching performance was also her 15th such performance of the season ... The win in game one of the series allowed CSU to post their first win over Coastal Carolina since the 2004 season ... Highlights from Sunday included Conway's third home run of the season, a team high, as well as MEGAN HALL hitting a runscoring double in game two for her 10th double on the season (in just 30 games) ... The game two one-run loss scoring double in game two for her 10th double on the season (in 115.1). It is again two one-run loss was CSU's third one-run loss in five Big South games thus far . This represents an increased level of competitiveness from the Bucs, as CSU only lost one game by less than three runs last season ... The Bucs will continue conference play this weekend when they host Radford beginning with a doubleheader on Friday ... Before that, however, CSU will travel to Buies Creek, N.C. to face Campbell University for a Tuesday doubleheader.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal concluded last week with a pair of wins over Charleston Southern Sunday, April 6 at the CCU Softball Field en route to winning the series with the Lady Bucs... Junior VERITY LONG-DROPPERT led CCU with a .462 hitting percentage, registering six hits in CCU's five games last week as she increased her hitting streak to 16 games... In the CCU-CSU series, Long-Droppert hit a two-run, third inning homer in both Game One and Game Three of the series... Meanwhile, junior KELSEY RIFFEL pushed her hitting streak to eight games, recording seven hits last week, and sophomore Alyssa Tornatore is currently on a seven-game hitting streak as she had six

Head coach PAUL WETMORE picked up his 400th career victory during the week, making him the 89th head coach in NCAA softball history to surpass the 400-career win plateau ... Liberty posted a 3-2 record during the week, its first winning week of the year, including a 2-1 mark in its first conference action of the season ... Liberty tied a program record by playing an 11-inning game against James Madison on Wednesday, eventually besting the Dukes, 5-4, in the home contest ... Liberty's 4-1 victory over Birmingham-Southern in the first game of a league doubleheader on Friday was the Lady Flames second win in a Big South opener over the last seven years ... During the second game, TIFFANI SMITH tossed her first collegiate shutout, 4-0, giving Wetmore the historic win ... Last week, ASHLEY WILLIAMS drove in a team-best six runs, making the senior Liberty's all-time career RBIs leader with 151 runs driven in ... Williams and BETH BENNETT both enter this week sporting lengthy hitting streak, as Williams has hit in seven-straight games and Bennett is holding a career-best, 11-game hitting streak ... Liberty will make up a rained out game against No. 12 Tennessee on Tuesday in Knoxville, Tenn., marking the sixth-straight year Liberty has tangled with the Vols on the softball diamond ... Liberty closes out the week with a non-conference tilt against Virginia at home on Wednesday, before hitting the road for three against Coastal Carolina over the weekend.

Presbyterian College softball split a doubleheader with Furman on Thursday afternoon at the PC Softball Complex. PC won game one, 5-1, while Furman took a 7-3 victory in game two ... The doubleheader was played in rainy conditions with the first game going into a rain delay four times ... The Blue Hose snapped a seasonhigh five-game losing streak with the game one victory over the Paladins ... The Blue Hose had seven hits in total in game one, while Furman had four. No PC player recorded more than one hit in game one ... Mary Gordon (Vernon, Conn.) claimed her seventh victory from the circle in game one. Gordon fanned four in seven innings ... PC was led in the second game by KATIE ANDERSON and LAURA TATE ... Anderson was 2-for-3 in the second game, while Tate was 2-for-4 with one RBI and one run scored.

RADFORD

Radford recieved its first ever top 25 vote last week in both the USA Today/NFCA and ESPN.com/USA Softball polls, ranking them tied for 34th and 37 respectively. Also, their game one victory over UNC Greensboro was their school record 10th, breaking the nine-game streak set last season. With a pair of wins this week, ASHLEY TAYLOR reached 70 caeer victories. She is now just five shy of breaking RU's career record. She also doubled once this week moving into fourth all-trne at RU. Senior CASSIE RHODES hit her 12th career triple this week, tying her for second at Radford. Freshman CHELSE KELLEY made a strong collegiate pitching, retireing three straight batters in the seventh inning against Winthrop on Saturday.

Winthrop is off to a good start at 5-1 in the league with all six games being played on the road ... STEPHANIE REID moved into second place on the Eagles all-time RBI list and is currently tied with LESLIE MCALISTER at 126 in a career ... MALLORY HOGAN has 32 RBI on the year and is now just one shy of her career-best of 33 in a single season. She did that in 66 games last season and has 32 RBI through 34 games this year.
