BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN
Birmingham-Southern went 1-4 this week, starting off with a win over Mobile in game one of a Tuesday doubleheader, but losing the next four games. In BSC's win against Mobile on Tuesday, senior pitcher BETHNEY REYNOLDSON broke her own single-season strikeout record, surpassing her record-breaking 2007 total of 221 with five strikeouts against the Lady Rams ... Winthrop swept the Panthers, shutting them out in all three games of the series. It was the first time that BSC has been shut out in a series since the Big South went to the three-game series in 2007. Junior MELISSA MUEHLENFELD kept her hitting streak alive, getting at least one hit in all five games to extend the streak to nine

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN
Though a difficult week for CSU overall, last week's series against Campbell and Radford did provide some highlights for JEFF AUMEND's squad ... For one, JILL SHONDEL continued to chase down some of the more notable records in CSU softball history ... the senior Floridian became CSU's all-time hits leader recently with 197 hits, surpassing the previous mark of 188 career hits held by A.J. ROBINSON (06) ... Also, with two doubles in the week, Shondel extended the new season (16) and career (44) doubles records that she has set this season ... In addition to setting a new record for outra base hits in a career (aurently has 61). Shondel is chasing down the record for most extra base hits in a seafor extra base hits in a career(currently has 61), Shondel is chasing down the record for most extra base hits in a sea-son ... The senior's 21 extra base hits in 2008 is one shy of the all-time season record of 22 set in 2001 by SAMANTHA MILLER ... A promising sign for the Bucs also was the production of freshman ERIN KEGLEY, who hit for a .750 average over the course of the week, including a key two-run double in the final game of CSU's series against Radford ... The Bucs battled in each and every game against Radford and were always in the contest in the middle innings, includ-The Bucs battled in each and every game against Radford and were always in the contest in the middle innings, including a 2-1 lead through the first four innings of play of game one of the series, but the Lady Highlander bats awakened tate in the games en route to two wins by a 6-2 scoreline and an 8-1 win over the weekend ... In that first game, the Bucs scored two runs and had four consecutive batters reach in the first inning against Big South pitcher of the year Ashley Taylor ... In their early week series, CSU fell by 5-2 and 5-4 scorelines to Campbell University ... MEGAN HALL had a big day against the Camels, an effort that helped her claim the team RBI lead for the week with four ... The one-run loss by CSU was their fourth one-run loss in their last six losses entering the Radford series ... The Bucs also saw a game two 3-2 lead over the Camels, which was built on the back of a second inning in which the team hit around, go by the boards ... The Bucs were able to tie the game in the seventh off an RBI single from Hall, but the Camels would retaliate with one in the bottom of the seventh to emerge victorious ... The Bucs' last week of games before exams takes place this week when CSU will welcome Lowcountry rival College of Charleston to Buccaneer Field for a doubleheader on Tuesday ... The Bucs and Cougars split an earlier series at the College of Charleston this season, with CSU winning game one 3-1 and CofC game two 4-0 ... Hall had two RBIs against the Lady Cougars and Shondel hit for an .800 average over the two games ... CSU then continues Big South play with a trip to Birmingham Southern for a series that will be contested this Friday and Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 2-4 last week, but won its Big South series over Liberty ... Both senior **ALLISON CANTRELL** and sophomore **ALICIA IRWIN** hit home runs during Coastal's mid-week games ... Cantrell had her home run in Game One against Gardner-Webb, while Irwin's blast came against South Carolina ... With its 3-2 Game One win over Liberty, Coastal now has eight comeback wins on the season.

LIBERTY
Liberty opened the week carrying on a six-year streak where the Lady Flames have squared off against Tennessee, falling twice to the No. 10 ranked program ... During the series with the Lady Vols, Tennessee has been nationally ranked 12 out of 13 times ... The Lady Flames had a pair of lengthy hitting streak come to an end during the week ... BETH BENNETT saw her career-best 17-game hitting streak come to an end on Sunday against Coastal Carolina ... The 17-game run was the longest by a Lady Flame over the past seven seasons ... senior ASHLEY WILLIAMS had her personal-best 11-game hitting streak come to an end during the first of three games against the Chanticleers over the weekend ... Bennett clocked her fourth home run of the year during the sixth inning against Coastal Carolina, giving Liberty its first road victory of the year on Saturday in a 1-0 win over the homestanding Chanticleers ... For the second-straight week, Liberty will play seven games over the next seven days ... Liberty will play all seven contests against foes from inside the Commonwealth ... The Lady Flames will host Longwood for two on Tuesday, before traveling to Blacksburg, Va., on Wednesday to face No. 19 Virginia Tech on Wednesday ... Following the doubleheader with the nationally ranked Hokies, Liberty has been invited to remain on campus and participate in a candlelight vigil in honor of the students who lost their lives one year ago during the tragedy on Virginia Tech's campus on April 16, 2007 ... Liberty will conclude the week by facing arch rival Radford in a split series ... The two squads will square off for two games in Radford on Saturday, followed by the series finale in Lynchburg on Sunday.

PRESBYTERIAN
RACHEL PARKER set the new program single season standard for home runs and the Blue Hose dominated Savannah State in their only games this week with a doubleheader sweep. The Blue Hose downed the Tigers 19-1 in game one before taking a 22-0 victory in game two ... Parker hit two home runs in total against Savannah State to end her day with 10 home runs on the season. The 10 home runs are currently the new program standard ... Prior to Friday, Parker was tied with former Blue Hose standouts AMANDA TEAL (2004) and JESSICA PETERKA (2004) for the program lead with eight home runs ... Parker was not the only Blue Hose softball player on Friday to utilize the long ball in PC's twinbill sweep of Savannah State ... TAYLOR STATEN concluded Friday with three home runs. She now has four on the 2008 season ... The Blue Hose are now 12-23 on the 2008 season ... They will next travel to Cullowhee, N.C. to square off against Western Carolina on Tuesday, April 15. First pitch in game one of the doubleheader is at 4 p.m. ... PC swept a doubleheader from WCU at the PC Softball Complex earlier this season ... RADFORD
With four wins last week, Radford reached 30 wins in a school record 41 games. It broke the mark of 46 games set in 2006. The Highlanders have also won their last 12 games away from home and are 27-7 away from Dedmon Center Field. With three victories last week, senior ASHLEY TAYLOR is three shy of breaking the career mark of 74 held by BRE FELIX (2004-07). Senior ASHLEY CARLSON moved into second on the career hits list at Charleston Southern and is 11 base knocks shy of breaking the career mark of 240 held by MELISSA PICKEL (1995-97,99). CASSIE RHODES' home run vs. North Carolina State moved her into a tie for third all-time at RU with 22. After being held to just nine hits in their doubleheader vs. NC State, the Highlanders exploded for 39 hits in their three-game series at Charleston Southern. They recorded three straight double-digit hit games for the second time this season and have a total of 11 on the season.

WINTINOT LISA KINGSMORE is riding a seven game hitting streak and she already has a career-best 20 game hit streak this season. She is currently batting .444 and has gotten atleast one hit in all but six games this year. She was 5-for-9 over the weekend with two HR and three RBI. Winthrop's pitching staff was very solid this past weekend not allowing a single run to cross the plate in its three-game series with Birmingham-Southern. MEGAN EVANS, IZZY TROTTIER and CARI WOOLDRIDGE combined to allow no runs, on nine hits (no extra base hits) while walking just two and striking out 27 in 19 innings of work.
