Kingsmore hit .500, drove in nine RBI and hit three home runs to lead Winthrop to a 5-0 record on the week. She posted two multi-hit games and two-multi RBI games and highlighted her week with two hits, a career-high five RBI, a double and a home run against Conference foe Coastal Carolina on April 19. She slugged 1.214 for the week and posted an on-base percentage of .529. She has homered in six of her last nine games and her batting average currently ranks among the top 20 in the country. The honor marks Kingsmore's second Player of the Week accolade this season

Taylor recorded 20 strikeouts and posted a 5-1 record in six appearances on the week. She tossed 29.1 innings and allowed just four earned runs to finish the week with a 0.95 ERA. The honor is Taylor's sixth Pitcher of the Week nod this season.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-1 this week at home, dropping a tough 2-1 decision to Samford, Wednesday, but sweeping Charleston Southern on Friday and Saturday. The conference sweep was the first time the Panthers have won or swept a three-game series since the league implemented the three-game series in 2007 ... Senior pitcher **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** made history in Friday's game, breaking the BSC career strikeout record in just two seasons. She now stands at 473 career strikeouts, 10 more than the old record. She also tied the career shutout record on Friday with her 19th career shutout ... Junior MELISSA MUEHLENFELD kept her hitting streak alive this week and has now gotten at least one hit in 13 straight games.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs began their week by defeating the College of Charleston for a second time this season, with this win coming by a 5-3 scoreline and in dramatic fashion ... The Lady Bucs were trailing 3-2 entering the bottom of the seventh against the Lady Cougars, but a JILL SHONDEL lead-off single ignited a rally that saw TATJANA SLAWSON tie the score with a two-out single ... The next batter, GAIL MATSUSHIMA, then brought the game to T conclusion with a home run down the left field line that sailed just inside the foul pole. The homer was the first for Matsushima in her CSU career ... It also helped move the Hawaii native into first place on the CSU RBI list with 25 on the season ... The win marked the first time since 2001 that CSU has beaten their Lowcountry rivals twice in the same season ... JAMIE WELLONS surrendered only four hits over seven innings pitched to record the win against the College ... Including her weekend performance against Birmingham Southern, Wellons has gone the distance in 18 of her 29 starts this season ... Shondel also had a notable week, as the senior set a new record for extra base hits in a season with her 23rd extra base hit in the weekend series against Birmingham Southern ... This season Shondel has already set new records for hits in a career (203)doubles in a season (18), doubles in a career (46) and extra base hits in a career (63) in addition to extra base hits in a season son ... Over the weekend in their fourth conference series of the year, the Bucs lost at Birminingham Southern by scorelines of 5-0, 3-2 and 4-1 ... The one-run loss in game two marked the fourth time this season that CSU has lost a Big South game by just one run ... The Lady Bucs will break for exams over the course of the next week before returning to the field on May 2, when CSU will host Liberty in their last Big South series of the regular season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal went 0-5 last week, falling at 15th-ranked North Carolina and then at Winthrop ... Freshman JESSICA SCOTT scored the Lady Chanticleers' only run of the week when she took advantage of a MICHELLE EVANS sacrifice fly during the sixth inning in the 3-f loss to Winthrop ... Coastal's regular season comes to an end this week with the Lady Chants traveling to NC State Wednesday, April 23 and then return to the CCU Softball Field to host Radford in a three-game series April 26-27 ... The final game of the Coastal-Radford series will be aired on

ASHLEY WILLIAMS continues to etch her name in Liberty's record books, as the senior became the program's all-time career hits leader during the week ... She has surpassed JESSICA MOORE's mark of 229 career hits ... Three of Williams' four hits during the week were home runs, giving her 40 round trippers for her career ... Williams needs two more games played. I liberty will conclude er Top 5 listing, as she currently ranks sixth in program history with 224 games played ... Liberty will conclude its 11-game stretch against in-state opponents this week with road doubleheaders at Hampton and Norfolk State on Tuesday and Wednesday ... The Lady Flames will welcome Big South leader Winthrop to town this weekend for a three-game set at the Liberty Softball Field, with Saturday's finale serving at Senior Day ... Liberty will honor a trio of players, as Williams, SHANNON MCKAIN and COURTNEY JOHNSON will be playing in their final home Big South series.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose snapped a season-high five-game losing streak with an 8-6 win in the second game of a double-header with Mercer on Sunday ... MARY GORDON hit a game-winning home run in the top of the seventh inning in the victory ... The Blue Hose end their 2008 season this week with three doubleheaders ... PC ends its year with two twinbills at the PC Softball Complex.

Radford bounced back from a pair of early week losses to No. 19 Virginia Tech by closing out the week with five straight wins. During that time, some team and individual records were broken. **ASHLEY TAYLOR**, who won five game this week, broke the career wins record with a pair of victories against Appalachian State on Thursday. She also set a new career games played and games started records against Appalachian State and Liberty, currently standing at 245 games and 243 starts. She also tied her career high mark in single-season wins with 23 is second most in a single season and just three shy of the school record of 26 ... ASHLEY CARLSON set the new career mark for at bats against Appalachian State and finished the week with 771. Carlson is also creaping in on a pair of career marks that have held up for several years. With nine hits last week, Carlson needs just two to break the career mark of 240 held by MELISSA PICKEL (1995-97,99). She also needs six stolen bases to break Suzie Rath's (1993-96) record of 94.

Junior LISA KINGSMORE had one heck of a week. She hit three home runs in six games, she reached 200 hits for her career, and had a career-best 5 RBI in a single game. She's homered in six of her last nine games and in that stretch she's had 14 RBI and raised her batting average 14 points to .449. STEPHANIE REID moved into second on Winthrop's all-time list this week with 214 hits and 126 RBI. Winthrop's scoreless streak was ended on Sunday by Coastal Carolina. The Eagles had recorded seven straight shutouts, a total of 41.0 innings. The Eagles held the Chanticleers scoreless for the first five in Sunday's game before finally allowing a run on a sacrifice fly in the sixth. (46.1 innings allowing no runs) During the seven straight shutouts, Winthrop pitching struck out 53 batters allowing just four walks and not a single extra base hit in the 41 innings
