Reynoldson notched 42 strikeouts and a 0.42 ERA to finish with a 4-1 record on the week. She tossed four complete games with two shutouts in the five-game span. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 6-3 this week, getting four wins on the road against Alcorn State and Mississippi Valley State, splitting with Belmont, and going 1-2 against Coastal Carolina in the opening Big South series for both teams. After the four road wins, BSC had won six straight games for its longest winning streak of the season.

A week highlighted by narrow losses saw the Bucs continue play against local rival the College of Charleston and open conference play against Winthrop in a three-game series over the weekend ... CSU recorded just its second victory over the College since 2001 in game one of a doubleheader on Wednesday, a 3-1 Buccaneer win ... JILL SHONDEL and MEGAN HALL both went two-for-three from the plate, with Hall twice connecting for runsoring doubles in the early going ... JAMIE WELLONS limited the Lady Cougars to just eight hits and one earned run over seven effective innings ... When combined with two complete games later in the week, Wellons' complete game total currently stands at 14 from 23 starts on the season ... CSU's offense would be neutralized over the next two games, as CofC bounced back with a 4-0 win in game two before Winthrop won the first game of its weekend series against the Bucs 5-0 ... In that game, Shondel set her third CSU record this season, following previous records for the most doubles and extra base hits in a career by setting a new record for the most doubles in a single season ... Shondel currently has 13 doubles with roughly a third of the season's schedule still to play ... the Bucs then lost two heartbreakers in the final two games against the Lady Eagles ... In game two of the series, JILL SHONDEL matched Winthrop pitcher Cari Wooldridge pitch for pitch through six shutout innings ... CSU did threaten to breakthrough by putting a runner on third in each of the fourth, fifth and sixth innings but could not break through with the game's opening run ... Winthrop's Mallory Hogan made CSU pay with a home run in the top of the seventh that handed the Lady Eagles a 1-0 win ... The final game of the series was a back and feath of the series. was a back-and-forth affair that saw the lead change several times and saw the game ultimately head for extra innings ... Once again, Winthrop made CSU pay for its inability to score base runners late in a game with a run in the eighth that secured a 5-4 victory for Winthrop ... JENN PARDUE did go for two-for-two with her second home run of the season in the final game against the Lady Eagles ... CSU returns to play against Presbyterian in a doubleheader at Buccaneer Field on Tuesday ... The Bucs will then face Coastal Carólina once at home on Friday before traveling to Conway to contest the final two games of the series on Sunday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 4-1 on the week, including sweeping a doubleheader from UNC Wilmington March 26 and taking two games from Birmingham-Southern ... Junior VERITY LONG-DROPPERT is currently riding an 11-game hitting streak, which started against Manhattan March 16 ... The Lady Chants won their first five-inning game of the season with a 12-4 game one win over UNC Wilmington ... In the 9-1 win over Birmingham-Southern, each Lady Chant registered at least one hit, including junior **KELSEY RIFFEL** with her first career home run.

Following a stretch where Liberty played 23 games over 25 days, the Lady Flames had their second-straight week with just one doubleheader ... The Lady Flames split the twinbill with UNC Greensboro in their first two games of the year at the Liberty Softball Field ... Liberty opened the doubleheader against the former Big South foe with a 1-0 victory, giving Liberty its third-straight and 12th home opening victory during head coach PAUL WETMORE's 15-year career ... A pair of sophomore powered Liberty during the 1-0 victory, as J'NAE JEFFERSON clocked her first home run of the year and DANA WHEELER went the distance, scattering four hits to pick up the win ... BETH BENNETT finished the doubleheader a combined 3-for-6, pushing the junior's hitting streak to six games ... Liberty hosts in-state foe James Madison on Wednesday before welcoming Birmingham-Southern on Friday and Saturday to open up Big South competition.

The Blue Hose fell in all four of their games last week ... PC started the week by falling in both games of a doubleheader with ETSU in Johnson City, Tenn. ... They then dropped two games to Longwood in what was supposed to be a three-game series, but was shortened to two games due to inclement weather in Farmville, Va. ... The Blue Hose will now next play Charleston Southern in a doubleheader on Tuesday, April 1 in Charleston, S.C. The first pitch in game one is scheduled for 3 p.m ... The twinbill will mark the fifth and sixth meetings between the two schools this season. PC and CSU enter the doubleheader 2-2 against one another on the year ... The doubleheader with CSU is the first of three doubleheaders next week for PC. The Blue Hose return home for the first time since March 22 to host Furman for a doubleheader at the PC Softball Complex on Thursday, April 3. First pitch in game one is scheduled for 2 p.m. ... The Blue Hose will then host Queens for a doubleheader on Sunday, April 6. The first pitch in game one is slated for 1 p.m. at the PC Softball Complex.

With a pair of doubleheader sweeps last week, Radford extended its winning streak to nine games, tying a school record ... Radford has run-ruled their opponents in four of the last five games. The Highlanders have scored 55 runs and recorded 61 hits in their last five games. During that stretch, RU has sent 10-plus batters to the plate in five different innings and a player has recorded two hits in an innning three times, twice by HOPE CREASY ... Radford's batting average has jumped 36 points (.259 to .295) in last eight games. After playing 31 games away from home, Radford will have its home opener on Tuesday against UNC Greensboro. It will begin a stretch of nine straight home games in a one-week stretch.

MALLORY HOGAN had a very good weekend for the Lady Eagles in helping them open up league play at 3-0. The most interesting hit she had all weekend was in the top of the seventh inning as she blasted a home run to give Winthrop a 1-0 win. However, in the process of hitting a home run, Hogan split her bat in half. MARK COOKE said the bat just broke off right in her hands ... Winthrop has won 12 of its last 15 games, which includes a sweep of Charleston Southern over the weekend. The Eagles have played their last five games on the road and six of their last eight. They will host South Carolina for one game on Wednesday before hitting the road again when they travel to Radford for three games on the weekend.
