NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers closed out the regular season this week on the road, losing three games to Radford to finish tied for fourth place in the conference standings with Liberty. Liberty gets the tiebreaker, so BSC earns the fifth seed in the upcoming tournament.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs were victorious in their post-exam return to the field, as CSU overcame conference foe Liberty 5-3 in the first game after the 13-day layoff ... JAMIE WELLONS recorded her 13th win of the year (and her second win in conference play) as well as her 19th complete game of the season in the victory ... the junior pitcher limited the Lady Flames to just one run through the first 6 2/3 innings before Liberty mustered a late rally ... meanwhile, offensively, the Bucs broke through with five runs in the game's first four innings against Liberty starter TIFFANI SMITH ... The biggest outburst came in the third inning, an inning in which CSU scored three runs ... LISA RICE put the Bucs ahead for good with a run-scoring single while freshman ERIN KEGLEY drove in two runs in the win ... Rice's strong weekend from the plate moves her batting average in conference games to .353, tops on the team ... The win makes CSU the Bucs 16-5 this year when scoring four or more runs and 13-4 in 2008 when allowing three runs or less ... The win over the 2007 Big South regular season co-champions marks the first time CSU had defeated Liberty since the 2004 season ... The Bucs would fall in the final two games of the series against the Lady Flames, dropping the second game of Friday's doubleheader 7-0 and a single game on Saturday 12-3 ... CSU's eight seniors were honored in a ceremony just before their final game at Buccaneer Field ... One of those seniors, JILL SHONDEL, picked up two hits on the weekend to move within three hits of the single season hits record (currently has 66, record is 69), while another senior, ASHLEY CONWAY, lead the Bucs from the plate on the weekend in going three-for-eight with a double and an RBI ... The Bucs will look to post a win for the second season in a row in the Big South Championships, which will begin on Thursday ... CSU's first opponent will be the Coastal Carolina Lady Chanticleers, whom CSU defeated once this season at home (4-3) and whom the Lady Bucs narrowly lost to (3-2) in the final ga

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina did not play this past week ... The Lady Chanticleers are the third-seed in the Big South Conference Tournament and will face sixth-seeded Charleston Southern... According to the NCAA Statistics of games through April 27, junior **BRITTANY BIRNBAUM** is the nation's leader in sacrifice hits with .46.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames posted a 4-1 record during their final regular-season week of the year ... Opened the week with a sweep over future Big South foe Gardner-Webb, including a 5-4, nine-inning victory in the squad's final home game of the year ... During the extra-inning affair, Liberty belted three solo home runs to tie the game, while claiming victory with a J'NAE JEFFERSON single in the bottom of the ninth ... Liberty's bats exploded over the weekend in its series against Charleston Southern, as the Lady Flames tallied 35 hits and 22 runs to claim the regular-season finale series ... 12 of the 35 hits fell for extra bases, including eight doubles ... The Lady Flames will open the 2008 Big South Softball Championship against No. 5 seed Birmingham-Southern on Thursday ... Liberty has posted a 2-0 record in previous tournament appearances against the Panthers, claiming a pair of one-run victories.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College completed the season sweep of Savannah State on Senior Day at the PC Softball Complex with a pair of shutouts over the Tigers. The Blue Hose won 15-0 and 10-0 on Friday ... With the two victories on Friday afternoon, PC ended the year outscoring the Tigers by a 66-1 margin in the four contests between the two teams ... The doubleheader sweep completed PC's first season of NCAA Division I softball with PC owning a 17-30 overall record ... PC finished the season with four series sweeps, three of which came on its home turf ... Overall, PC was 11-6 at home ... The Blue Hose also ended the year on a three-game winning streak ... They also were 5-5 in their final 10 games of the year ... RACHEL PARKER hit one home run against Savannah State to end the year with a program-best 12 home runs ... Parker finished the season with a .354 batting average ... She was one of three Blue Hose to hit better than .354 in 2008 ... Katie Anderson led the Blue Hose with a .356 batting average, while Laura Tate hit .355 ... Mary Gordon led PC from the circle by acquiring 12 of PC's 17 victories

RADFORD

Radford concluded its regular-season with a school record 45 wins as well as a school record 13 Big South victories ... **ASHLEY CARLSON** broke the career steals mark with her 95th on Saturday vs. Birmingham-Southern. She also moved into second on the Big South career steals list ... **ASHLEY TAYLOR** set a new single-season win record with her 27th vs. BSC on Saturday and moved into fifth on the Big South's single season wins list with her 28th in game two. Taylor also tied a single-game home run record with two on Saturday. It was the third time she has done so in her career.

WINTHROP

Junior right fielder LISA KINGSMORE moved up to 9th nationally with her .459 batting average. The three-year starter is looking to become just the third player in school history to finish with a .400 or better average in a single season (135 at-bats or more). She is ranked 16th nationally with a .522 on-base percentage. As of today she is 49 points higher than the current single-season record held by CHRISTINE YON (.410) set in 1995 ... Sophomore pitcher MEGAN EVANS now has 38 career victories and is currently ranked 7th on the school's all-time list. She is also in the top 10 all-time for total strikeouts with 289 (6th). She is currently 38th nationally with a 1.32 ERA.


