NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-2 this week at the 2008 Big South Conference Softball Championship, upsetting No. 4 Liberty in the first game, 2-1, but falling to top-seeded Winthrop, 3-2, and then losing to No. 3 Coastal Carolina, 1-0, in eight innings. Seniors **LINDSAY CREIGHTON**, **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON**, and **GRACE STOKES**, and junior **MELISSA MUEHLENFELD** all earned Second-Team All-Conference honors, and Creighton was named to the All-Academic Team.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs season came to an end with two hard-fought two-run losses at the Big South Championships ... CSU fell in its opener, 3-1 to Coastal Carolina, before being eliminated from the tournament courtesy of a 5-3 loss to Liberty ... The Lady Bucs out-hit the Lady Chants in the opening game nine to four, but CSU could not overcome a first inning three-run home run from Coastal ... **JAMIE WELLONS** recorded her 20th complete game of the season in the loss, while senior **JENN BROOKS** went two-for-four from the plate ... Seniors and Second Team All-Conference selections **JILL SHONDEL** and **ASHLEY CONWAY** each made an impression in CSU's season-ending loss to the Lady Flames ... Conway connected on her fourth home run of the season in the first to put CSU ahead 1-0, while Shondel added her third homer in the fifth as part of a CSU rally that saw the Bucs place the game-tying run on second in the sixth inning ... Conway's homer gave her the team lead in both home runs (four) and RBIs (26) on the season ... Shondel's homer was her 68th hit of the season, leaving her just one off of the single season record for hits in a season ... The Florida native, who also set single season records for doubles (19) and extra base hits (25) in a season this year, concludes her CSU career as CSU's all-time leader in doubles (47), extra base hits (65) and hits (207) in a career ... CSU's season ends at a final record of 18-41, a three-game improvement over last season's 15-44 mark

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina ended the season with a 20-40 overall mark... Junior **VERITY LONG-DROPPERT** was named to the All-Tournament Team after 3-for-9 with 5 RBI in Coastal's four games and blasting two multi-run homers in the Lady Chants' first two games (vs. Charleston Southern and Radford)... Long-Droppert became the Coastal's single-season hit by a pitch leader in the game against Liberty as she was hit by a pitch for the 11th time this season... Long-Droppert's 11 hit by pitches is ties CCU's career record, joining current assistant coach Sarah Lockett and Susette Stone... Junior **BRITTANY BIRNBAUM** picked up her 27th sacrifice bunt of the season in the game against Birmingham-Southern, which ranks third among Coastal's single-season leaders... She still leads the nation in sacrifice hits according to the NCAA Statistics with games played through May 4... Off the field, Birnbaum received a pair of academic honors... She was named to the Big South All-Academic Team May 7 and then selected ESPN the Magazine First Team Academic All-District 3 University Division, which now she can be considered for ESPN the Magazine Academic All-America honors.

LIBERTY

Liberty closed out the year on its most successful run of the season, winning 11 out of its last 17 games ... The Lady Flames made their fourth appearance in the Big South Softball Championship title game on Saturday, moving Liberty into a tie for third most championship game appearances in Big South history ... Prior to the Championship, **ASHLEY WILLIAMS** was named to the Big South second-team all-conference team, making her the first Liberty player in program history to be named to an all-conference team all four years of her career ... Williams finished up her career as Liberty's all-time leader in games played (241), games started (239 - tied), at bats (781), hits (249), doubles (52) and RBI (168), while ranking second with 44 home runs.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College completed the season sweep of Savannah State on Senior Day at the PC Softball Complex with a pair of shutouts over the Tigers. The Blue Hose won 15-0 and 10-0 on Friday ... With the two victories on Friday afternoon, PC ended the year outscoring the Tigers by a 66-1 margin in the four contests between the two teams ... The doubleheader sweep completed PC's first season of NCAA Division I softball with PC owning a 17-30 overall record ... PC finished the season with four series sweeps, three of which came on its home turf ... Overall, PC was 11-6 at home ... The Blue Hose also ended the year on a three-game winning streak ... They also were 5-5 in their final 10 games of the year ... **RACHEL PARKER** hit one home run against Savannah State to end the year with a program-best 12 home runs ... Parker finished the season with a .354 batting average ... She was one of three Blue Hose to hit better than .354 in 2008 ... Katie Anderson led the Blue Hose with a .356 batting average, while Laura Tate hit .355 ... Mary Gordon led PC from the circle by acquiring 12 of PC's 17 victories.

RADFORD

ASHLEY TAYLOR was named to the Louisville Slugger All-Southeast Region Second Team ... **ASHLEY CARLSON** will continue her softball career after earning a roster spot with the Chicago Bandits of the National Pro Fastpitch League ... Radford finished 2008 with the best record in school history at 46-15 (.754) as well as its highest RPI at 49. They ended the regular season with the 11th most wins in Division I and held the third longest current winning streak of 16 games. RU also had the 10th best road record in the country and were 34-11 away from home (neutral and away games). Numerous team and individual records were set this season. As a team, Radford record school records in batting average (.307), home runs (57), wins, winning percentage, slugging percentage (.486) and on base percentage (.361). The on base record broke a mark that held for 12 years. Individually, Taylor broke the single-season wins record with 29 and also leaves with every career pitching record. Ashley Carlson leaves with the hits and stolen bases career records. **KRISTEN SHIFFLETT** broke the single-season hit by pitches record with 12. **VICKI MADDEN** set RU's freshman record with 11 home runs and a .689 slugging percentage and was second in on base percentage. **SHANNON KEEFE** was right behind her with 10 home runs and a .675 slugging percentage, second most for a freshman. Radford's freshmen class was a huge key to its success. The freshmen were second third and fifth in batting average. Madden and Keefe led them in home runs with 11 and 10. Shifflett hit a team best 15 doubles. Madden and Keefe led RU in slugging and on base percentage. Lauren Williams was second on the team with 15 stolen bases and scored 23 runs. Pitching wise, **REBECCA WHALLEY** was 11-5 with a 2.89 ERA. **KELLIE SNOOKS** was 4-0 with a 2.13 ERA and a save. **CHELSEA KELLEY** was 2-0.

WINTHROP

LISA KINGSMORE turned in the best batting average in school history as she finished the season at .448. She became the first player in school history to achieve 74 or more hits in a single season twice. She was named Louisville Slugger Southeast First Team All-Region and picked up NFCA Second Team All-America honors. During the regular season Kingsmore played in nine games against teams that made the NCAA Tournament and she finished with a .467 average in those games. She's only the third player in school history to finish with a .400 average or better in two seasons and the first since **CHRISTINE YON** did it in 1995 and 1996 ... In addition to Kingsmore, **CARI WOOLDRIDGE** was also named a Louisville Slugger South East All-Region selection as she was voted to the Second Team. Wooldridge was a Second Team All-Big South selection as well as the Big South Tournament's Most Valuable Player for the second straight year ... Senior **STEPHANIE REID** finished her career as one of the all-time offensive leaders in school history. She will leave as the all-time leader in at-bats (744). She leaves ranked second in total hits (225), home runs (23), and RBI (131). She is fourth in runs (144), eighth in doubles (32), third in total bases (340) and third in stolen bases (49) ... As of May 19, she will finish among the Top 10 in Big South history for career runs.

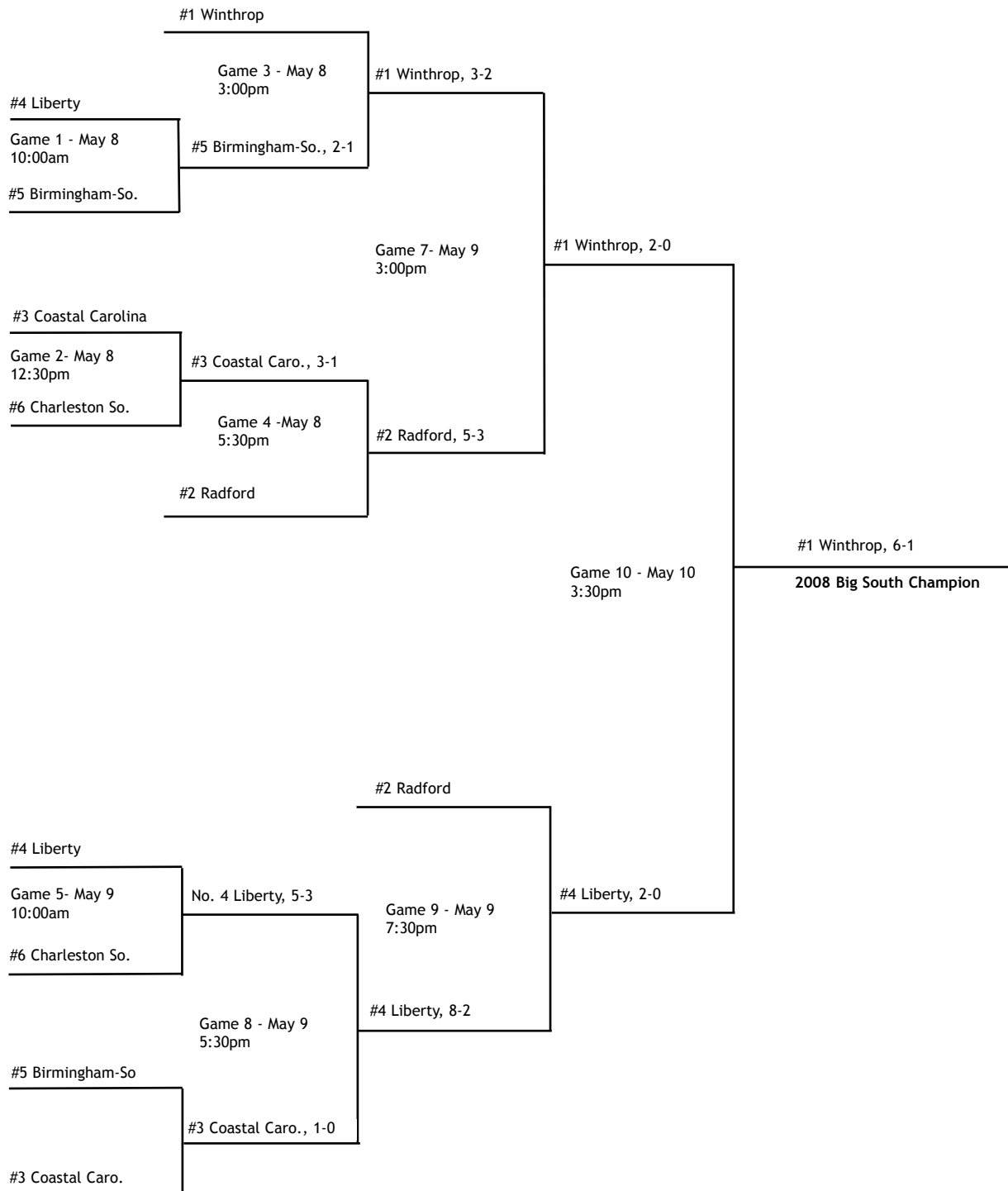
