Shifflett batted .556 to help her team to a 4-0 record to win the Virginia Cavalier Classic over the weekend. She recorded two multihit games during the week, highlighted by three RBI, a double and a triple against Georgetown on March 22. For the week, Shifflett drove in four runs and notched five hits, two triples, one double and a 1.111 slugging percentage. She also drew three walks to finish the week with a .667 on-base percentage. In the field, she was perfect as she recorded seven assists and three put-outs.

# NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Ashley Taylor • Senior Radford Danville, Va.

Taylor posted a perfect 3-0 record and a 0.40 ERA to earn her third Big South Player of the Week nod this season. She got her week started with a complete game shutout with six strikeouts against Rutgers on March 20. The next day against Ohio, Taylor came in the seventh inning with one out and induced a double-play to preserve the 2-1 win and pick up her fifth save of the season. Against Virginia later that day, Taylor pitched seven innings, mowed down 12 Cavalier hitters and allowed just one earned run. She closed her weekend out with 3.2 shutout innings and eight strikeouts in Radford's win over Georgetown. Taylor also broke the Radford career stikeout record against the Hoyas as she now has 726 in her career. Taylor recorded 26 stikeouts in the fourgame span and finished with just one earned run in 17.1 innings pitched.

#### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### **BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN**

The Panthers went 2-2 this week at the Mercer Easter Classic, falling to Harvard and Mercer, each by one run, on Friday, and defeating Arkansas-Pine Bluff twice on Saturday by scores of 16-3 and 9-1. Sophomore **DIAMOND JORDAN**, junior **ANNE LAWRENCE**, and senior pitcher **BETHNEY REYNOLDSON** were all named to the All-Tournament Team of the Classic.

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs posted a 3-1 week in the last week, defeating Charlotte 2-0 and Towson 8-0 in a single-day, three-team event at home on Tuesday before finishing the week by splitting a double-header at future Big South foe Presbyterian ... The Tuesday sweep allowed CSU to post its first undefeated day in which the Bucs have played multiple games all season long ... The key to the victories was pitching, as JAMIE WELLONS and SONDRA VETTER pitched CSU's second and third shutouts of the year ... Wellons was the first to shine, pitching seven innings of scoreless ball against Charlotte, the school from which she transferred to CSU ... On the day, Wellons allowed only three hits and one walk while striking out three Lady 49er batters ... In the next game, Vetter pitched exceptionally in the first start of her CSU career ... The freshman allowed only two hits while striking out two batters to provide CSU a 2-0 edge through 4 1/2 innings ... The Buc offense then broke out with six runs in the bottom of the fifth to bring the game to a close ... CSUs offense kept the good times rolling over the weekend, pounding out 24 hits and 15 runs in two games against the Lady Blue Hose ... The offensive heroics were not quite enough to rally CSU to victory in the first game, as PC held on for an 8-6 victory ... In the second game, however, the Bucs climbed out of an early 4-1 hole by scoring four times in both the fifth and sixth innings, allowing CSU to post a 9-7 victory ... Vetter also recorded the win in the second game against PC by neutralizing the Blue Hose over three innings of relief ... Offensive highlights included JILL SHONDEL recording the 12th double of the season, allowing her to tie the record for doubles in a single season by a CSU player with a little less than half the season to play ... GAIL MATSUSHIMA and JENN BROOKS both had prolific weekends from the plate for Jeff Aumend's squad, as each hit .500, with Matsushima driving in seven runs and Brooks four ... Brooks lead CSU in slugging percentage (.750) and on base p

#### COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 2-2 last week, playing doubleheaders against Presbyterian (March 20) and Georgia Tech (March 22) ... The Lady Chanticleers played in their third 10-inning game of the season as they opened the week with a 6-5 come-from-behind 10-inning win over Presbyterian ... The 10-inning game was CCUs first 10-inning win since a 2-1 10-inning win over UNC Charlotte in 1991 ... Both junior VERITY LONG-DROPPERT and sophomore LAICOLE WALKER hit home runs last week. ... Walker recorded her first of the season with a solo shot in game one versus Presbyterian ... Long-Droppert had her team-leading third of the season in game two against Georgia Tech.

#### LIBERTY

Following a stretch where Liberty played 12 games over eight days, the Lady Flames had a lighter run last week as their doubleheader on Monday closed out their annual spring break trip and accounted for the team's only two games of the week ... Despite pounding out a season-best nine hits, Liberty couldn't squeeze across a run in the first game, falling to St. Louis, 1-0, in the opener held at the National Training Center in Clermont, Fla. ... Liberty's bats stayed hot in the second game, collecting eight hits which led to three runs to help the squad record a 3-0 victory ... the win snapped Liberty's 13-game losing streak, the longest-such run in program history ... Sophomore DANA WHEELER struck out 10 batters, her second-highest total of the year, while scattering five hits during the complete-game victory ... During the last four games of Liberty's spring break trip, the Lady Flames tallied 29 hits (7.25 per game), as compared to 28 hits during the first 10 games (2.8 per game) ... Liberty has another light slate ahead of them this week, with just one doubleheader on the schedule ... Former Big South foe UNC Greensboro will travel to Lynchburg on Tuesday to open up the home portion of Liberty's 2008 schedule.

#### **PRESBYTERIAN**

Presbyterian College was 1-5 last week in a week in which they faced off against all future Big South Conference opponents ... Including the doubleheader with future conference foe Gardner-Webb, PC is now 3-7 against Big South teams in 2008 ... PC ended its week by splitting with CSU at the PC Softball Complex ... The Blue Hose and Buccaneers will play six times in 2008 and the teams are currently 2-2 against one another in 2008 ... RACHEL PARKER hit successfully in all six of PC's games last week.

#### RADFORD

Radford won the Cavalier Classic last week, winning all four games. The Highlander pitching staff was key, allowing just three runs, one earned, and only 12 hits in 26 innings. Opponents batted just .136. Radford also batted .374 and scored 25 runs ... Senior ASHLEY TAYLOR broke the career strikeout record (726) vs. Georgetown on Saturday. With her eighth punch out of the game in the fourth innning, she surpassed BRE FELIX (2004-07), who just set the mark last season. Against Georgetown, Radford recorded a season high 14 runs and 15 hits. Radford batted around twice ... Five players recorded multiple hit games, including freshman LAUREN WILLIAMS, who registered two bunt hits in the bottom of the fourth. Radford reached 20 wins faster than any other team in softball program in school history.

#### WINTHROP

Winthrop extended its win streak to a season-best nine games before falling in the second game of the double-header with Georgia Tech ... The Eagles will look to start a new streak at North Carolina State on Wednesday ... This past week STEPHANIE REID became just the fifth player in school history to reach 200 hits for a career. She was 3-for-6 in the double-header with Georgia Tech ... LISA KINGSMORE has 41 hits on the season, despite the Eagles having seven games canceled due to bad weather. She is nearly halfway to her season total in 2007. She has now moved into 10th on Winthrop's all-time list with 179 in her career ... Fellow outfielder TESSA THOMAS is now 8th with 190 career hits. Thomas has also moved into 4th all-time with 127 career runs.
