NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC went 4-3 this week, defeating Mid-Continent twice at home and defeating Drake and George Mason but losing to Central Florida, No. 12 Michigan, and Aubum at the UCF Tournament. Seniors LINDSAY CREIGHTON and GRACE STOKES led the Panthers with nine hits apiece, and both hit .429 for the week. Junior Anne Lawrence led with six RBI. Senior BETHNEY REYNOLDSON led the Panthers in the circle with a 3-1 record, recording 36 strikeouts in 22.2 innings and a .182 opponent batting average.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs recorded a 2-3 week in the past week, defeating Mt. St. Mary's 7-1 and Delaware State 9-0 at UNCWs Seahawk Classic, and falling to Tennessee Tech 3-1 at home and Lehigh (5-0) and UNCW (4-1) at the classic ... In the week's opener against Tennessee Tech, pitcher JAMIE WELLONS had a no hitter going into the seventh inning ... The performance combined with Wellons' no-hit shutout of nationally-ranked Virginia Tech gave her 13 consecutive innings of scoreless ball ... TTU would rally for three runs in the 7th before a Buc rally in the bottom of the inning would come up short, resulting in the 3-1 loss ... After dropping their opener in the classic to Lehigh, the Bucs rebounded Saturday with a 9-0 cruise by Delaware State in five innings ... The Buc offense busted loose early against the Hornets, scoring three runs in the first inning before tacking five more on in the fourth ... 2B JENNIFER BROOKS keyed the offense against Del. State, going 2 for 4 with 3 RBIs ... Pitchers JILL SHONDEL, CAITLIN ALLEN and SONDRA VETTER (career debut) combined to shutout the Hornets ... On Sunday, the Bucs won their opener 7-1 over Mt. St. Mary's before falling to host UNCW 4-1 to conclude the tournament ... ASHLEY CONWAY went 2 for 3 against Mt. St. Mary's with a double and CSU's first home run on the season ... Conway has hit safely in each of CSU's nine games thus far this season and currently holds a hitting streak of 15 games dating back to last season ... Wellons recorded her second win of the season against Mt. St. Mary's, shutting down the Mountaineer offense which could muster just one run in the seventh and final inning against the Bucs ... The Bucs have a busy week ahead of them, with double-headers vs. Furman and @ USC Upstate preceding the CSU Lady Bucs College Softball Invitiational, which will take place this upcoming Friday and Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

CCU went swept Hampton in a Sunday doubleheader at the CCU Softball Field... In the first game, the Lady Chants scored all five of its runs in the fifth inning... With the game tied 1-1, Junior VERITY LONG-DROPPERT smashed a grand slam to center field that allowed Coastal to take the 5-1 lead and ultimately win ... CCU recorded its first shutout of the season with a 3-0 win in the second game ... Sophomore ASHLEY FREDERICK threw all seven innings for her seventh complete game of the season and allowed just one hit.

LIBERTY

Liberty opened the 2008 season posting a 1-2-1 record at the College of Charleston Cougar Classic ... The Lady Flames tied Tennessee Tech, 2-2, in their first game, as the game was called after six innings of play ... AMBER DEPAQUALE hit her first collegiate home run to tie the game in the bottom of the sixth inning just minutes for the game was halted ... The tie was the second in program history, as the Lady Flames also recorded a tie in 1983 ... Liberty's victory during the event was a 7-0 shutout victory over Kennesaw State ... DANA WHEELER picked up the victory, allowing just one hit over seven innings of work, fanning a career-best 12 batters ... Liberty returns action on Wednesday when the Lady Flames travel to Knoxille, Tenn., to face No. 5 Tennessee in Liberty's first doubleheader of the year ... The contest will mark the fifth-straight season the Lady Flames and the Lady Vols have met on the softball diamond ... The past four years, Tennessee has been nationally ranked, including No. 1 last year and No. 2 in 2006 ... Later in the week, Liberty will return to Greenville, N.C., for the Pirate Clash for the weekend ... The Lady Flames have frequented the tournament three out of the last four years.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian College took both games of a doubleheader with North Greenville on Saturday afternoon at the PC Softball Complex. PC won game one 10-1 and then followed that up with a 5-2 victory in game two ... The two wins give PC its first doubleheader sweep of the season and improve the Blue Hose to 3-7 on the 2008 season. The Crusaders dropped to 1-6 on the year with the two losses ... PC has now won four consecutive games between the two schools to hold a commanding 19-5 all-time series advantage. PC has not lost to the Crusaders at home since 1999 ... Two Blue Hose are currently batting better than .400 in KATIE ANDERSON (.412) and RACHEL PARKER (.458) ... Parker leads PC with three home runs.

RADFORD

Radford is off to its best start in school history after two weeks on play. The Highlanders are 8-3 after a 3-2 weekend at the Littlewood Classic, hosted by Arizona State. At the tournament, freshman **SHANNON KEEFE** hit her first collegiate home run against Buffalo. Sophomore **HOPE CREASY** hit her first two home runs of the season last weekend, including one against No. 2 Arizona State. Also, freshman **KELLIE SNOOKS** picked up her first win in her first collegiate appearance. **CASSIE RHODES** scored five runs last weekend, moving into fourth on RU's career list with 116 and needs three more for third.

WINTHROP

STEPHANIE REID has 5 RBI on the season and has moved into third all-time in Winthorp history with 112 career RBI. TESSA THOMAS has 11 runs in 11 games and has moved into 9th on Winthrop's all-time list with 109 career runs. Head Coach MARK COOKE is just five wins away from 600 for his career. He reached his 450th victory in 2004 and reached his 500th victory at home vs. Furman on April 21, 2005. He coached his 1,000th career game in the Big South Conference Tournament on May 12, 2006 in a 4-3 victory over Birmingham-Southern.
