NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC went 0-2 this week at the Kennesaw State Owl Classic, losing to Kent State, 4-0, and the host Owls, 1-0, in eight innings on Sunday after Saturday's games were rained out.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU went 1-4 over the weekend at the 2008 Lowcountry Invitational, which the Lady Bucs hosted this weekend on CSU's campus ... The Lady Bucs lone win was a 6-4 win in their tournament opener against eventual Invitational champion Towson ... JILL SHONDEL got the CSU offensive attack going early, homering in CSU's first at bat of the game and then tripling in a third inning that would eventual produce two CSU runs ... The two extra base hits allowed Shondel to establish a new CSU program record for extra base hits in a career with 55 ... A back-and-forth game ensued, with the game tied at four through the completion of 6 1/2 innings ... CSU would then win the game in the bottom of the seventh when MEGAN HALL ripped a walk-off, two run home run over the right field wall ... Hall lead the team with seven hits, five runs scored and four RBIs at the Invitational ... The performance earned Hall All-Tournament team honors at the Invitational ... Hall, who had a perfect fielding percentage during the Invitational, also scored both CSU runs in the Bucs' Saturday game against Notre Dame ... Hall singled in BRITTANY GIANNINI in the third and then, following a Notre Dame fielding error on the same play, motored around the bases to score and give CSU what was a 2-0 lead at that time ... JAMIE WELLONS recorded the win against Towson, pitching seven innings and surrendering six hits, four earned runs and two walks while striking out two batters ... The win was her eighth on the season ... Wellons has now started 18 of CSU's 32 games on the year and has recorded 10 complete games ... The Bucs will face three opponents whom they have already faced this season this week ... CSU will face Towson once more Tuesday as part of a three-team, one-day event ... Charlotte will also participate in the event ... The 49ers defeated CSU 5-1 earlier this season ... The Bucs will two games earlier this season at the Green & White Classic in Charlotte, N.C., with Presby winning the first game 5-2 and CSU rebounding to win the second game 8-5.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina went 3-1 on the week ... Among CCU's wins were a pair at the shortened Owl Classic in Kennesaw, Ga., where the Lady Chanticleers defeated Manhattan 4-3 in eight innings and Alabama State 6-2 ... Coastal's only loss of the week came in game one in the doubleheader against USC Upstate as the Lady Chants fell 1-0 in 10 innings, marking the second time this season CCU has played a 10-inning game and the first time in program history in which the Lady Chants have played multiple 10-inning games in a season ... Three Lady Chants hit .500 or above at the Owl Classic with junior VERITY LONG-DROPPERT hitting a team-best .714 (5-for-7) with three RBI ... Juniors BRITTANY BIRNBAUM and KELSEY RIFFEL each hit .500 at the tournament with Birnbaum going 4-for-8 with two RBI and Riffel going 3-for-6 and scoring two runs ... On the week, Birnbaum led the Lady Chants with a .538 batting average, going 7-for-13 with four RBI ... Birnbaum also hit the game-winning single in the second game against USC Upstate to drive in both Mecaela Ballard and Riffel and give CCU the 6-5 lead ... In the pitching circle, ASHELY FREDERICK threw complete games in both of CCU's extra inning games as well as came in for the final third in game two against USC Upstate for 18.1 innings pitched.

LIBERTY

After finishing its first 18 games in regulation or less, Liberty finished off the week playing in three extra inning contests ... The Lady Flames are in the midst of a 12-game losing streaking, tying a program record for consecutive loss (also set in 1994) ... On Wednesday, Liberty squared off against No. 14 Baylor, dropping an 8-0 decision to the nationally ranked Lady Bears ... The contest against Baylor marked the sixth-consecutive year Liberty has faced at least one nationally ranked program ... In its final game of the week, **DANA WHEELER** walked a batter in the first inning against Dartmouth, snapping a 35-inning streak during which the lefty had not walked a batter ... The walk was just her second in 48 1/3 innings of work this year, as compared to 61 strikeouts ... Liberty's pitchers have pitched well enough to win of late, surrendering three or few runs during six of its last seven contests ... Liberty will end its Florida Spring Break swing with a non-conference doubleheader against St. Louis in Clermont, Fla., on Monday ... Following the twinbill, Liberty will have eight days off before open its 2008 home slate against James Madison on March 25.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose did not play a game last week ... They have three doubleheaders this week against future Big South Conference opponents ... They are currently 2-2 against Big South teams in 2008, splitting with Liberty and Charleston Southern in regular season tournaments this season.

RADFORD

After having last week's competition lost due to different types of weather problems, Radford went down to Clearwater, Fla. and went 4-2. The Highlanders recorded three shutouts and defeated two team that reached the 2007 NCAA Tournament. Two wins came against the Big Ten and one against the BIG EAST. **SARAH HIMAN** had her nine-game hitting streak snapped against UMass, but during that time she batted .500 (14-28) with three doubles, a home run and 10 RBI. **ASHLEY TAYLOR** tossed two shutouts in Florida, setting a new school record with 21. She broke the old mark of 20 held by Bre Felix (2004-07). Radford was shutout for the first time this season. It took 21 games, but UMass held them scoreless in a 1-0 game during the USF Under Armour Classic. **CASSIE RHODES** hit three home runs last week, bringing her total to seven, tying a career high. She also hit two vs. Rutgers, tying a single-game school record.

WINTHROP

Winthrop picked up its 8th straight win after defeating North Carolina A&T 12-2 on Sunday to capture the Winthrop/adidas Invitational. Megan Evans was named the MVP Pitcher of the tournament and LISA KINGSMORE was named the Offensive MVP. STEPHANIE REID had a solid weekend and continued to climb the all-time lists in some offensive categories. Reid moved up to third on the all-time runs list and is now third in total bases. She is now just three hits shy for 200 in her career. Only four players in school history have reached that mark. TESSA THOMAS is moving up the all-time lists herself as she is now fourth all-time in runs, just three behind Reid. She is just 12 hits shy of the 200 hit mark. She also moved up to sixth on the doubles list and is now eighth in RBI and just five away from the 100 mark.
