LIBERTY, STONY BROOK KICKOFF 2008 SEASON WITH HOME WINS

Big South preseason favorite Liberty University won its fifth consecutive season opener this past Saturday, a 49-10 win over North Greenville. It was the Flames' sixth consecutive win, dating back to last season, as well as their ninth-straight home victory, which is the third-longest home winning streak in Big South history and currently tied with Dayton for the longest in FCS. Meanwhile, Big South newcomer Stony Brook also won its season opener, a resounding 42-26 win over Colgate, and has now won its last six home games.

MORE ON THE 1-0 TEAMS

As mentioned above, Liberty is 1-0 for the fifth-straight season, and is looking to start 2-0 for the third time in head coach **DANNY ROCCO's** three seasons. The Stony Brook Seawolves are 1-0 for the second consecutive year, and is looking to open the season 2-0 for the first time since last season and sixth time overall. Liberty is 1-0 for the 18th time in school history, while Stony Brook is 1-0 for the 13th time in its 25-year football history.

WELCOME MAT

For the first time since 2003, the Big South has new teams in the League this year in Stony Brook and Presbyterian. The Seawolves won their first game as a League member this past Saturday, while the Blue Hose fell in its first official game as a Big South member at #13 Wofford. New football members are now 4-4 in their Big South debut. In the Big South's inaugural season of 2002, Gardner-Webb and Elon both won, while Charleston Southern and Liberty both lost their first games. In 2003, Coastal Carolina won its first contest, while VMI lost in its Big South debut.

FLAMES ON A STREAK

Liberty's win over North Greenville was its sixth consecutive victory, dating back to last season, and is tied for the third-longest winning streak among FCS programs, behind Dayton and Harvard. The six-game winning streak is tied for third-best in program history and the last time the Flames won six consecutive games was during the 1992-93 seasons. LU ended the 1992 season with three consecutive wins and then opened the 1993 season at 3-0. Liberty is looking to win seven-straight games for the first time since reeling of 10 consecutive wins during the 1988-89 seasons.

STREAKING SEAWOLVES

Stony Brook has now won six-straight home games, its longest home winning streak since winning nine in-a-row during the 2001-03 seasons. In that streak, the Seawolves won their final two home games of 2001, all five home contests in 2002, and their first two home games in 2003.

HOME SWEET HOME

Charleston Southern, Coastal Carolina, Gardner-Webb, Presbyterian and VMI will make their home debut this Saturday. VMI is opening the season this week, and is opening the campaign at home for the fourth-straight year. The Keydets are 3-0 in their last three openers and have outscored their opponents 73-19 in that span, including two shutouts. Below is a look at the five team's last home opening win and current home opening win streaks.

EN FUEGO

Liberty has now scored at least 30 points in its last eight games, dating back to last season. In that span, the Flames have surpassed 40 points in four of those contests, including this past Saturday night against North Greenville. In fact, Liberty has scored 30 points now in 13 of its last 14 games. The last time Liberty did not put a 30 spot on the scoreboard was Sept. 22, 2007, when the Flames lost to Elon, 42-14.

MEET THE CANDIDATES

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** is one of 16 players on the Walter Payton Award Watch List, marking the third consecutive season a Big South student-athlete has been an official candidate for the national Offensive Player of the Year award in FCS. In addition, Gardner-Webb LB **MARIO BROWN** is one of 16 players on the 2008 Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, the second-straight season a Big South player has been honored on that list and third overall.

DAILY DOUBLE

Stony Brook running backs **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** each surpassed 100 yards rushing in Saturday's win over Colgate. Gowins finished with 147 yards, while Cuttino rushed for 104. The last time two Big South teammates rushed for 100 yards in the same game was last season. On Sept. 29, 2007, Liberty duo **ZACH TERRELL** (115) and **RASHAD JENNINGS** (101) did it against St. Francis (Pa.), while VMI trio **HOWARD ABEGESAH** (157), **KYLE HUGHES** (136) and **JOEY ROBINSON** (100) hit the century mark the same day against Robert Morris. The last time the feat was accomplished in a season opener was in 2004, when Liberty had two 100-yard rushers against West Virginia Tech on Sept. 4.

SPINNING HIS WEBB

Presbyterian QB **TIM WEBB** set two Big South single-game records this past Saturday at #13 Wofford. Webb was 37-of-56 passing against the Terriers, breaking the League mark for completions and attempts in a game. His 37 completions broke the previous high of 34, set by Charleston Southern's **ELI BYRD** last season vs. North Greenville. Webb's 56 attempts surpassed Byrd's record of 54 in the same game against the Crusaders.

JENNINGS MOVES INTO FOURTH-PLACE ON ALL-TIME RUSHING LIST

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** rushed for 100 yards in the season opener vs. North Greenville -- his 13th career 100-yard rushing game at Liberty -- and moved past former Coastal Carolina runner **PATRICK HALL** for fourth-place all-time in Big South history. Jennings standings at 2,233 yards and needs 111 yards to pass Coastal's **AUNDRES PERKINS** for third-place. Jennings is 767 rushing yards away from becoming the third player in Conference history with 3,000.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 57 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Charleston Southern has not been shutout in its last 32 games, while VMI (38) and Liberty (28) also have extended their respective streaks. Meanwhile, Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 19 games, while Stony Brook has cracked the scoreboard in its last five contests.

ZACH IS BACK

Liberty senior RB **ZACH TERRELL** extended his Big South-record rushing touchdown streak to 17 consecutive games with his 15-yard first quarter score against North Greenville this past weekend. He has scored 22 touchdowns during his streak, increasing his career total to 27 and tied with teammate **RASHAD JENNINGS** for second all-time in Big South history. Terrell started his streak Oct. 14, 2006 with two scores vs. William & Mary.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Charleston Southern WR **DEE BROWN** needs 78 receiving yards to become the 16th player in Big South history with 1,000. Once he hits the milestone, the Buccaneers will have five players in the top 16. Meanwhile, Brown needs 27 receptions for 100 in his career.

MURRY NEARING CENTURY MARK(US)

Charleston Southern WR **MARKUS MURRY** needs eight receptions to become the 12th player in Big South history with 100. He is the League's active leading receiver with 92 receptions and 1,308 receiving yards. Murry needs 692 receiving yards to become the fourth player with 2,000.

RETURN ON INVESTMENT

Liberty's **JONATHAN CRAWFORD** returned a kickoff 76 yards for a touchdown Saturday against North Greenville, marking the third-straight season that Liberty has recorded a kickoff return TD. Meanwhile, Crawford is just the second player in Big South history to return a punt and kickoff for a touchdown in his career. Former Flames' specialist **WYNTON JACKSON** was the first.

ANYONE FEEL A DRAFT?

The Big South had two players selected in the 2008 NFL Draft, a League first. Coastal Carolina WR **JEROME SIMPSON** was selected by the Cincinnati Bengals in the second round with the 46th overall pick, while Gardner-Webb DE **BRIAN JOHNSTON** was selected by the Kansas City Chiefs in the seventh round with the 210th overall pick.

BIG SOUTH GETS BIGGER IN 2008

The Big South football membership officially stands at seven overall in 2008 with the addition of Stony Brook University as an associate member and Presbyterian College beginning its full-time affiliation as a League member. The addition of SBU gives the League six Division I playing members, marking the first 5-game League slate. Meanwhile, Presbyterian College, which is in the midst of its transition into Division I, is playing five of the six members in 2008, and will officially become a Big South opponent in 2009 when the Blue Hose play their first full Conference schedule, at which time PC will be eligible for the regular-season title. However, Presbyterian is not eligible for the football post-season until the 2011 season.

BIG SOUTH SCORES AUTOMATIC BID IN 2010

As part of the NCAA's expansion of the FCS Playoffs to 20 teams in 2010, the Big South Conference has been granted an automatic bid to the playoffs beginning that same year. In the meantime, Big South members are eligible to receive an at-large berth in 2008 and 2009.

FB-YES

The Big South football membership is playing a League-record five games against FBS members in 2008. The list features two ACC teams, two MAC teams and one Big Ten opponent. Charleston Southern is facing two FBS squads -- Miami of both Florida and Ohio. Coastal Carolina opened the season at Penn State -- its first-ever FBS foe, while Gardner-Webb plays a mid-season contest at Georgia Tech. VMI rounds out the Big South's FBS slate with a visit to Ohio.

BROCK YOU LIKE A HURRICANE

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** is fifth all-time in Big South history with 4,587 passing yards, and he needs 413 passing yards to become the fifth QB in League history with 5,000. VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** is ahead of Smith with 5,096 career yards. Smith ranks fifth in pass attempts (545), fifth in completions (319), fourth in TD passes (33) and fifth in total offense (4,634).

HUGHES EFFORT

VMI junior QB **KYLE HUGHES** needs 466 rushing yards to become the third quarterback in Big South history with 1,000 in his career. Coastal's **TYLER THIGPEN** is first among QBs with 1,638, followed by Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** at 1,182. Hughes' 444 rushing yards last season were third-most in a campaign by a Big South signal-caller, while his 71-yard TD run at Robert Morris is the third-longest rush from scrimmage by a QB in League history. In addition, Hughes is one of just four quarterbacks in Big South history to rush for 100 yards and pass for 100 yards in the same game.

* The Buccaneers last win over a SoCon opponent was in 2006, when CSU defeated The Citadel in double overtime, 38-35.

* QB **TRIBBLE REESE**'s two-yard TD pass to **TYRESE HARRIS** last Thursday at Miami (Fla.) marked the first career touchdown for both players.

* Reese completed 10-of-21 passes for 81 yards, including a 39-yarder to **ANTWAN IVEY** that set-up the Bucs' only touchdown.

* **T.J. LATIMORE** carried six times for 29 yards in his Buccaneer debut, a 4.8 average.

* **JAKE KILLEEN**, **MATT BACH** and **ZACHARY HILLERY** each recorded a TFL for the Charleston Southern defense. Hillery's was a sack for an eight-yard loss.

* **DARIUS GAITHER** led the Buccaneer defense with nine tackles and also recorded a pass break-up.

* Bach recovered a fumble in the second quarter to account for the only Miami turnover.
