OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

RASHAD JENNINGS • RB • R-Senior
Liberty • Forest, Va.

Jennings rushed for a career-high 220 yards on 29 carries and scored three touchdowns to help lead the Liberty Flames past No. 23 Youngstown State, 31-28. Jennings' first touchdown was a 2-yard run that capped a nine-play, 86-yard drive that tied the game 14-14 with 2:03 remaining in the first half. Jennings set-up his touchdown with a 55-yard run on the third play of the drive. He added two scores late in the third quarter, scoring another 2-yard run to end an eight-play, 95-yard drive with 2:21 on the clock, and a 6-yard scamper less than two minutes later that gave Liberty a 28-14 lead. Jennings averaged 7.6 yards per carry, the fifth-highest of his career, and his 220 rushing yards are the sixth-most in a game in Big South history. He also recorded his fifth career game with three rushing touchdowns, extending his Big South record.

NEW BALANCE

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NICK HURSKY • LB • Senior

Hursky led the Flames with 13 tackles (nine solo, four assisted) and 3.0 tackles for loss of 14 yards in helping Liberty knock off No. 23 Youngstown State. His 11-yard sack pushed a driving Penguin squad back from the 32-yard line to near mid-field during the second quarter that led to an eventual punt, allowing Liberty to tie the game on the ensuing drive. His 3.0 tackles-for-loss set a career-high, and he finished with his second-highest tackle output and 11th career double-figure tackle game.

Gates tied a Big South single-game record with four field goals in Saturday's game against Sam Houston State, and is just the third player in League history to hit 4-of-4 field goals in a game. He boomed field goals from 47, 42, 22 and 26 yards, and added 3-of-3 extra point kicks to account for 15 of Gardner-Webb's 33 points Saturday. Gates' 15 points scored is tied for second-most in a game by a kicker in League history.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Bevins knocked down the game-winning 24-yard field goal as time expired to lift Liberty to a three-point victory over No. 23 Youngstown State. The field goal was just the second of his career. He also was a perfect 4-of-4 on extra points and he finished with a career-high seven points on the night.

BIG SOUTH KICKS OFF TELEVISION PACKAGE

The 2008 Big South Television package kicks off this Saturday and features the Conference opener between Liberty and Coastal Carolina live on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) and SportSouth at 7:00pm. **MATT HOGUE** (play-by-play) and **JOHN GREGORY** (analyst) will call the action. It will be the first of three Big South "Game of the Week" broadcasts on MASN, as the network will also air the Nov. 8 Coastal Carolina at Gardner-Webb contest and the Nov. 15 VMI at Stony Brook tilt.

LET THE CONFERENCE SEASON BEGIN

The Conference portion of the 2008 schedule begins this Saturday, Oct. 4, with two League games on the slate. Preseason Big South favorite Liberty opens at preseason No. 2 Coastal Carolina, while Charleston Southern hosts Gardner-Webb. Stony Brook and VMI open Conference action next weekend. Below is a breakdown of how each team has fared in its Big South opener, as well as some additional notes:

Charleston Southern is opening its League season at home for the third-straight year ... Gardner-Webb is beginning the Conference season on the road for the seventh-straight year ... Liberty has finished with a winning League record when winning its Conference opener ... Coastal Carolina is 2-1 when opening the Big South season at home ... VMI's lone Big South opening win was a 10-7 victory at Liberty on Oct. 1, 2005.

SOMETHINGS GOTTA GIVE

Liberty carries a six-game Conference game win streak into Saturday's Big South opener at Coastal Carolina. Coastal Carolina is second to the Flames with a two-game League winning streak -- but has won its last eight Big South home games. Meanwhile, during Liberty's six-game streak, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and are averaging 43.8 points, while holding their League brethren to 20.0 points. The Big South record for longest Conference winning streak is eight games, set by Coastal Carolina from Nov. 22, 2003 to Oct. 29, 2005.

LIBERTY OWNS NATION'S LONGEST WINNING STREAK AT NINE

The Flames rallied from a 14-0 deficit and won on a last-second field goal at No. 23 Youngstown State this past Saturday to extend its winning streak to nine -- currently the longest in the nation. It was Liberty's first win over a ranked opponent since defeating No. 24 Charleston Southern in 2006, and its first win over a ranked team on the road since winning 25-19 at No. 15 Appalachian State on Nov. 22, 1997. Liberty, which has won two-straight non-Conference road games for the first since 1997, is tied with Gardner-Webb for the third-longest win streak in Big South history. The Bulldogs won nine-in-a-row from Sept. 14, 2002 to Aug. 30, 2003. The Flames' nine-game winning streak is the program's longest since reeling off 10 consecutive wins during the 1988-89 seasons.

GIMME FIVE

Liberty is looking to start 5-0 for the first time since the 1989 season when the Flames opened the year with a 6-0 mark. Liberty is 4-0 for the first time in head coach **DANNY ROCCO**'s three seasons and 4-0 for the first time since opening the 1997 season at 4-0. The last time a Big South member started 5-0 was Charleston Southern in 2006 when the Bucs jumped out to a 9-0 record.

TOAST OF THE COAST

Coastal Carolina's 26-7 win Monmouth in Week 3 was its first non-Conference road victory since winning at Winston-Salem State on Sept. 30, 2006, snapping a five-game losing streak in non-Conference away games. That victory started the Chanticleers' current three-game win streak, which is their longest since winning eight-straight to close out the 2006 regular-season. Coastal Carolina also has won two consecutive non-Conference road contests for the first time since the 2005 season, and is above .500 for the first time since 2006.

RECORD CHANTS

With its 20-7 win at North Carolina A&T this past Saturday, Coastal Carolina became the first team in Big South history to hold three-straight opponents to less than 10 points. The Chanticleers have allowed just 17 points in the span (7 at Monmouth, 3 vs. Towson, 7 vs. North Carolina A&T). Coastal Carolina broke the record of two-straight games that was established by the 2006 Liberty Flames.

GIMME FIVE, UP HIGH

Liberty has won four consecutive road games, tying the Big South record set by Gardner-Webb from Sept. 21, 2002 to Nov. 9, 2002, and matched by Charleston Southern from Nov. 5, 2005 to Oct. 7, 2006.

FLAMES MOVE UP IN THE POLLS

The Liberty Flames, which entered the national Top 25 the week of Sept. 8 for the first time since 1998, are No. 20 in this week's *The Sports Network* poll, and No. 21 in the FCS Coaches Poll. Prior to this season, Liberty's previous national ranking came in the Aug. 31, 1998 preseason ESPN/USA Today Division I-AA poll, as the Flames were ranked tied for No. 24 with Troy State.

RECORD DOGS

Gardner-Webb held Sam Houston State to 24 net rushing yards on 24 attempts Saturday, its fourth-straight game holding an opponent under 100 yards and setting a Big South record. The Bulldogs have permitted 63, 6, 98 and 24 rushing yards in their first four games, respectively, and are allowing an average of 47.75 rushing yards per game -- 4th in the nation. Gardner-Webb bested the previous League mark of three-straight opponents under 100 rushing yards, which was established by Coastal Carolina in 2005. The Big South's season record for rushing defense is 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006.

RECORD MAYPRAY

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the first player in Big South history to have a 50-yard run in four-straight games. He has opened the season with touchdown runs of 52 yards against St. Francis (Pa.), 64 yards at William & Mary and 60 yards vs. Chowan, in addition to a 51-yard non-scoring scamper this past Saturday at Ohio. Maypray broke the record of three-straight games with a 50-yard rush, set by Coastal Carolina's **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. That season, Hall closed out the year with a 70-yard TD run vs. Savannah State (Nov. 6), at 50-yard rush vs. Jacksonville (Nov. 13) and a 68-yard score vs. Charleston Southern (Nov. 20).

JENNINGS JUMPS AHEAD

Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** became the second player in Big South history with 30 career rushing touchdowns when he hit the total with his third rushing score of the night at Youngstown State this past Saturday. He also became the fourth player overall in League history with 30 career touchdowns, and he is tied with former Gardner-Webb WR **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** for third all-time with 32 career scores. Meanwhile, Jennings moved into a tie with former VMI back **SEAN MIZZER** for second-place in League history with his 15th career 100-yard rushing game, and needs two more 100-yard games to tie the all-time mark.

JENNINGS JAUNTS

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS**, who is third all-time in Big South history with 2,569 career rushing yards, is 431 yards away from becoming the third player with 3,000. Jennings is averaging 145.33 rushing yards a game, and if he maintains his average the remainder of the season, he will finish the season with both the single season and career rushing records. Jennings is on pace for 1,598 rushing yards in 2008, and 3,731 for his career. **DRE BARNES** currently holds both the Big South season rushing record (1,347 in 2003) and the career mark (3,409 from 2002-04).

SEE YOU IN SEPTEMBER

The Big South concluded the month of September with a 12-13 record (=.480), the second-highest win total in the traditional first month of the season. The League mark for most wins in September is 13, set during the 2006 season.

PEAKS AND VALLEYS

The Big South captured its first-ever win over a Missouri Valley Football Conference opponent (formerly the Gateway Football Conference) with Liberty's 31-28 win at Youngstown State this past Saturday. The Big South was winless in three previous meetings. Meanwhile, the Big South has wins this season over members from AQ Conferences the Colonial, Ohio Valley, Patriot and Southern.

BULL DURHAM

Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **JUSTIN DURHAM** is tied for the League-lead with eight field goals this season. He has three games with at least two field goals, and has increased his career total to 20 -- already fifth all-time in Big South history and halfway to the career record of 40, set by former Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE**.

ANOTHER SUCCESSFUL YOUNG MAN NAMED GATES

Gardner-Webb kicker **RYAN GATES** became the first freshman to make four field goals in a game when he tied the Big South single-game field goal record Saturday vs. Sam Houston State. Gates added three extra point kicks, and his 15 points scored are the second-most in a game by a kicker in League history. Former Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE** set the single-game mark of 16 points vs. North Greenville on Sept. 25, 2004.

SPINNING HIS WEBB

Presbyterian QB **TIM WEBB** attempted 57 passes Saturday at No. 3 Appalachian State, breaking his own Big South single-game record of 56, which he established this season in Week 1 at Wofford. Webb completed 35 passes against the Mountaineers -- just two shy of matching his Conference record for completions in a game, and became the first QB in League history with 30 completions in a game twice. He also finished the night with 372 yards passing, the sixth-highest single-game total in Big South history. Webb is tops in the Big South in completions (126), attempts (209), yards (1,328) and tied for first in touchdown passes (8).

CONSISTENTLY EFFICIENT

Coastal Carolina leads the Big South in pass efficiency defense with a 103.3 rating, which ranks 15th in the nation. The Chanticleers have led the Big South in the category the past four seasons, including a Conference-record and national-leading 86.8 rating in 2004.

NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING IN A RUSH

VMI's season rush average of 384.0 yards per game leads the nation and is more than 100 yards ahead of its Big South record of 283.2 rushing yards per game set last season. The Keydets are on pace to gain more than 4,200 rushing yards at their current clip, which would shatter their League record of 3,115 yards established in 2007.

MAYPRAY ECLIPSES 1,000 RUSHING YARDS

VMI all-everything back **TIM MAYPRAY** became the 21st player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone this past Saturday at Ohio. Maypray has 1,124 yards to his credit -- including a Big South-leading 453 yards this season. He is looking to become the first quarterback to lead the League in rushing, and is 204 rushing yards away from setting the single-season record for most rushing yards by a quarterback. Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** owns the record of 656 yards, set in 2006.

TWO HUNDRED POINT CONVERSION

Liberty teammates **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **ZACH TERRELL** are each approaching 200 career points. Jennings is at 194, while Terrell has 174. The Big South's 200-point club currently stands at five members.

TV GUIDE UPDATE

MASN's broadcast of the Nov. 8 Coastal Carolina at Gardner-Webb at 3:30pm will be aired on same day tape delay on SportSouth beginning at 7:00pm.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 61 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. Charleston Southern has not been shutout in its last 35 games, while VMI (42) and Liberty (31) also have extended their respective streaks. Meanwhile, Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 23 games, while Stony Brook has cracked the scoreboard in its last nine contests.

A CLOSER LOOK AT VMI'S SCORING STREAK

VMI's 42-game scoring streak is the second-longest run in the 118-year history of the program, trailing only a 43-game stretch from 1919-1924. The Keydets have also scored 30 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2003.

RUNNIN' WITH THE NIGHT

Gardner-Webb has scored 30 points in three consecutive games for the first time since surpassing the threshold in four-straight games in the final two games of 2005 and the first two contests in 2006. The current streak began in Week 2 in the Runnin' Bulldogs' 31-12 victory vs. Tusculum, followed by their 31-15 win at Austin Peay in Week 3, which was their first non-Conference road win since Sept. 2, 2006 at Jacksonville. Gardner-Webb scored 33 this past Saturday in its loss against Sam Houston State.

HAVE YOU DRIVEN A FORD LATELY?

Coastal Carolina senior RB **JAMIE FORDHAM** became the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in the Chanticleers' win over Towson in Week 4. Fordham's career total stands at 1,089 yards, and he is the fifth player in school history over the 1,000-yard rushing mark, joining **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638), **MIKE TOLBERT** (1,670), **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (2,343).

THE BUTLER DID IT

Presbyterian WR **TERRANCE BUTLER** is looking to end Charleston Southern's run of producing the top wide receiver in the Conference. Butler leads the Big South in the three main receiving categories: receptions (36), receiving yards (481) and TD catches (5). A Charleston Southern receiver has led or shared the Big South lead in receptions every year of Big South football. No Buccaneer is currently in the League's top 10 thus far.

THIRD BROCK FROM THE SUN

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** became the fifth QB in League history with 5,000 career passing yards when he surpassed the milestone this past Saturday at No. 23 Youngstown State. Smith's total stands at 5,088 yards, and he is nine yards away from moving past VMI's **JONATHAN WILSON** for fourth-place. Smith also ranks fifth in pass attempts (605), fifth in completions (357), fourth in TD passes (36) and fifth in total offense (5,179).

WIDE OUTS

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** and Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** each surpassed the 1,000 career receiving yard mark this past Saturday. Collins caught seven passes for 51 yards against Sam Houston State, while Bolden hauled in six receptions for 91 yards at Youngstown State. Bolden's 1,030 career yards is slightly ahead of Collins' 1,020.

REESE'S PIECES

In his last three games, Charleston Southern QB **TRIBBLE REESE** is 73-of-112 passing (=65.2 percent) for 723 yards and seven touchdowns. He has thrown for more than 200 yards in each of those outings, and has a TD pass in all four games this season. Reese is tied for first in the Big South with eight touchdown passes.

WE MUST PROTECT THIS HOUSE

The Liberty Flames have won 10 consecutive home games, which is currently the second-longest home winning streak in FCS. San Diego has won 26-straight home games to lead the nation. Liberty's 10-game home winning streak is the third-longest in Big South history, and two victories away from tying the record of 12 held by Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern. The Flames' next home game is next weekend -- Oct. 11 vs. League newcomer Stony Brook.

"ALL THE WAY" MAYPRAY

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth all-time in Big South history with 3,310 career all-purpose yards. He needs 304 all-purpose yards to catch **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** for third-place at 3,614. Maypray has scored a touchdown in 11-straight games and now has 20 in his career.

MURRY PASSES CENTURY MARK(US)

Charleston Southern WR **MARKUS MURRY** caught six passes at Miami (Ohio) in Week 3 to become the 12th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions. Murry stands at 103 and needs six catches to tie VMI's **GARY PRICE** for 11th place with 109. Meanwhile, Murry stands 24 receiving yards away from 1,500 and needs 123 yards to reach the League's all-time top 10.

MR. SATURDAY AFTERNOON

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** became the first player in Big South history to throw a 70-yard touchdown pass and score a 60-yard rushing touchdown in the same game when he accomplished the feat in Week 4 vs. Chowan. Maypray opened the game with a 74-yard scoring strike to **DAUD SEMALULU**. At the beginning of the second quarter, Maypray took the snap from center and raced 60 yards for a touchdown -- his 10th straight game with a TD.

VMI RUNS WILD IN RECORD-BREAKING WIN

VMI rushed for a Big South single-game record 517 yards in its 69-20 victory over Chowan in Week 4. The Keydets are the first Big South squad to rush for 500 yards in a game, and eclipsed the old record of 490 rushing yards, which was set by Coastal Carolina against Chowan last season on Oct. 13. VMI scored seven rushing touchdowns -- tied for second-most in League history, and amassed 659 total yards of offense, the second-highest total in Big South football history.

HE IS THE BIG SOUTH'S DEVIN HESTER

Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** had a 72-yard punt return touchdown vs. Glenville State in Week 2, his first career punt return TD and Big South record fourth career kick return touchdown. Bolden is the all-time leader with three career kickoff return TDs, and is now just one of three players in Big South history to have returned both a punt and kickoff for touchdowns, joining **WYNTON JACKSON** and **JONATHAN CRAWFORD**.

KEYDET KICKS

VMI's 69 points in its win over Chowan in Week 4 tied for third-highest all-time in Big South history, and matched the VMI single-game record for most points scored, which was first established on Sept. 25, 1982 when the Keydets blanked Central Florida, 69-0. The Keydets' 10 touchdowns in the game equaled the Conference record of 10, which was set by Coastal Carolina in 2005 and matched by Liberty in 2007. It was the first time in 18 years that VMI scored 60 points in a game, the last being Oct. 20, 1990 vs. West Virginia Tech (66 points). Meanwhile, VMI has scored at least 40 points in back-to-back home games for the first time since 2003 when the Keydets scored 42 against Georgetown on Sept. 27 and 50 vs. Charleston Southern in its next home game on Oct. 11.

STEVENSON SETS KICKOFF RETURN RECORDS

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** set a Big South single-game record with 255 kickoff return yards at No. 13 Wofford during Week 2. The previous record was 204, by VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** against The Citadel in the season finale last year. Stevenson averaged 36.4 yards on his seven kickoff returns, the highest single-game return average with at least five kickoff returns.

FB-YES

The Big South football membership is playing a League-record five games against FBS members in 2008. The list features two ACC teams, two MAC teams and one Big Ten opponent. Charleston Southern is facing two FBS squads -- Miami of both Florida and Ohio. Coastal Carolina opened the season at Penn State -- its first-ever FBS foe, while Gardner-Webb plays a mid-season contest at Georgia Tech. VMI rounds out the Big South's FBS slate with a visit to Ohio.

BIG SOUTH SCORES AUTOMATIC BID IN 2010

As part of the NCAA's expansion of the FCS Playoffs to 20 teams in 2010, the Big South Conference has been granted an automatic bid to the playoffs beginning that same year. In the meantime, Big South members are eligible to receive an at-large berth in 2008 and 2009.
