Campbell completed 28-of-38 passes (73.7 percent) for a career-high 392 yards and three touchdowns in Gardner-Webb's 34-27 win over VMI. He added 17 yards on the ground to finish with a personal-best 409 yards of total offense. Campbell went 12-of-16 for 224 yards and two scores in the first half alone, as GWU built a 24-6 advantage by intermission. He finished with a 186.39 passing efficiency rating, while his passing yardage and total offense yardage were the most by a Big South player this season, and each ranks fifth in League history overall.

**NEW BALANCE**  
**DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**JEFFREY WILLIAMS • LB • Sophomore**  
 Gardner-Webb • Frisco City, Ala.

Williams topped his own career high in total tackles, set just one week earlier, amassing 19 hits (10 solo, 9 assisted) against VMI's option-based attack. He added 2.0 TFL and one sack, and also forced an incomplete pass with a quarterback pressure just before the half. Williams had nearly double the tackles than the Bulldogs' next-leading tackler (10).

McGowan personally kept four points off the scoreboard Saturday vs. VMI, as he blocked a 33-yard field goal attempt on the Keydets' opening drive into Bulldog territory, and swatted away an extra point attempt to preserve what was a 7-6 lead at 10:27 in the second quarter. McGowan also finished the day with seven tackles and a fumble recovery that set up a GWU touchdown in the third quarter.

Gates had the second-best scoring day of his young career, booting a pair of field goals and going a perfect 4-of-4 on PAT attempts against VMI to finish with 10 points. Gates' 40-yard field goal as time expired in the first half gave GWU a 24-6 lead. With his two field goals Saturday, Gates established a Big South Conference single-season freshman record with 13 field goals, and is just four makes shy of the overall single-season mark.

**LIBERTY SETS CONFERENCE WIN STREAK RECORD**

Liberty defeated Charleston Southern this past Saturday for its ninth consecutive Big South win, establishing a League record for the longest win streak in Conference games. The Flames had shared the mark with Coastal Carolina, which won eight straight Big South contests from Nov. 22, 2003 to Oct. 29, 2005. Meanwhile, the Flames put their Conference-record 5-game road winning streak on the line this weekend at Presbyterian.

**ZERO TOLERANCE**

Liberty blanked Charleston Southern 42-0 this past Saturday, marking its second consecutive shutout of a Big South opponent this season. It is the first time in League history that a member has recorded two shutouts during the Conference season, let alone consecutively. In fact, Liberty has shutout three of its last four League opponents, dating back to last year's 31-0 win over Gardner-Webb in the season finale. The Flames have recorded a League-best six shutouts since Big South football began in 2002.

**MMM, GOOD**

Gardner-Webb QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** threw for a career-high 392 yards this past Saturday against VMI, the most in the Big South this season and the fifth-highest single-game passing performance in Big South history. Campbell finished the game with 409 total yards of offense, becoming the fifth player in Big South history to reach that plateau in a contest. In his past three games, Campbell has gone an impressive 55-of-79 passing ( =69.6 percent) for 701 yards, five touchdowns and no interceptions. In his two starts this year, Gardner-Webb is 2-0 and is averaging 485.0 yards offensively and 40.5 points per game.

**THREE'S COMPANY**

Liberty is 3-0 in the Big South for the just the second time. The Flames opened the 2007 League slate 3-0 en route to a perfect 4-0 Conference record. Every team that has started Big South play 3-0 has gone on to win the Conference championship (2005 co-champion Charleston Southern opened 0-1).

**THREE-PEAT**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South in rushing with exactly 1,000 yards, and is the first player in Big South history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons. Jennings is looking to finish as the League's rushing leader for the first time in his career, and he has fallen short the past two seasons by a combined 11 yards.

**CENTURY MAN**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has rushed for 100 yards in eight consecutive games, dating back to last season, breaking the Big South record of seven consecutive games set by Liberty's **EUGENE GOODMAN** from Nov. 15, 2003 to Oct. 2, 2004. Jennings has recorded 19 career 100-yard rushing games with the Flames, setting the all-time Conference record and surpassing **DRE BARNES'** previous record of 17 in Week 8.

**MAYPRAY CLOSING IN ON ANOTHER FIRST**

VMI QB **TIM MAYPRAY** is 159 rushing yards shy of becoming the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. He broke the single-season quarterback rushing record of 656 yards in Week 7. Maypray is second in the Big South in rushing, and should he surpass current rushing leader **RASHAD JENNINGS**, he would become the first quarterback to lead the League in rushing.

**FLAMES BURNING THROUGH BIG SOUTH FOES**

During Liberty's Big South-record nine-game Conference winning streak, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and is averaging 42.3 points, while holding its League brethren to 17.6 points. The Flames also have won four of those nine games on the road.

**COLLINS CATCHES UP**

Gardner-Webb WR **DOBSON COLLINS**, who became the 13th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 7 at Georgia Tech, is now 11th in Conference annals with 120 -- one reception from joining the Top 10. In his last five games, Collins is averaging 7.6 receptions a contest and 99.4 receiving yards to move into first among the League leaders with 53 receptions and second with 658 yards.

**OF THE PEOPLES, BY THE PEOPLES, FOR THE PEOPLES**

Gardner-Webb RB **PHILIP PEOPLES** became the 22nd player in Big South history to reach 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone this past Saturday against VMI. His career total stands at 1,036.

**FLAMES MOVE RIGHT BACK UP IN NATIONAL POLLS**

Following a one week drop, the Liberty Flames have moved up in the two Top 25 national polls. Liberty is No. 17 in this week's *The Sports Network* poll, and No. 17 in the FCS Coaches Poll, marking the eighth-straight week that Liberty has been ranked, extending its school record. Liberty entered the national Top 25 the week of Sept. 8 for the first time since 1998, when the Flames were ranked tied for No. 24 with Troy State in the Aug. 31, 1998 preseason ESPN/*USA Today* Division I-AA poll.

**TWO ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM**

The Big South Conference season has seen two different types of outcomes this season. In the eight League games played thus far, five have been decided by seven points-or-less (4.0 average), while the remaining three have been decided by an average of 34 points, and no less than 27 points.

**ELEY DAN**

Stony Brook WR **DWAYNE ELEY** hauled in six passes for 120 yards and three touchdowns at Coastal Carolina this past Saturday, becoming just the sixth player in Big South history to tally three touchdown catches in a game. He is now the third player to have three touchdown receptions in a Conference game, joining Gardner-Webb's **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** (Oct. 18, 2003 at VMI) and Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** (Oct. 18, 2008 at Stony Brook).

**STEVENSON BECOMES BIG SOUTH CAREER LEADER IN KICKOFF RETURN YARDS**

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** collected 119 kickoff return yards this past Saturday at Liberty, increasing his career total to 1,338 and surpassing Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** as the Big South's career leader in kickoff return yards. Bolden entered last week first at 1,303. Stevenson leads the Big South with 787 kickoff return yards this year, which is already the fourth-highest single season total in League history. Stevenson needs four kickoff returns to tie the Big South career record of 60, set by Liberty's **ADRIAN HALL** from 2002-04.

**MR. 3000**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS**, who became the third player in Big South history with 3,000 career rushing yards when he eclipsed the milestone vs. Lafayette in Week 8, is third all-time in Big South history with 3,133 career rushing yards. He needs 90 yards to surpass **SEAN MIZZER** for second-place (3,223). Jennings is averaging 142.9 rushing yards a game, and if he can maintain his average the remainder of the season, he will finish with both the single season and career rushing records. Jennings is on pace for 1,572 rushing yards in 2008, and 3,705 for his career. **DRE BARNES** currently holds both the Big South season rushing record (1,347 in 2003) and the career mark (3,409 from 2002-04).

**TAKING THEIR TREASURE**

Charleston Southern's run of producing the top wide receiver in the Big South is in jeopardy this season, as leading receiver **GERALD STEVENSON** is currently 27 receptions away from the top spot. Stevenson's 26 catches this season rank 10th in the League. A Charleston Southern receiver has led or shared the Big South lead in receptions every year of Big South football.

**CATCH US IF YOU CAN**

Liberty receiving duo **DOMINIC BOLDEN** and **JONATHAN CRAWFORD** became the first teammates in Big South history to amass 100 receiving yards in the same game in consecutive weeks. Crawford totaled 124 receiving yards this past Saturday vs. Charleston Southern, while Bolden had 117. In Week 8 vs. Lafayette, Bolden posted 150 receiving yards while Crawford finished with 106.

**BEWARE OF DOG**

Despite allowing 321 rushing yards to VMI this past Saturday (which was still 35 yards below the Keydets' season average), Gardner-Webb remains the Big South leader in rushing defense at 92.3 yards per game, good for 14th in the nation. The Bulldogs are still pacing ahead of the Big South single-season record of 108.8, set by Charleston Southern in 2006. Gardner-Webb held its first six opponents this season under 100 yards rushing, establishing a Big South record.

**SECOND-AND-TEN**

Walter Payton Award candidate **RASHAD JENNINGS** has scored 13 touchdowns this season (11 rushing and two receiving), and is just four TDs away from tying his Big South season record of 17. Jennings is the second player in Big South history with three 10-touchdown seasons, and is the third in history with 40 career trips to the end zone. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** is the Big South's career touchdown leader with 47, followed by **JEROME SIMPSON** with 44.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 65 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. VMI (45) and Liberty (35) also have extended their respective scoring streaks. In addition, Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 26 games. Charleston Southern's 38-game scoring streak ended this past Saturday at Liberty.

**A CLOSER LOOK AT VMI'S SCORING STREAK**

VMI's 45-game scoring streak is the longest run in the 118-year history of the program. The previous record was a 43-game stretch from 1919-1924. Earlier this year, the Keydets scored 30 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2003.

**SPEAKING OF POINTS...**

Gardner-Webb has scored 30 points in a game five times this season, the most for the Bulldogs since reaching the 30-point plateau seven times in 2005.

**BIG MAC**

Coastal Carolina QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** is closing in on the League's all-time Top 10 in passing yards. He has thrown for 1,564 yards this season, just 367 away from the No. 10 position, which is held by Liberty's **BROCK FARREL** at 1,931. MacDowall's 12 touchdown passes are also just four away from the all-time leaders. Teammate **WILLIAM RICHARDSON** is 10th in League history with 16 touchdown passes.

**50-50**

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fourth player in Big South history with back-to-back 50 reception seasons. He joins former teammate **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (three times), VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** (two) and Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** (two) with consecutive seasons with 50 catches.

**PLAYING WITH FIRE**

Through three League games, Liberty has allowed 38 points (all vs. Coastal Carolina) and has two shutouts. The Big South record for fewest points allowed in a Conference season is 59, set by Gardner-Webb during a four-game League schedule in 2003. Liberty's 12.7 scoring defense average in Big South games this season is pacing ahead of the League record of 14.8, which is held by the 2003 Gardner-Webb Runnin' Bulldogs.

**NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING IN A RUSH**

VMI's season rush average of 351.4 yards per game continues to lead the nation and is more than 70 yards ahead of its Big South record of 283.2 rushing yards per game set last season. The Keydets are on pace to gain more than 3,800 rushing yards at their current clip, which would shatter their League record of 3,115 yards established in 2007.

**JENNINGS CLIMBING SCORING LADDER**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS**, who became the sixth player in League history with 200 career points when he surpassed the milestone in Week 6 at Coastal Carolina, is fourth all-time in career scoring with 242 points. Jennings' total is third-most by a non-kicker, trailing Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286) and **JEROME SIMPSON** (264).

**REAL ESTATE BROKERS**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** and Liberty teammates **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **DOMINIC BOLDEN** are the Big South's active players with more than 3,000 all-purpose yards. Maypray moved into third-place all-time this past Saturday at Gardner-Webb and stands at 3,759 -- just 24 yards away from passing **DRE BARNES** (3,782) for second-place. Jennings eclipsed 3,000 career all-purpose yards in Week 6 at Coastal Carolina and remains in fifth in history at 3,574. Bolden reached the milestone this past Saturday vs. Charleston Southern, and his career total of 3,058 is seventh all-time.

**CUTTING THROUGH THE CLUTTER**

Stony Brook junior **CONTE CUTTINO** surpassed 2,000 career rushing yards on his third carry of the game in Week 8 vs. Charleston Southern. He recorded his second consecutive 100-yard rushing game of the season with 136 yards at Coastal Carolina to move into third-place all-time at Stony Brook with 2,227 rushing yards. Cuttino, who has nine career 100-yard rushing games, is third in the Big South in rushing this season with 612 yards.

**WIDE OUTS**

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** and Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** each surpassed the 1,000 career receiving yard mark in Week 5. Collins' 1,466 career yards rank 12th all-time and is just ahead of Bolden's career total of 1,443, which is 13th in League history. Charleston Southern senior WR **MARKUS MURRY** is 11th all-time with 1,562 receiving yards, just 37 yards away from cracking the League's all-time Top 10. Former Gardner-Webb receiver **AUSTIN GAINES** is 10th at 1,599.

**GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE**

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **RYAN GATES** leads the Big South with 13 field goals made, which is a freshman record and fourth-most in a single-season in League history. Gates is four makes away from tying the season record of 17, set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. Gates has made two field goals in a game five times this season, and has made five field goals from 40 yards-or-longer.

**THIRD BROCK FROM THE SUN**

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** became the fourth QB in League history with 6,000 career passing yards when he surpassed the plateau this past Saturday vs. Charleston Southern. He is fourth in history with 6,097 passing yards, and is also one of four players with 40 career touchdown passes (44). Smith needs four TD strikes to move into a tie for third-place with Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS**. Smith ranks fifth all-time in pass attempts (714), fourth in completions (428), fourth in TD passes (44) and fourth in total offense (6,194).

**HAVE YOU DRIVEN A FORD LATELY?**

Coastal Carolina senior RB **JAMIE FORDHAM** became the 20th player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards when he reached the milestone in the Chanticleers' win over Towson in Week 4. Fordham's career total stands at 1,308 yards, 16th highest in Big South history. He is the fifth player in school history over the 1,000-yard rushing mark, joining **TYLER THIGPEN** (1,638), **MIKE TOLBERT** (1,670), **PATRICK HALL** (2,214) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (2,343).

The list of 16 candidates will be reviewed early in November, before the finalized list will be handed over to the voting panel at the conclusion of the regular season. The top three finalists will be announced on Dec. 1.

**IF THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY**

Gardner-Webb sophomore LB **JEFFREY WILLIAMS** has recorded 37 tackles in his last two games, pushing his season total to a Big South-leading 81. He is looking to become the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in tackles since **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2002 (120). In 19 career games, Williams has 201 career tackles, a 10.6 per game career average.

**HE'S JUST BEING MILEY**

Presbyterian redshirt-freshman **BRANDON MILEY** posted career-highs of 34 completions and 331 passing yards at Gardner-Webb in Week 8. Since replacing the injured **TIM WEBB** vs. North Greenville in Week 6 (Oct. 4), Miley is 59-of-94 passing ( =62.8 percent) for 580 yards and three touchdowns.

**MAYPRAY LOOKING FOR ANOTHER BIG SOUTH RECORD**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** needs 70 receiving yards to become the first player in Big South history with 1,000 career receiving yards and 1,000 career rushing yards.

**ASH BROWNS**

Charleston Southern's **PHILIP ASHLEY** recorded an interception in three-straight games from Sept. 27-Oct. 11, and is tied for the League-lead with three picks this season. He is CSU's career interception leader with eight, and is tied for fourth all-time in Big South history with Gardner-Webb's **MARIO WILLIAMS**, who had eight interceptions from 2002-04.

**STONY BROOK SCORES FIRST CONFERENCE WIN**

New Big South football member Stony Brook University won its first Big South game with a 20-19 win over Charleston Southern in Week 8. The victory over the Buccaneers snapped a five-game losing streak for SBU, and was the first Conference win of any kind for the Seawolves since defeating Wagner on Nov. 4, 2006 as members of the Northeast Conference.

**WHAT YOU TALKING ABOUT WILLIS?**

In his last four games, Coastal Carolina redshirt-sophomore **MARQUEL WILLIS** has 14 receptions for 253 yards and four touchdowns. He enjoyed a career night vs. Liberty in Week 6, as he hauled in personal bests of seven receptions for 145 yards and two touchdowns. Willis entered the game with two catches for 29 yards. He is the first Chanticleer receiver with more than 100 receiving yards in a game since **JEROME SIMPSON** had 107 in Coastal Carolina's 2006 playoff game at Appalachian State on Nov. 25. Willis' 145 receiving yards are the most by a Chants' receiver since Simpson had 145 against Liberty on Oct. 28, 2006.

**SIX SHOOTERS**

Liberty was just the second team in Big South history to start the season 6-0, joining the 2006 Charleston Southern Buccaneers, which opened that year with a 9-0 record. Liberty opened 6-0 for the second time in program history, matching the 1989 squad for best start in school history.

**SUGG FEST**

Stony Brook WR **LYNELL SUGGS** first catch at Liberty in Week 7 put him over the 2,000-yard mark in receiving yards. He now has 2,054 receiving yards in his career, third all-time at Stony Brook. He owns 143 receptions for his career, making him the third Stony Brook receiver to reach 140 career receptions.

**PEAKS AND VALLEYS**

The Big South has wins this season over members from AQ Conferences the Colonial, Ohio Valley, Missouri Valley, Patriot and Southern. In Week 5, the Big South captured its first-ever win over a Missouri Valley Football Conference opponent (formerly the Gateway Football Conference) with Liberty's 31-28 win at Youngstown State. The Big South was winless in three previous meetings.
