Gowins continued his dominance over the second half of the season, leading Stony Brook with 250 rushing yards and three touchdowns against VMI. It was his second-straight 200-yard rushing game, in addition to the most rushing yards in a Big South game and the second-highest overall single-game rushing performance in League history. Gowins averaged 12.5 yards per carry, and on his second carry of the game, he ran for 36 yards and a score to give Stony Brook its first touchdown of the game. With the Seawolves leading by just three in the third quarter, Gowins broke off a 65-yard run for a score that answered a VMI scoring drive. In the fourth stanza, he answered another Keydet score with a 32-yard touchdown run that iced the game for Stony Brook. Gowins was named *The Sports Network's* National Player of the Week as well.

**NEW BALANCE**

Hursky led the Flames with 15 tackles (eight solo, seven assisted) against Gardner-Webb, and contributed 3.0 tackles for loss of 18 yards, 1.0 sack for minus-11 yards, one forced fumble and one quarterback hurry. His second sack of the year came on a first-and-goal play and eventually forced the Bulldogs to settle for a field goal. Hursky's 15 tackles were the second-highest total of his career, and helped the Flames' defense force a season-high five turnovers, as well as three quarterback hurries and four sacks.

**HISTORY MAKERS**

The Liberty Flames are the first Big South team to post a 5-0 record in League games following its 30-10 victory over Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. Liberty also is the second team in Big South history to win back-to-back outright championships with undefeated League marks, as the Flames were 4-0 in Conference action in 2007. Gardner-Webb was the first team to accomplish the feat, going 3-0 in 2002 and 4-0 in 2003.

**LIBERTY LOOKING TO BECOME SECOND BIG SOUTH TEAM WITH 10 WINS**

Liberty enters the regular-season finale against No. 12 Elon looking to become the second team in Big South history to win 10 games in a season. Coastal Carolina went 10-1 in 2004 to set the Conference record for most wins in a campaign.

**MARQUEE MATCH-UP**

No. 20 Liberty hosts No. 12 Elon Saturday. It is the third time in League history and the second time this season in which a ranked Big South member will face a nationally-ranked non-Conference opponent. Earlier this year on Sept. 27, the then-No. 25 Flames visited then-No. 23 Youngstown State. The first such occurrence was No. 13 Coastal Carolina vs. No. 1 Appalachian State in the 2006 FCS Playoffs.

**RASHAD GETS RUSHING RECORD SWEEP**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** broke the Big South single-season rushing record this past Saturday vs. Gardner-Webb. Jennings' 56 yards against the Bulldogs pushed his season total to 1,391, breaking the previous record of 1,347, set by **DRE BARNES** in 2003. At VMI in Week 11, Jennings broke Barnes' Big South career rushing record of 3,409, and enters the regular-season finale at 3,524 career yards.

**GOWIN, GOWIN, GONE**

One week after setting the Big South single-game rushing record with 278 yards at Iona, Stony Brook freshman RB **EDWIN GOWINS** set the Conference-game mark with 250 rushing yards against VMI this past Saturday in the Seawolves' season finale. He now owns the top two single-game rushing performances in Big South history. Gowins closes out the 2008 season with a Big South freshman record (True or Redshirt) 1,310 rushing yards.

**"I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 200 PLEASE, ALEX"**

Already the first pair of Big South teammates to rush for more than 200 yards in the same game when they did so last week at Iona, Stony Brook tandem **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** are now the first set of teammates to rush for more than 200 yards in the same game in consecutive weeks. Gowins totaled 250 rushing yards vs. VMI this past Saturday, while Cuttino added 233. It was the fourth time this season that Gowins and Cuttino rushed for 100 yards in the same game, the most times since Liberty had six pairs of teammates accomplish the feat in 2004. Gowins and Cuttino also tied the Big South record for most 200-yard rushing games in a season (two).

**"I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 1,000 PLEASE, ALEX"**

Stony Brook tandem **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,310 rushing yards) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (1,195) are the first pair of teammates in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in the same season.

**GOWINS, CUTTINO SET NCAA RECORD**

The rushing duo of **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** have set an NCAA FCS single-game record for most rushing yards gained by two players from the same team. Gowins and Cuttino combined for 483 rushing yards at Iona in Week 11, and duplicated the output this past Saturday vs. VMI. The previous record was 473, established by Eastern Washington in 1999.

**LIBERTY EXTENDS CONFERENCE WIN STREAK TO 11**

Liberty extended its Big South-record Conference games win streak to 11 with its 30-10 win over Gardner-Webb this past Saturday. During the run, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and is averaging 40.8 points, while holding their League brethren to 17.6 points. Liberty has won five of those 11 games on the road.

**HOME RUN**

Charleston Southern concluded its home schedule with a perfect 5-0 record, its second undefeated home slate since 2006. The Buccaneers are third the Big South team to post a perfect record at home twice since Big South football began in 2002. CSU joins Gardner-Webb (5-0 in 2002 and 6-0 in 2003) and Coastal Carolina (7-0 in 2004 and 5-0 in 2005) on the list.

**LIBERTY CLAIMS SECOND CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP**

Liberty officially won the 2008 Big South Football Championship in Week 11, as the Flames' 38-26 win at VMI, coupled with Gardner-Webb's loss to Coastal Carolina, gave Liberty the title with two games remaining. Liberty is now the third Big South football program to win back-to-back crowns, joining Gardner-Webb (2002, 2003) and Coastal Carolina (2004, 2005, 2006), and the second to win consecutive outright championships (Gardner-Webb in 2002 and 2003).

**STONY BROOK CLAIMS SECOND-PLACE**

First-year Big South football member Stony Brook University finished the Conference season with a 3-2 record, good for second-place in the League standings. The Seawolves could receive some company after this weekend's action, as Charleston Southern has a chance to finish 3-2 as well with a victory over Coastal Carolina.

**SEAWOLVES SET CONFERENCE-GAME RUSHING RECORD**

Stony Brook rushed for a Conference-game record 447 yards this past Saturday vs. VMI, breaking the old mark of 424, set by former member Elon against Liberty on Nov. 9, 2002. The Seawolves' total against the Keydets is the fifth-highest team rushing performance in League history, and came one week after Stony Brook set the Big South single-game record of 635 rushing yards at Iona in Week 11.

**THREE-PEAT**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South in rushing with 1,391 yards, and is the first player in Big South history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons. Jennings is looking to finish as the League's rushing leader for the first time in his career, as he fell short the past two seasons by a combined 11 yards.

**REESE'S PIECES**

Charleston Southern QB **TRIBBLE REESE** threw four touchdown passes against Edward Waters this past Saturday, his third 4-TD pass game of the season -- a Big South record. He also is the first player in Big South history to throw four touchdown passes in back-to-back games, as he had four TD strikes vs. Presbyterian in Week 11. In his last three games, Reese is 45-of-60 ( =75.0 percent) for 620 yards and 10 touchdowns.

**RECORD RASHAD**

Walter Payton Award candidate **RASHAD JENNINGS** broke his own Big South single-season touchdown record when he scored his 18th TD of the year this past Saturday vs. Gardner-Webb. Jennings' set the record of 17 in 2007. Of his 18 touchdowns this year, 16 are rushing scores -- another single-season record for Jennings. He is just the second player in Big South history with three 10-touchdown campaigns, and is second in League history with 45 career scores. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** is the Big South's career touchdown leader with 47.

**MAYPRAY SCORES ANOTHER FIRST**

VMI QB **TIM MAYPRAY** rushed for 99 yards Saturday at Stony Brook and became the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season in the process. He enters the final week of the regular-season fourth in the Big South with 1,031 rushing yards. Maypray broke the single-season quarterback rushing record of 656 yards in Week 7. Meanwhile, Maypray's nine rushing touchdowns ties the League record for most rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. The record was first established by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** in 2005.

**A LEAGUE FIRST**

The Big South has four 1,000-yard rushers this season in **RASHAD JENNINGS** (1,391), **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,310), **CONTE CUTTINO** (1,195) and **TIM MAYPRAY** (1,031) -- a single-season League record. The previous high was two players with 1,000 rushing yards, which was accomplished in 2003, 2006 and 2007.

**NOT YOUR AVERAGE FRESHMAN**

Stony Brook freshman RB **EDWIN GOWINS** has set the Big South single-season record for rushing yards per carry at 9.36. The old mark was 7.14, set by Coastal Carolina's **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. Gowins rushed for 1,310 yards on 140 attempts, and he had five games this season over 10.0 yards a carry, based on a minimum of 10 rushes a game. He also owns four of the top seven single-game yards per carry averages in Big South history.

**FLAMES CONTINUE RUN IN NATIONAL POLLS**

The Liberty Flames are nationally-ranked for the 11th consecutive week, extending its school record. Liberty is No. 22 in *The Sports Network* poll and No. 20 in the FCS Coaches Poll. The Flames entered the national Top 25 the week of Sept. 8 for the first time since 1998, when Liberty was ranked tied for No. 24 with Troy State in the Aug. 31, 1998 preseason ESPN/*USA Today* Division I-AA poll.

**END OF THE LINE**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS'** League-record of 10 consecutive 100-yard rushing games came to end this past Saturday against Gardner-Webb, as he finished the day with 56 yards rushing on 14 carries. Jennings started the streak against Gardner-Webb in the 2007 season finale, and broke the Big South record of seven consecutive 100-yard rushing games, which was established by Liberty's **EUGENE GOODMAN** from Nov. 15, 2003 to Oct. 2, 2004. Jennings has recorded 21 career 100-yard rushing games with the Flames, setting the all-time Conference record and surpassing **DRE BARNES'** previous record of 17 in Week 8.

**SEAWOLVES EAT UP THE YARDS**

Stony Brook gained 622 yards of total offense against VMI this past Saturday (447 rushing yards, 175 passing), becoming the first team in Big South history with 600 yards of total offense in back-to-back games, as well as the first team to surpass 600 total yards twice in one season. The Seawolves' 622 yards vs. VMI just missed the record for a Conference game, falling 16 yards short of Coastal Carolina's record 638 vs. Gardner-Webb in 2006.

**BROCK OF AGES**

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** will finish his career among the top passers in Big South history. He is second all-time in passing yards with 6,763, and needs 237 yards to become the second player with 7,000. Smith's 50 touchdown passes are third in history and three away from the No. 2 spot. His 467 completions are fourth-most in a career (20 shy of third-place), while his 780 career pass attempts are fourth in history. During his career, Smith has completed 59.9 percent of his passes, which ranks third-best in Conference annals. Smith will end his career fourth all-time in total offense, as his career total of 6,908 is more than 950 yards shy of third-place.

**CAMPBELL COMPLETES CAREER**

Gardner-Webb QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** concluded his collegiate football career this past Saturday at Liberty. He ends his tenure ranked fifth in Big South history in three categories: passing yards (5,614), completions (440) and touchdown passes (39). Earlier this year, Campbell became the first player in Big South history with two 400-yard total offense games, the first with 400 total offense yards in back-to-back games, and tied the Big South record for most consecutive 300-yard passing games with three.

**COLLINS CATCHES UP**

Gardner-Webb WR **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fifth different player in Big South history with 10 touchdown receptions in a season. He leads the League with 10 TD catches, which is the most by a Gardner-Webb receiver since **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** had 13 in 2005. Collins, who became the 13th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 7 at Georgia Tech, finishes his career tied for 5th in Conference annals with 143. Collins will likely finish as the season leader in receptions, as his League-leading 76 catches are 23 ahead of the next player still in action this year.

**BOLTEN BOLDEN**

Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** is 39 receiving yards away from becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 1,000 receiving yards in a season. His Big South-leading 961 receiving yards this season rank sixth-highest in a single-season in League annals. No Liberty player has ever led the Conference in receiving yards. Bolden recently became the third player in Big South history with three consecutive 100-yard receiving games.

**TEETER-TOTER**

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** and Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** each surpassed the 1,000 career receiving yard mark in Week 5, and have been leap-frogging each other since. Collins' 1,745 career yards rank 8th all-time. Charleston Southern's **MARKUS MURRY** moved ahead of Bolden and reclaimed the No. 10 spot this past Saturday with 1,715 career receiving yards. Bolden is 11th in League history with 1,686. Meanwhile, Bolden needs three receptions to become the 14th player in League history with 100 career catches.

**TAKING THEIR TREASURE**

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** leads the Big South with 76 catches and will likely become the first Bulldog since **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** in 2002 to lead the Big South in receptions. Andrews shared the League lead that season with Charleston Southern's **AARON DUNKLIN**. Charleston Southern's annual run of producing the top wide receiver in the Big South will end this season, as Bucs' leading receiver **GERALD STEVENSON** is currently 35 receptions away from the top spot. Stevenson's 41 catches this season rank ninth in the League. A Charleston Southern receiver led or shared the Big South lead in receptions the first six years of Big South football.

**BIG MAC**

Coastal Carolina sophomore QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** has moved into the League's all-time Top 10 in passing yards. He has thrown for 1,984 yards this season, good for the No. 10 position and unseating Liberty's **BROCK FARREL** (1,931). MacDowall's 16 touchdown passes are also just one away from the Top 10 all-time leaders.

**REESE'S CUPS**

Charleston Southern QB **TRIBBLE REESE** leads the Big South with 21 touchdown passes this season, which places him at seventh all-time on the Big South's career chart.

**STEVENSON EXTENDS BIG SOUTH CAREER KICKOFF RETURN YARDAGE RECORD**

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** collected 119 kickoff return yards during Week 9 at Liberty to surpass Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** as the Big South's career leader in kickoff return yards. Stevenson's career total currently stands at 1,462, ahead of Bolden's 1,409. Stevenson leads the Big South with 911 kickoff return yards this year, which is the second-highest single season total in League history. Former Buccaneer **KIJANA THOMAS** holds the season record of 1,148 kickoff return yards in 2003. Stevenson's 60 career kickoff returns are tied with Liberty's **ADRIAN HALL** (2002-04) for the most in Big South history.

**JENNINGS CLIMBING SCORING LADDER**

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has scored a Big South season record 108 points this year. He is the first player in Big South history to score 100 points in consecutive seasons, as he amassed the previous record of 104 points in 2007. Jennings is third all-time in League history with 272 career points (second-most by a non-kicker), and trails Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (297) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286) on the career scoring chart.

**POINT OF ORDER**

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 67 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. VMI (48) and Liberty (38) also have extended their respective scoring streaks. In addition, Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 29 games.

**A CLOSER LOOK AT VMI'S SCORING STREAK**

VMI's 48-game scoring streak is the longest run in the 118-year history of the program. The previous record was a 43-game stretch from 1919-1924. Earlier this year, the Keydets scored 30 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2003.

**SPEAKING OF POINTS...**

Gardner-Webb scored 30 points in a game six times this season, the most for the Bulldogs since reaching the 30-point plateau seven times in 2005.

**REAL ESTATE BROKERS**

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** and Liberty teammates **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **DOMINIC BOLDEN** are the Big South's active players with more than 3,000 all-purpose yards. Jennings surpassed Maypray for second all-time in Week 11, and stands at 4,034. Maypray is third at 3,949, while Bolden's career total of 3,421 is sixth all-time. VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** is the Big South's career leader with 4,621 all-purpose yards.

**50-50**

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fourth player in Big South history with back-to-back 50 reception seasons. He joins former teammate **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (three times), VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** (two) and Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** (two) with consecutive seasons with 50 catches. Collins' 76 receptions this year are a career-high and tied for third-most in a season in Big South history.

**NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING IN A RUSH**

VMI has broken its Big South single-season record for team rushing yards. With one game remaining, the Keydets have rushed for 3,435 yards this season, breaking their League record of 3,115 established in 2007. VMI's season rush average of 343.5 yards per game continues to lead the Big South and is second in the nation.

**CUTTING THROUGH THE CLUTTER**

Stony Brook junior **CONTE CUTTINO** became Stony Brook's all-time leading rusher this past Saturday after gaining a career-high 233 rushing yards vs. VMI. It is was career-best fifth consecutive 100-yard rushing game of the season and 12th of his career. Cuttino's 2,807 career rushing yards surpassed **RALPH MENENDEZ**'s previous school-record total of 2,623.

**GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE**

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **RYAN GATES** leads the Big South with 16 field goals made, which is a freshman record and second-most in a single-season in League history. Gates fell one field goal shy of tying the season record of 17, set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. This season Gates made two field goals in a game six times, and made six field goals from 40 yards-or-longer, including a career-long 49-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina in Week 11.

**CLOSE ENCOUNTERS**

In the 14 League games played thus far, seven have been decided by seven points-or-less (3.7 average) -- tying a Conference record. In 2005, seven Big South games were also decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory being 4.0 points in those contests.

**IF THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY**

Gardner-Webb sophomore LB **JEFFREY WILLIAMS** recorded 75 tackles in his final five games of the season (15.0 average), pushing his season total to a Big South-leading 119. He is looking to become the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in tackles since **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2002 (120). In 22 career games, Williams has 239 career tackles, a 10.9 per game career average.

**ACADEMIC HONORS**

The Big South placed six football student-athletes on the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III Team, the most All-District honorees in League history. Liberty led the way with four honorees: **DAN POPE**, **RYAN GREISER**, **COLIN DUGAN** and **KEVIN RICHARD**. Coastal Carolina's **DER-RICK FRASIER** and VMI's **JACOB ROCHESTER** were also named to the team. All six student-athletes move onto the Academic All-America ballot.

**STONY BROOK'S RECORD-SETTING DAY**

Stony Brook won at Iona 68-9 in Week 11. The Seawolves tied a Big South record for most touchdowns scored with 10, while their 68 points are tied for fourth-most in a game by a Big South member. Stony Brook compiled 668 yards of total offense (635 rushing, 33 passing), which is the second-highest output by a League team. SBU's 9.54 yards per play is fourth-best, while its 10.08 yards per rush is the second-best single-game team rushing average in Big South history. Lastly, Stony Brook's 59-point win is the fourth-largest margin of victory in Conference annals.

The victory was the first for the Blue Hose over a Big South team in 2008.
