Gowins rushed for a Big South single-game record 278 yards and three touchdowns in Stony Brook's victory at Iona, breaking the League's single-game rushing record by 33 yards. Nine of his 19 carries went for more than 10 yards and he had touchdown runs of 3, 29 and 62 yards on the day. Gowins accounted for 43 yards on SBU's second drive of the game and finished the day with a 14.63 yards per carry average - the third-highest average in Big South history. Gowins now leads all freshmen in FCS in rushing and his performance pushed him over the 1,000-yard mark on the season, becoming the first Big South freshman to accomplish that feat.

Lott recorded a career-high six tackles (including a personal-best three solos), along with his first collegiate interception and three pass break-ups in Coastal Carolina's victory at Gardner-Webb. Making just his second career start due to injuries, Lott had one of the game's crucial plays when he broke up the Bulldogs' two-point conversion late in the fourth quarter to preserve the Chanticleers' two-point lead and the win. His third quarter interception also ended a Gardner-Webb threat, as the Bulldogs were in Chanticleer territory when the pick occurred.

LIBERTY CLAIMS SECOND CONSECUTIVE BIG SOUTH FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

Liberty has officially won the 2008 Big South Football Championship, as the Flames' 38-26 win at VMI Saturday, coupled with Gardner-Webb's loss to Coastal Carolina, gives Liberty the title. No team can match the Flames' four League wins this season. Liberty is now the third Big South football program to win back-to-back crowns, joining Gardner-Webb (2002, 2003) and Coastal Carolina (2004, 2005, 2006).

GOING FOR HISTORY

With its football championship in tow, the Liberty Flames are looking to become the first Big South team to post a 5-0 record in League games. From 2003-07, Big South teams each played four Conference games. This is the fifth season a League member has been 4-0 in Conference action. The others are 2003 (Gardner-Webb), 2004 (Coastal Carolina), 2006 (Coastal Carolina) and 2007 (Liberty). In 2009, the Conference season increases to six games each with the official inclusion of Presbyterian.

BIG SOUTH TELEVISION PACKAGE CONCLUDES SATURDAY

The 2008 Big South Television package concludes Saturday, Nov. 15 with VMI at Stony Brook live on the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) at 3:30pm. **DAVE WEEKLEY** (play-by-play) and **GUS ORNSTEIN** (analyst) will call the action. Meanwhile, MASN will simulcast the Flames Television Network's broadcast of Gardner-Webb at Liberty at 7:00pm on Saturday, as well as Liberty's showdown with Elon on Nov. 22 at 1:00pm.

GOWIN, GOWIN, GONE

Stony Brook freshman RB **EDWIN GOWINS** broke the Big South single-game rushing record Saturday at Iona. Gowins rushed for 278 yards, breaking the old mark of 245, which was set by Elon's **RASHAUD PALMER** vs. Liberty on Nov. 9, 2002. Gowins averaged 14.63 yards on his 19 carries, the third-highest single-game average in Big South history. He also became the first freshman -- True or Redshirt -- in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season, as he finished the day at 1,060 on the year.

RECORD IS RASHAD'S

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** became the Big South's all-time leading rusher Saturday at VMI after rushing for 147 yards against the Keydets. His career total of 3,468 surpasses **DRE BARNES'** previous League record of 3,409 yards. Meanwhile, Jennings' season total of 1,335 rushing yards is 13 shy of breaking Barnes' single-season Big South record of 1,347, set in 2003.

"I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 200 PLEASE, ALEX"

Stony Brook tandem **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** became the first set of Big South teammates to rush for more than 200 yards in the same game when they each eclipsed the mark this past Saturday at Iona. Gowins went for a Big South-record 278 yards, while Cuttino gained 205. It was the third time this season Gowins and Cuttino rushed for 100 yards in the same game, the most times since Liberty did it six times in 2004.

"I'LL TAKE RUSHING FOR 1,000 PLEASE, ALEX"

Stony Brook tandem **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,060 rushing yards) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (962) are on the cusp of becoming the first pair of teammates in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in the same season.

SEAWOLVES DO DAMAGE ON LAND

Stony Brook rushed for a Big South single-game record 635 yards this past Saturday in its 68-9 win at Iona. The Seawolves shattered the old mark of 517, which was set by VMI earlier this season against Chowan on Sept. 20. Stony Brook's rushing output pushed the squad's season average to more than 200 rushing yards per game at 207.5. SBU entered the contest averaging 160.0 rushing yards.

LIBERTY FIRST BIG SOUTH TEAM TO WIN 10 CONSECUTIVE LEAGUE GAMES

Liberty extended its Conference games win streak to 10 with its 38-26 win at VMI this past Saturday. During the run, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and is averaging 41.9 points, while holding their League brethren to 18.4 points. Liberty has won five of those 10 games on the road.

THREE-PEAT

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** leads the Big South in rushing with 1,335 yards, and is the first player in Big South history with three 1,000-yard rushing seasons. Jennings is looking to finish as the League's rushing leader for the first time in his career, as he has fallen short the past two seasons by a combined 11 yards.

RECORD RASHAD

Walter Payton Award candidate **RASHAD JENNINGS** has tied his Big South single-season record of 17 touchdowns after scoring twice at VMI this past Saturday. Of his 17 touchdowns this year, 15 are rushing scores, which also matches his single-season rushing TD record. Jennings, who is just the second player in Big South history with three 10-touchdown campaigns, and is now tied with Coastal Carolina's **JEROME SIMPSON** for second in League history with 44 career scores. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** is the Big South's career touchdown leader with 47.

ARM & HAMMER

Gardner-Webb QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** recorded his third consecutive game with more than 300 passing yards after throwing for 338 Saturday vs. Coastal Carolina, tying the Big South record. Campbell threw for 392 yards in Week 9 vs. VMI and 394 at Stony Brook in Week 10 -- the first in League history with consecutive games over 390 yards. Campbell has matched the record set by former Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN**, who in 2006 threw for 306 yards at Gardner-Webb on Nov. 11, 325 against Charleston Southern on Nov. 18 and 351 yards in the Chanticleers' playoff game at Appalachian State on Nov. 25. Thigpen also owns the record for most 300-yard passing games in one season (5).

MORE ON STONY BROOK'S RECORD-SETTING DAY

Stony Brook won at Iona this past Saturday, 68-9. The Seawolves tied a Big South record for most touchdowns scored with 10, while their 68 points are tied for fourth-most in a game by a Big South member. Stony Brook compiled 668 yards of total offense (635 rushing, 33 passing), which is the second-highest output by a League team. SBU's 9.54 yards per play is fourth-best, while its 10.08 yards per rush is the second-best single-game team rushing average in Big South history. Lastly, Stony Brook's 59-point win is the fourth-largest margin of victory in Conference annals.

CENTURY MAN

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** has rushed for 100 yards in a Big South-record 10 consecutive games, dating back to last season. The previous high was seven consecutive games set by Liberty's **EUGENE GOODMAN** from Nov. 15, 2003 to Oct. 2, 2004. Jennings has recorded 21 career 100-yard rushing games with the Flames, setting the all-time Conference record and surpassing **DRE BARNES'** previous record of 17 in Week 8.

FLAMES REMAIN IN NATIONAL POLLS

The Liberty Flames are nationally-ranked for the 10th consecutive week, extending its school record. Liberty is No. 24 in *The Sports Network* poll and No. 22 in the FCS Coaches Poll. The Flames entered the national Top 25 the week of Sept. 8 for the first time since 1998, when Liberty was ranked tied for No. 24 with Troy State in the Aug. 31, 1998 preseason ESPN/*USA Today* Division I-AA poll.

COLLINS CATCHES UP

Gardner-Webb WR **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fifth different player in Big South history with 10 touchdown receptions in a season. He leads the League with 10 TD catches, which is the most by a Gardner-Webb receiver since **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** had 13 in 2005. Collins, who became the 13th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 7 at Georgia Tech, is 7th in Conference annals with 133. He needs six catches for sixth-place in history. In his last seven games, Collins is averaging 7.3 receptions a contest and 95.3 receiving yards to move into first in the League with 66 receptions and second with 828 yards.

BOLTEN BOLDEN

Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** is 120 receiving yards away from becoming the fourth player in Big South history with 1,000 receiving yards in a season. His Big South-leading 880 receiving yards this season rank seventh-highest in a single-season in League annals. No Liberty player has ever led the Conference in receiving yards. Bolden's three consecutive games streak with 100-yard receiving yards ended this past Saturday at VMI. He was the third player in Big South history to accomplish the feat.

MAYPRAY CLOSING IN ON ANOTHER FIRST

VMI QB **TIM MAYPRAY** is 68 rushing yards shy of becoming the first quarterback in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in a season. He broke the single-season quarterback rushing record of 656 yards in Week 7. Maypray has scored eight rushing touchdowns from his QB position this season, one away from tying the Big South single-season record for most rushing touchdowns by a quarterback. The record of nine was set by Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** in 2005.

SPEAKING OF FIRSTS

With Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** and Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** already over the mark, the Big South could have a single-season record four 1,000-yard rushers this season. Stony Brook's **CONTE CUTTINO** is third in the League with 962 yards, while **TIM MAYPRAY** is fourth at 932.

TEETER-TOTER

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** and Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** each surpassed the 1,000 career receiving yard mark in Week 5, and have been leap-frogging each other since. Collins' 1,636 career yards rank 10th all-time and move him past Bolden and Charleston Southern's **MARKUS MURRY** on the career list. Murry sat in the 10th spot last week, but is now 11th at 1,615 yards. Bolden remains in 12th place in history with 1,605. Meanwhile, Bolden needs seven receptions to become the 14th player in League history with 100 career catches.

TAKING THEIR TREASURE

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** leads the Big South with 66 catches and is looking to become the first Bulldog since **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** in 2002 to lead the Big South in receptions. Andrews shared the League lead that season with Charleston Southern's **AARON DUNKLIN**. Charleston Southern's annual run of producing the top wide receiver in the Big South is in jeopardy this season, as Bucs' leading receiver **GERALD STEVENSON** is currently 27 receptions away from the top spot. Stevenson's 39 catches this season rank ninth in the League. A Charleston Southern receiver has led or shared the Big South lead in receptions every year of Big South football.

BROCK OF AGES

With two weeks remaining in the regular-season, Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** will finish his career among the top passers in Big South history. He is fourth all-time in passing yards with 6,537, but needs just 154 to move into second-place. Smith's 48 touchdown passes are tied for third in history and is six away from the No. 2 spot. His 456 completions are fourth-most in a career (31 shy of third-place), while his 762 career pass attempts are fourth in history. During his career, Smith has completed 59.8 percent of his passes, which ranks third-best in Conference annals. Smith will end his career fourth all-time in total offense, as his career total of 6,652 is more than 1,200 yards shy of third-place.

BIG MAC

Coastal Carolina sophomore QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** is closing in on the League's all-time Top 10 in passing yards. He has thrown for 1,856 yards this season, just 75 away from the No. 10 position, which is held by Liberty's **BROCK FARREL** at 1,931. MacDowall's 15 touchdown passes are also just two away from the all-time leaders.

REESE'S PIECES

Charleston Southern QB **TRIBBLE REESE** has thrown four touchdown passes in a game twice this season, the first Big South quarterback to do so since both Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** and Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** did it in 2006. Reese is tied for the Big South lead with 17 touchdown passes this season, which places him at eighth all-time on the Big South's career Top 10 chart.

STEVENSON EXTENDS BIG SOUTH CAREER KICKOFF RETURN YARDAGE RECORD

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** collected 119 kickoff return yards during Week 9 at Liberty to surpass Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** as the Big South's career leader in kickoff return yards. Stevenson's career total stands at 1,420, ahead of Bolden's 1,369. Stevenson leads the Big South with 869 kickoff return yards this year, which is the third-highest single season total in League history. Stevenson needs one more kickoff return to tie the Big South career record of 60, set by Liberty's **ADRIAN HALL** from 2002-04.

JENNINGS CLIMBING SCORING LADDER

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** is the first player in Big South history to score 100 points in consecutive seasons. Jennings leads the Big South with 102 points this year. He amassed a single-season record 104 points in 2007. Jennings is now third all-time in League history with 266 career points (second-most by a non-kicker), and trails Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (297) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286) on the career scoring chart.

THREE BALL

Stony Brook's **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** each rushed for three touchdowns in the Seawolves' 68-9 win at Iona this past Saturday, becoming the first set of teammates to score three TDs in the same game since Liberty's **RASHAD JENNINGS** (3) and **DOMINIC BOLDEN** (3) did it against VMI on Nov. 10, 2007. It was the fourth overall occurrence in Big South history.

POINT OF ORDER

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 66 games in its history, extending its Big South record for consecutive games with a point. VMI (47) and Liberty (37) also have extended their respective scoring streaks. In addition, Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 28 games.

A CLOSER LOOK AT VMI'S SCORING STREAK

VMI's 47-game scoring streak is the longest run in the 118-year history of the program. The previous record was a 43-game stretch from 1919-1924. Earlier this year, the Keydets scored 30 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2003.

SPEAKING OF POINTS...

Gardner-Webb has scored 30 points in a game six times this season, the most for the Bulldogs since reaching the 30-point plateau seven times in 2005.

REAL ESTATE BROKERS

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** and Liberty teammates **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **DOMINIC BOLDEN** are the Big South's active players with more than 3,000 all-purpose yards. Jennings surpassed Maypray this past Saturday for second all-time at 3,924. Maypray is third at 3,850, while Bolden's career total of 3,300 is sixth all-time. VMI's **SEAN MIZZER** is the Big South's career leader with 4,621 all-purpose yards.

RUNNING FOR A PURPOSE

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** is challenging the Big South single-season record for all-purpose yards. His total of 1,612 is second-most in a season, and at his current per game clip of 161.2, he would finish at 1,934 -- just short of the record of 1,975, which was established by **TIM MAYPRAY** last season. Stevenson would need to average 182.0 all-purpose yards in the final two games to break the mark.

50-50

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fourth player in Big South history with back-to-back 50 reception seasons. He joins former teammate **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (three times), VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** (two) and Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** (two) with consecutive seasons with 50 catches. Collins' 66 receptions this year are a career-high and seventh-most in a season in Big South history.

NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING IN A RUSH

VMI's season rush average of 341.2 yards per game continues to lead the Big South and is second in the nation. The Keydets are well ahead of their Big South record of 283.2 rushing yards per game set last season, and need 45 team rushing yards to break their League record of 3,115 yards established in 2007. VMI is on pace for 3,753 rushing yards this season.

CUTTING THROUGH THE CLUTTER

Stony Brook junior **CONTE CUTTINO** surpassed 2,000 career rushing yards on his third carry of the game in Week 8 vs. Charleston Southern. He recorded his career-best fourth consecutive 100-yard rushing game of the season with 205 yards at Iona, and is second all-time at Stony Brook with 2,577 rushing yards. Cuttino, who has 11 career 100-yard rushing games, is third in the Big South in rushing this season with 962 yards.

GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **RYAN GATES** leads the Big South with 15 field goals made, which is a freshman record and tied for second-most in a single-season in League history. Gates is two makes away from tying the season record of 17, set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. Gates has made two field goals in a game six times this season, and has made six field goals from 40 yards-or-longer, including a career-long 49-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina this past Saturday.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

In the 12 League games played thus far, seven have been decided by seven points-or-less (3.7 average) -- tying a Conference record. In 2005, seven Big South games were also decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory being 4.0 points in those contests.

IF THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Gardner-Webb sophomore LB **JEFFREY WILLIAMS** has recorded 60 tackles in his last four games (15.0 average), pushing his season total to a Big South-leading 104. He is looking to become the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in tackles since **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2002 (120). In 21 career games, Williams has 224 career tackles, a 10.7 per game career average.

ACADEMIC HONORS

The Big South placed six football student-athletes on the *ESPN The Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-District III Team, the most All-District honorees in League history. Liberty led the way with four honorees: **DAN POPE, RYAN GREISER, COLIN DUGAN** and **KEVIN RICHARD**. Coastal Carolina's **DER-RICK FRASIER** and VMI's **JACOB ROCHESTER** were also named to the team. All six student-athletes move onto the Academic All-America ballot.

PRESBYTERIAN SCORES HISTORICAL UPSET

Presbyterian defeated then-No. 17 Liberty, 31-28 in Week 10 -- its first-ever win over a nationally-ranked NCAA Division I FCS program. The loss snapped the Flames' Big South-record five-game road winning streak. The game was not an official Conference game since Presbyterian is not playing a complete League slate in 2008. The victory was the first for the Blue Hose over a Big South team in 2008.

YARD MARKERS

Two Big South teams have combined for 1,000 yards of total offense in a game three times this season. In Week 10, Stony Brook (525) and Gardner-Webb (480) combined for 1,005 total offensive yards. It was Gardner-Webb's second combined 1,000-yard game, as the Bulldogs (514) and Presbyterian (492) combined for 1,006 yards on Oct. 18. Earlier this season on Oct. 4, Coastal Carolina (534) and Liberty (531) combined for a Conference game record 1,065 yards.

MMMM, GOOD

Gardner-Webb QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** is the first player in Big South history to compile 400 yards of total offense in consecutive games, let alone the first with two 400-yard total offense games in a season. In Week 9, Campbell finished with 409 total offensive yards against VMI, and followed that up with exactly 400 at Stony Brook in Week 10.

ZERO TOLERANCE

Liberty blanked Charleston Southern 42-0 in Week 9, marking its second consecutive shutout of a Big South opponent this season. It is the first time in League history that a member has recorded two shutouts during the Conference season, let alone consecutively. In fact, Liberty shutout three Big South foes in a four-game span, dating back to last year's 31-0 win over Gardner-Webb in the season finale. The Flames have recorded a League-best six shutouts since Big South football began in 2002.
