CHOICE HOTELS OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

TIM MAYPRAY • QB/SB • Junior
 VMI • Madisonville, Ky.

Maypray amassed 332 all-purpose yards and tied a Big South single-game record with four touchdowns scored in VMI's 49-27 win over Presbyterian. Maypray rushed for a career-high 235 yards on 20 carries (11.8 yards per rush), and caught three passes for 97 yards. He scored rushing touchdowns of 4, 60 and 34 yards, and added a 75-yard touchdown reception. Maypray's 332 all-purpose yards are second-most in a game in Big South history, and his 97 receiving yards pushed him over the 1,000 career mark, becoming the first player in League annals with 1,000 career rushing yards and 1,000 career receiving yards. For his efforts, Maypray was named *The Sports Network's* National Player of the Week as well.

NEW BALANCE DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

NICK HURSKY • LB • Senior
 Liberty • Carnegie, Pa.

Hursky's 12 tackles led a defensive unit that held No. 12 Elon to just three points and 267 total offensive yards - 133 less yards than its season average. He also posted a tackle-for-loss and had two quarterback hurries on the day. Hursky made two critical stops for the Flames in the third quarter. With Elon deep in Liberty territory, Hursky posted a tackle-for-loss on second down, then recorded a third down stop at the LU 12-yard line that forced a field goal attempt. Earlier in the game, he forced Elon into another fourth down with a quarterback hurry.

SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

LIBERTY SPECIALS TEAMS UNIT

The Flames' Special Teams Unit accounted for 20 of Liberty's 26 points against Elon. **MATT BEVINS** was 4-of-4 on field goal attempts, tying a Big South single-game record, and made his field goals from four different yardage groups. **DOMINIC BOLDEN** returned a punt 74 yards for a touchdown to give the Flames a 10-0 lead in the second quarter. In the third quarter, **TREY JACOBS** blocked his second kick of the year, stopping a 28-yard field goal attempt. Punter **MIKE LARSSON** placed both of his punts inside the 20-yard line.

LIBERTY BECOMES SECOND BIG SOUTH TEAM WITH 10 WINS

Liberty is the second team in Big South history to win 10 games in a season following its 26-3 victory over No. 12 Elon this past Saturday. It is a school-record win total for the Flames, as its previous best was nine wins in 1979 and 1997. Liberty joins the 2004 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers, who went 10-1 to initially set the Conference record for most wins in a campaign.

LIBERTY KNOCKS OFF SECOND RANKED TEAM IN 2008

Liberty's 26-3 victory over No. 12 Elon was the Flames' second win over a nationally-ranked opponent in 2008. LU defeated then-No. 23 Youngstown State in Week 5. It also was its third-straight win over a ranked team, as the streak started in 2006 with a victory over then-No. 24/25 Charleston Southern on Nov. 11. Liberty is the second Big South team in League history to defeat two nationally-ranked non-Conference foes in a season, joining the 2005 Coastal Carolina Chanticleers. That season, Coastal Carolina defeated No. 1 James Madison and No. 17 South Carolina State.

FOUR SCORE AND SEVEN YEARS

The seventh season of Big South football ended with two single-game records being tied. VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** scored a record-tying four touchdowns (three rushing, one receiving) against Presbyterian in the season finale, while Liberty kicker **MATT BEVINS** made a record-tying four field goals in the Flames' victory over No. 12 Elon.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN SNAPS CHANTICLEERS RECORD STREAK

Charleston Southern's 24-0 blanking of Coastal Carolina in the season finale ended the Chanticleers' Big South-record 67-game scoring streak. The Chants had scored a point in every game in its history prior to being shutout by the Buccaneers. VMI takes over the active streak, as the Keydets have scored a point in their last 49 games. Liberty's current streak stands at 39 games, while Presbyterian has not been shutout in its last 30 games.

A CLOSER LOOK AT VMI'S SCORING STREAK

VMI's 49-game scoring streak is the longest run in the 118-year history of the program. The previous record was a 43-game stretch from 1919-1924. Earlier this year, the Keydets scored 30 points in back-to-back games for the first time since 2003.

ALL THE WAY MAYPRAY

VMI's all-everything **TIM MAYPRAY** gained 332 all-purpose yards in the season finale against Presbyterian, the second-highest single-game total in Big South history. It was his record second career 300-yard all-purpose game, and pushed him back into second-place on the career list with 4,281 all-purpose yards. Maypray rushed for a career-high 235 yards against the Blue Hose out of the quarterback/slot back position, and also caught three passes for 97 yards.

REESE'S PIECES

Charleston Southern QB **TRIBBLE REESE** finished his only season with the Buccaneers leading the Big South with 23 touchdown passes, the second-most in a single-season in Big South history. Reese's total also places him seventh all-time on the Big South's career chart. During the 2008 campaign, he became the first player in Big South history to throw four touchdown passes in back-to-back games, and had three games with four TD passes -- another Big South record.

MAYPRAY GETS UNIQUE RECORDS

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** is the first player in Big South history with 1,000 career rushing yards and 1,000 career receiving yards, as he surpassed the receiving milestone in the season finale vs. Presbyterian. Maypray has rushed for 1,937 yards, and has amassed 1,027 receiving yards in his three years with the Keydets. He also is the first with 10 career rushing touchdowns (16) and 10 career touchdown receptions (10).

TOTAL RECALL

VMI set a Big South single-game record for total offense yards per play in the season finale against Presbyterian. The Keydets averaged 10.45 yards per play (648 yards on 62 plays) against the Blue Hose, breaking the old mark of 9.91, which was set by Coastal Carolina against VMI in 2006. Meanwhile, VMI is the second Big South team to amass more than 600 yards of total offense in a game this season, as the Keydets also gained 659 yards against Chowan in Week 3. VMI joins Stony Brook, as the Seawolves posted 669 yards vs. Iona in Week 11 and 622 the following week vs. VMI.

BOLDEN RIGHT BY YOU...

With 308 punt return yards this year, Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** broke the Big South's single season record. Former teammate **WYNTON JACKSON** set the mark of 298 in 2006. Bolden's 18.1 punt return average also broke the previous best of 16.5, which was established by Gardner-Webb's **KORY ALSTON** in 2005. Bolden's two punt return TDs this year tied the League's season record.

BIG PLAY MAYPRAY

VMI's **TIM MAYPRAY** became the first player in Big South history to record a 60-yard rushing touchdown and a 75-yard receiving touchdown in the same game when he accomplished the feat in the season finale against Presbyterian. He also added a 50-yard non-scoring run against the Blue Hose. Maypray, who earlier in the year became the first player in League history with a 50-yard run in four-straight games, ended the season with seven rushes of 50-yards or longer. He also threw a 74-yard touchdown pass against Chowan in Week 3.

HISTORY MAKERS

The Big South Football Champion Liberty Flames are the first Big South team to post a 5-0 record in League games following its 30-10 victory over Gardner-Webb in Week 12. Liberty also is the second team in Big South history to win back-to-back outright championships with undefeated League marks, as the Flames were 4-0 in Conference action in 2007. Gardner-Webb was the first team to accomplish the feat, going 3-0 in 2002 and 4-0 in 2003.

RECORD RASHAD

Walter Payton Award finalist **RASHAD JENNINGS** scored a Big South single-season record 19 touchdowns this season (17 rushing, two receiving). He broke his own Big South single-season touchdown record in Week 12 vs. Gardner-Webb when he scored his 18th TD of the year. His 17 rushing scores are another single-season record. Just the second player in Big South history with three 10-touchdown campaigns, Jennings finishes his career second in League history with 46 career scores. Coastal Carolina's **AUNDRES PERKINS** is the Big South's career touchdown leader with 47.

NOTHING WRONG WITH BEING IN A RUSH

VMI set the Big South single-season team rushing record for the second consecutive season. The Keydets rushed for 3,932 yards in 2008, breaking their League mark of 3,115 established last year. VMI's season rush average of 357.5 currently ranks first in the nation and eclipses last season's Big South record average of 283.2. The Keydets scored 37 rushing touchdowns this season, the second-most in Big South history and three shy of the single-season record of 40 (Coastal Carolina in 2004).

RASHAD DEPARTS WITH RUSHING RECORD SWEEP

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** concluded his season with a Big South single-season record 1,500 rushing yards, his first Big South rushing title. He had just missed leading the League the last two seasons by a combined 11 yards. Jennings, who is the only player in Big South history to rush for 1,000 yards in three-straight seasons, broke the season record of 1,347 yards in Week 12 vs. Gardner-Webb. He became the Big South's all-time leading rusher in Week 11 at VMI, and departs the Conference with the new career standard of 3,633.

DYNAMIC DUO

Stony Brook's rushing duo of **EDWIN GOWINS** and **CONTE CUTTINO** set an NCAA FCS single-game record this season for most rushing yards gained by two players from the same team. Gowins and Cuttino combined for 483 rushing yards at Iona in Week 11, and duplicated the output in Week 12 vs. VMI. The previous record was 473, established by Eastern Washington in 1999. Gowins and Cuttino are the first set of teammates in Big South history to rush for more than 200 yards in the same game in consecutive weeks, and are the first pair of teammates in League history to rush for 1,000 yards in the same season. Gowins finished second in the Conference with 1,310 rushing yards, while Cuttino was fourth with 1,195.

A LEAGUE FIRST

The Big South had four 1,000-yard rushers this season in **RASHAD JENNINGS** (1,500), **EDWIN GOWINS** (1,310), **TIM MAYPRAY** (1,266) and **CONTE CUTTINO** (1,195) -- a single-season League record. The previous high was two players with 1,000 rushing yards, which was accomplished in 2003, 2006 and 2007.

NOT YOUR AVERAGE FRESHMAN

Stony Brook freshman RB **EDWIN GOWINS** has set the Big South single-season record for rushing yards per carry at 9.36. The old mark was 7.14, set by Coastal Carolina's **PATRICK HALL** in 2004. Gowins rushed for 1,310 yards on 140 attempts, and he had five games this season over 10.0 yards a carry, based on a minimum of 10 rushes a game. He also owns four of the top seven single-game yards per carry averages in Big South history.

HOME RUN

Charleston Southern concluded its home schedule with a perfect 5-0 record, its second undefeated home slate since 2006. The Buccaneers are the third Big South team to post a perfect record at home twice since Big South football began in 2002. CSU joins Gardner-Webb (5-0 in 2002 and 6-0 in 2003) and Coastal Carolina (7-0 in 2004 and 5-0 in 2005) on the list.

LIBERTY CARRIES 11-GAME CONFERENCE WIN STREAK INTO 2009

Liberty will enter 2009 with its Big South-record 11-game Conference win streak intact. During the run, the Flames have scored at least 30 points in each game and is averaging 40.8 points, while holding their League brethren to 17.6 points. Liberty has won five of those 11 games on the road.

GOWIN, GOWIN, GONE

One week after setting the Big South single-game rushing record with 278 yards at Iona in Week 11, Stony Brook freshman RB **EDWIN GOWINS** set the Conference-game mark with 250 rushing yards against VMI in Week 12 in the Seawolves' season finale. He owns the top two single-game rushing performances in Big South history. Gowins closed out the 2008 season with a Big South freshman record (True or Redshirt) 1,310 rushing yards.

FLAMES CONTINUE RUN IN NATIONAL POLLS

The Liberty Flames are nationally-ranked for the 12th consecutive week, extending its school record. Liberty is No. 14 in *The Sports Network* poll following its defeat of No. 12 Elon, up from No. 22 last week. The Flames are No. 15 in the FCS Coaches Poll, up from No. 20. The Flames entered the national Top 25 the week of Sept. 8 for the first time since 1998, when Liberty was ranked tied for No. 24 with Troy State in the Aug. 31, 1998 preseason ESPN/USA Today Division I-AA poll.

A GREAT RUN

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS'** concludes his Big South tenure with a League record 22 career 100-yard rushing games following his 109 yard output vs. Elon in the season finale. Jennings also owns the Conference mark for most consecutive 100-yard rushing games (10) and the most consecutive 100-yard rushing games in a single-season (9).

BROCK OF AGES

Liberty QB **BROCK SMITH** finishes his career among the top passers in Big South history. He is second all-time in passing yards with 7,036 -- just the second player with 7,000 career passing yards, and third in history with 50 touchdown passes. Smith's 484 completions are fourth-most in a career, while his 806 career pass attempts are also fourth in history. During his career, Smith completed 60.0 percent of his passes, which ranks third-best in Conference annals. Smith ends his career fourth all-time in total offense with 7,189 yards.

CLOSE ENCOUNTERS

Seven of the 15 League games played this season were decided by seven points-or-less (3.7 average) -- tying a Conference record. In 2005, seven Big South games were also decided by seven points-or-less, with the average margin of victory being 4.0 points in those contests.

TAKING THEIR TREASURE

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** led the Big South with 76 catches and is the first Bulldog since **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** in 2002 to lead the Conference in receptions. Andrews shared the League lead that season with Charleston Southern's **AARON DUNKLIN**. Charleston Southern's annual run of producing the top wide receiver in the Big South is over, as Bucs' leading receiver **GERALD STEVENSON** finished eighth in the League with 45 receptions. A Charleston Southern receiver had led or shared the Big South lead in receptions the first six years of Big South football.

ALL CAUGHT UP

Gardner-Webb WR **DOBSON COLLINS'** 76 receptions this year tied for third-most in a single-season in Big South history. He also led the League with 10 touchdown catches -- the fifth different player with 10 TD grabs in a season and the most by a Gardner-Webb receiver since **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** had 13 in 2005. Collins, who became the 13th player in Big South history with 100 career receptions in Week 7 at Georgia Tech, finishes his career tied for fifth in Conference annals with 143.

BOLDEN GETS HIS HUNDRED

Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** finished with six catches against No. 12 Elon in the season finale, pushing his career total to 103 receptions. He is the 14th player in League history with 100 career catches and third Liberty player on the Big South's all-time receptions list.

BOLTEN BOLDEN

Liberty WR **DOMINIC BOLDEN** became the fourth player in Big South history with 1,000 receiving yards in a season. His Big South-leading 1,056 receiving yards this year is second-most in a single-season in League annals and 21 yards shy of the Conference mark of 1,077 (**JEROME SIMPSON** in 2006). Bolden, who became the third player in Big South history with three consecutive 100-yard receiving games during the season, is the first Liberty player to lead the Big South in receiving yards.

TEETER-TOTER

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** and Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** each surpassed the 1,000 career receiving yard mark in Week 5, and vaulted each other since. With the season complete, Bolden finished ahead of Collins with 1,781 receiving yards -- good for seventh in Big South history. Collins' 1,745 career yards was eighth all-time last week, but with Bolden's jump in the final week, officially falls to ninth. Charleston Southern's **MARKUS MURRY** ended his career with 1,736 career receiving yards, but fell out of the Top 10 due to Bolden's final game.

NO SOPHOMORE SLUMP

Charleston Southern's **GERALD STEVENSON** concludes his sophomore season as the Big South's career leader in kickoff returns (61) and kickoff return yardage (1,472). Stevenson became the League's all-time returner in the season finale at Coastal Carolina, and the yardage leader in Week 9. Stevenson's 921 kickoff return yards this season are the second-highest single-season total in Big South history. Meanwhile, Stevenson's 1,780 all-purpose yards this season is third all-time, pushing his two-year total to 2,482.

JENNINGS A PURE SCORER

Liberty RB **RASHAD JENNINGS** scored a Big South season record 114 points this year. He is the first player in Big South history to score 100 points in consecutive seasons, as he amassed the previous record of 104 points in 2007. Jennings finishes his career third all-time in League history with 278 career points (second-most by a non-kicker), behind Coastal Carolina's **JOSH HOKE** (297) and **AUNDRES PERKINS** (286) on the career scoring chart.

BIG SOUTH 1,000-YARD RUSHERS

GOLDEN GATES BRIDGE

Gardner-Webb freshman kicker **RYAN GATES** led the Big South with 16 field goals made, which is a freshman record and second-most in a single-season in League history. Gates fell one field goal shy of tying the season record of 17, set by VMI's **MATT SHARPE** in 2003. This season, Gates made two field goals in a game six times, and made six field goals from 40 yards-or-longer, including a career-long 49-yarder vs. Coastal Carolina in Week 11.

IF THERE'S A WILL, THERE'S A WAY

Gardner-Webb sophomore LB **JEFFREY WILLIAMS** recorded 75 tackles in his final five games of the season (15.0 average), pushing his season total to a Big South-leading 119. He is the first Gardner-Webb player to lead the Big South in tackles since **MARIO WILLIAMS** in 2002 (120). In 22 career games, Williams has 239 career tackles, a 10.9 per game career average.

Charleston Southern's **PHILIP ASHLEY** led the Big South with six interceptions this season, tying the Big South single-season record. Coastal Carolina's **QUINTON TEAL** established the record in 2004. Ashley's 11 career interceptions are tied for second all-time in League history, and six behind Teal's career mark of 17.

McSACKY

Presbyterian senior **ADAM MCKINNEY** led the Big South with 7.5 sacks, which is tied for second-most in a single-season in Big South history. He missed tying the record by a half-sack.

50-50

Gardner-Webb's **DOBSON COLLINS** is the fourth player in Big South history with back-to-back 50 reception seasons. He joins former teammate **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** (three times), VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** (two) and Charleston Southern's **MAURICE PRICE** (two) with consecutive seasons with 50 catches. Collins' 76 receptions this year were a career-high.

REAL ESTATE BROKERS

Liberty teammates **RASHAD JENNINGS** and **DOMINIC BOLDEN** conclude their careers among the Big South's all-time leaders in all-purpose yards. Jennings ranks third all-time with 4,155, while Bolden's career total of 3,595 is sixth in history.

STAY BOLD

Liberty's **DOMINIC BOLDEN** departs the Big South as the League's record holder with five kick return touchdowns. He is the all-time leader with three kickoff return scores, and added two punt return touchdowns this season. In his career, Bolden returned 49 kickoffs for 1,409 yards (28.76 average) and 18 punts for 308 yards (17.1 average).

YARD MARKERS

Four games this season between Big South members saw each with a combined 1,000 yards of total offense. On Nov. 1, Stony Brook (525) and Gardner-Webb (480) combined for 1,005 total offensive yards. It was Gardner-Webb's second combined 1,000-yard game, as the Bulldogs (514) and Presbyterian (492) combined for 1,006 yards on Oct. 18. On Oct. 4, Coastal Carolina (534) and Liberty (531) combined for a Conference game record 1,065 yards. And in the season finale, VMI (648) and Presbyterian (490) combined for a Foster Stadium-record 1,138 yards.

HE'S JUST BEING MILEY

Presbyterian redshirt-freshman **BRANDON MILEY** became the second player in Big South history with two games of at least 30 completions after completing 32-of-56 passes at VMI in the season finale. Miley threw for 318 yards, his third 300-yard pass game of the season. His 56 pass attempts against the Keydets are tied for second-most in a single-game in League history.

CAMPBELL COMPLETES CAREER

Gardner-Webb QB **DEVIN CAMPBELL** concluded his collegiate football career ranked fifth in Big South history in three categories: passing yards (5,614), completions (440) and touchdown passes (39). Earlier this year, Campbell became the first player in Big South history with two 400-yard total offense games, the first with 400 total offense yards in back-to-back games, and tied the Big South record for most consecutive 300-yard passing games with three.

BIG MAC

Coastal Carolina sophomore QB **ZACH MacDOWALL** concludes his first season in Conway ranked 10th in League history with 2,064 passing yards. He unseated Liberty's **BROCK FARREL** (1,931) in Week 12. MacDowall's 16 touchdown passes are just one away from the Top 10 all-time leaders.

ACADEMIC HONORS

The Big South placed six football student-athletes on the *ESPN The Magazine/CoSIDA Academic All-District III Team*, the most All-District honorees in League history. Liberty led the way with four honorees: **DAN POPE**, **RYAN GREISER**, **COLIN DUGAN** and **KEVIN RICHARD**. Coastal Carolina's **DER-RICK FRASIER** and VMI's **JACOB ROCHESTER** were also named to the team. All six student-athletes moved onto the Academic All-America ballot.
