Brown has posted one 20-point game this season and is averaging 12.1 points per contest, while Schwagmeyere has posted two 10-rebound efforts for the Lady Bucs and is averaging 9.9 points per game and is leading her team with 6.3 rebounds per game. The duo has combined for 4-of-5 Big South Freshman of the Week honorees this season.

### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs returned to the floor after almost two weeks of now competition because of finals. They dropped their contest to the 49ers by a score of 43-91. **KELSEY WASMER** and **PAM TOLBERT** each scored in double digits for the Bucs.

#### **COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal Carolina faced a tough opponent in second-ranked North Carolina last week. The Tar Heels held the Chants to 18 first half points, and a season-low 44 points in the contest.

#### **GARDNER-WEBB**

The Bulldogs took last week off for exams. This week, head coach **RICK REEVES**' team will be looking to win again on the road as the squad plays at East Carolina and at Georgetown. The Bulldogs are playing their first of two games in successive seasons against the Pirates as ECU will make a trip to GWU next year. The Red and Black are making the return trip to Georgetown after the Hoyas came to Boiling Springs, N.C., last year. The two games mark the third and fourth consecutive games away from Paul Porter Arena. The Bulldogs head to Dayton, Ohio, for a tournament at the end of the month before returning to GWU on Jan. 1 for a match-up against Montreat.

#### **HIGH POINT**

High Point is in the middle of an 11 day break with the last game being on the ninth against Campbell. The Panthers do not play again until Dec. 20 when they host Chowan in the final game before the Christmas break.

#### LIBERTY

Liberty snapped a five-game losing streak with a 92-68 home victory over Saint Paul's on Dec. 13 ... Five players set new career highs in the scoring column for the Lady Flames, including KYLEE BEECHER (18 points), AVERY WARLEY (13), DANIKA DALE (12), KITTERY MAINE (12) and JESSICA NELSON (5) ... The Lady Flames put six players in double figures for the first time since Jan. 19, 1987 against Ferrum ... Liberty shot a season-best 55.7 percent from the field against Saint Paul's, making the Lady Flames 50-0 all-time under Carey Green when shooting 50 percent or higher.

#### PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose took last week off for exams and return to the court against Wake Forest on Dec. 15.

### **RADFORD**

Radford, which will play eight of its first 10 and 12 of its first 16 games away from home, is playing just its second home game on Friday when it hosts VCU. Eight of Radford's first 10 opponents finished the season with a .500 or better record, including four (JMU, Towson, Vanderbilt, VCU) with 22-plus victories a year ago. **JOHNETTE WALKER** is four steals from becoming the second Highlander to record 300 career thefts. She is also seven rebounds from 500 in her career

#### **UNC ASHEVILLE**

UNC Asheville went 3-2 on its five game home stand with an 84-78 victory over Johnson C. Smith on Saturday. CHIOMA OKOLI scored a team-high 19 points giving her double-figures in eight of nine game this season. She had been the Dogs leading scorer six times. KENDALL SHEPARD scored a career-high 17 points against the Bulls on 7-for-10 shooting from the floor and JESSICA MONROE notched her second double-double of the season with 16 points and 10 rebounds. Ana Baker had nine assists and LINDA AUGBURNS matched her season-high with nine points. The Bulldogs have just one game this week at Campbell before the Christmas Break.

#### WINTHROP

When ASHLEY FANN starts against Georgia Tech, she will be participating in her 100th collegiate game. She has played in 99 games with 94 starts. As long as she stays healthy, she should make her 100th career start on Jan. 10 when the Lady Eagles host Liberty. Ashley Fann is now in 6th place on Winthrop's all-time free throws made list. She has 284 in her career and is now just 11 out of 5th place. LEIGH-ANN PURSIFULL is the all-time leader at 359.
