Frazee averaged 21.5 points and 11 rebounds in two wins for the Lady Flames last week. She got her week started with 20 points on 57 percent from the floor and chipped in two from downtown and two from the line against Charleston Southern on Feb. 23. In the post, Frazee ripped down 10 boards to go along with seven assists. Five days later against UNC Asheville, Frazee put in 23 points as she connected on 6-of-13 from the floor and 11-of-12 from the charity stripe. She pulled down 12 boards in the contest and came away with four steals and two assists. For the week, Frazee shot 52 percent from the floor. The honor marks her 18th career Player of the Week plaudit and sixth nod this season.

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NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneers split their series of games this week, losing to Liberty and winning over Gardner-Webb later in the week. Saturday's game marked the Buccaneer's last home game of the season and they finished it out with a 80-68 victory over the Bulldogs after overcoming a 12-point deficit early in the game. Freshman forward **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** recorded her fifth double-double of the season against GWU with 12 points and 10 rebounds. The Lady Bucs lost their contest earlier in the week to the Flames, but forced a season high 27 turnovers by the Flames, while the Bucs capitalized making 25 points on the turnovers.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to Radford in its only contest last week, but **KATE JASINSKI** and **SYDNEI MOSS** paced the squad with 18 and 17 points, respectively. The Chants will close out their home schedule Monday, March 2 when they host Winthrop at 7 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

Bulldogs continue to struggle on the road, falling to 3-11 overall and 1-7 in conference play in road contests. However, on Monday the Bulldogs made history, coming back from 15 points down to defeat the Eagles 65-62. The comeback from behind win was the largest in the history of GWU since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01. The win was also the 15th win of the year for GWU, matching their highest win total since 2000-01.

HIGH POINT

High Point picked up a pair of wins this week. The Panthers dropped Presbyterian early in the week on the road before returning home to defeat Winthrop. With the win, High Point broke a four game losing streak to the Eagles. HPU will have the next week off before hosting Liberty next Monday in its final game of the regular season.

LIBERTY

Liberty's winning streak has reached 16 games, which is the fourth longest in program history ... The Lady Flames went 6-0 in February, improving to 91-5 in their last 96 February tilts ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** was recognized as the first ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America first-team honoree in program history. She was a second-team Academic All-American a season ago ... Frazee has scored in double figures 62 consecutive times, equaling **ELENA KISSELEVA's** program record and ranking as the second-longest active streak in NCAA Division I women's basketball ... Frazee now ranks No. 3 in program history in both points (1,747) and rebounds (882) ... One more victory would give Liberty its eighth 20-win season in the last nine years ... Liberty has only trailed for a total of 7:39 in its last 11 games.

PRESBYTERIAN

Presbyterian will hit the road to play Radford on March 2 and return home to host Charleston Southern on March 6.

RADFORD

Radford picked up a pair of victories last week, helping them complete its first two conference series sweeps of the season. The Highlanders wrap up their regular season with a pair of home games against UNC Asheville and Liberty.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville played just one game this week, falling 77-41 at Liberty. **ANA BAKER** scored 16 points on 7-for-13 shooting. She has now been in double-figures in 10 straight game and 15 of the last 16 games. Baker added three rebounds and six steals in the game. The rest of the team went 9-for-43 from the floor. Asheville finishes the regular season this week with games at Radford (Mar. 2) and at Winthrop (Mar.6).

WINTHROP

Winthrop was 0-2 on the week, but seniors **ASHLEY FANN** and **TIFFANY RODD** were good offensively. Fann averaged 20 points and 10 rebounds while Rodd averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds. Fann is currently 18 points behind **KIM SEGARS** record for points at the Division I level. **KIM SEGARS** is the all-time leader with 1,699 points, but as a freshman she played at the NAIA level and scored 182 points (7.9 ppg). So her total amount of points scored at the Division I level is 1,517 points.
