Frazee averaged 21 points and 11.5 rebounds per game to lead her Lady Flames to a 2-0 record in League play last week. She got her week started with 22 points on 8-of-16 from the floor, 3-of-6 from downtown and 3-of-3 from the charity stripe as Liberty downed UNC Asheville on Jan. 19. In the post, Frazee ripped down 14 rebounds against the Bulldogs. Five days later against Charleston Southern, the guard/forward connected on 75 percent of her shots from the floor and added two from beyond the arc to finish with 20 points. She also corralled nine boards and came up with five assists and two blocks against the Lady Bucs. For the week, Frazee shot 61 percent from the floor and 46 percent from long range. The honor marks her third Player of the Week nod this season and 15th of her career to tie her for the most plaques in Big South history with former Lady Flame and WNBA player Katie Feenstra.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 56 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She is currently ranked No. 7 in the country with 3.5 steals per game and has 323 steals in her career.

SEP-LU-RATION

Nearing the mid point in the season the Lady Flames have found themselves as the No. 1 team in the Big South. Liberty is 5-0 and is in sole possession of first place.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KELSEY WASMER** has been making it rain three pointers in most every gym she has played in this season. She is ranked No. 4 in the country with 3.1 triples per game to spark a Lady Buc offense that ranks No. 8 in the nation with 8.0 treys per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Being inside the paint is not where a team wants to be when they're playing High Point. Led by **MACKENZIE MAIER**'s League-leading 2.43 blocked shots per game, the Panthers rank No. 1 in the Big South in blocked shots with five rejections per game. Maier's blocked shot total has her currently ranked No. 26 in Division I.

GLASS MASTER

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has established herself as one of the top post players in the League this season. Fann is tops in the Big South with 9.2 boards per game and ranks No. 1 in the League with eight games of 10-or-more rebounds.

HITTING THE GROUND RUNNING

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** is not your ordinary freshman. She has stepped up to become a BIG part of the Panther offense this season. Brown has been named the Big South's Freshman of the Week four times this season and has posted three 20-point games this year. She has also posted three double-doubles on the year.

When **MORIAH FRAZEE** joined her sister **MEGAN** on the Big South 1,000 point list Liberty went down in NCAA history. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs struggled this week losing both games on the road, one conference, one non-conference. The Bucs played their last non-conference game scheduled for the 2008-09 season at Clemson, then struggled against the Lady Flames of Liberty. Sophomore **LYDIA JOHNSON** was only one point away from a double double, with 12 rebounds and 9 points. Senior **PAM TOLBERT** lead the team and was the single Buc sin double figures against Liberty with 12 points. The Bucs return to the court for one last game on the road against Radford, then return home on the 31st to play at home against Presbyterian.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina will end a four-game road trip at Liberty Monday, Jan. 26. Sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS** has been at the top of her game hitting double figures in the past five games scoring 14.2 points per contest..

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs are 7-0 this season at home and are currently riding a two game winning streak. After starting the conference slate 0-4, all four games on the road, the Bulldogs have won their last two conference games. Over the last three games, redshirt-junior **LAURA PŪVILONYTE** is averaging a double-double, 15 points and 11 rebounds, in helping guide the Bulldogs to a 2-1 record over that span.

HIGH POINT

High Point went 1-1 on the week last week, dropping a heartbreaker at Winthrop early in the week in the final minute of play. The Panthers returned home to pick up a big win over Presbyterian. HPU tallied 22 steals in the game, the most ever against a Division I opponent. **LATEISHA DEAN** recorded a career-high six in the game. The Panthers will host UNC Asheville early in the week this week before heading to Liberty on Saturday.

LIBERTY

Liberty is on an eight-game winning streak, which is tied for the 12th-longest active winning streak in the nation, through the games of Jan. 25 ... Senior **MORIAH FRAZEE** reached the 1,000-point milestone on Jan. 24 versus Charleston Southern, becoming the 12th player in program history to do so ... Head coach **CAREY GREEN** will coach his 300th career game Monday versus Coastal Carolina. A victory over his alma mater would boost his career winning percentage to exactly 75 percent ... Liberty is seeking its 30th consecutive victory over Coastal Carolina Monday.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC dropped two conference games against Radford and High Point this week...Sophomore forward **CHELSEA WRIGHT** grabbed a season-high nine rebounds against the Highlanders and totaled 17 boards through two games...Junior forward **LEA SMITH** was one rebound shy of a double-double on Saturday evening at High Point...The Blue Hose travel to Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern this week..

RADFORD

With its victory over Coastal on Saturday, Radford won consecutive games for the first time this season. The Highlanders made the most of their return to the newly refurbished Dedmon Center. In its second home opener of the season, Radford used a stifling second half defense to defeat Coastal Carolina. The Highlanders have now won 25 of their last 29 games in the Dedmon Center. In that game, sophomore **TALEIA MOTON** scored a career-high 20 points and senior **VANDY PULLEN** dished out a career-best seven assists. The defense forced 18 second half turnovers, three more than the Chanticleers averaged in a game. When Radford hosts Charleston Southern on Monday, it will be the 1,000th game in program history.

UNC ASHEVILLE

After playing seven games in 16 days, the Bulldogs played just once this week falling to Liberty. **KENDALL SHEPARD** matched her career-high with 17 points as she went 6-for-12 from the floor. Ana Baker went 5-for-10 from the floor for 11 points. The two guards were a combined 11-for-22 while the rest of the team went 7-for-31 from the floor. **IPEK DERICI** scored seven points and grabbed four rebounds in just 10 minutes of work. The loss snapped a four-game Big South winning streak which was Asheville's longest since 2007. The Bulldogs will travel to High Point on Monday before returning to face Winthrop on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Last week the Lady Eagles were involved in back-to-back one point games and went 1-1. It is the first time since the 1995-96 season that Winthrop has been involved in consecutive one point games. That year Winthrop won at Liberty, 62-61 and then won at Charleston Southern 63-62. **ASHLEY FANN** is just 142 points shy of becoming Winthrop's all-time scoring leader at the Division I level. **KIM SEGARS** is the all-time leader at 1,699 points, but played her freshman season at the NAIA level. Fann needs to average 10.9 points a game over the remainder of the season to achieve this mark.
