She connected on 65 percent of her shots from the floor and added one trey and four from the line. She also posted one assist and two steals in the contest. Frazee now ranks No. 1 in the Big South with 16 career Player of the Week plaudits, surpassing former Lady Flame and current WNBA standout Katie Feenstra.

Charleston Southern set a Big South record for three-pointers in a game on Feb. 2 as it nailed 15 treys ... On Feb. 9, the Lady Bucs reset the record as they canned 17 in a win over High Point.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneers split their games this week, winning at High Point on the 9th and losing at Coastal on the 14th. The losses did not lack results however, as the 17 three-pointers scored at High Point tied a High Point record of the most threes allowed by a Division-I opponent against the Panthers. Those 17 also pushed the Lady Bucs past High Point in the Big South record book for the most threes attempted in a season. The Lady Buccaneers, including their game against Coastal have now attempted 622 from beyond the arc this season. The Lady Bucs broke their second conference record on Saturday against Coastal, again breaking the record in a game against the team that held the former record. The Lady Bucs made a total of 10 from beyond the arc at Coastal, to surpass Coastal's standing conference record in three-pointer made in a single season. The Lady Bucs have scored 209 tres so far this season. Sophomore guard **KATIE TULL** recorded a total of 6 three-pointers at Coastal to send the Lady Bucs into the record books. Freshman forward **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** recorded a double-double at Coastal as well.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina got two victories last week behind great performances by junior **AMANDA STULL** and sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS**. Stull averaged 17.5 points in two games, while Moss was close behind adding 17 points per contest.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs had their nine game home winning streak snapped on Monday night in the 58-51 loss to Liberty. However, GWU bounced back to defeat High Point 63-60 on Saturday afternoon to move to 10-1 at home. The 10 home wins are the most the Bulldogs have had in one season at home since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01. Red-shirt junior **LAURA POVILONYTE** scored a season-high 23 points, while sophomore guard **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** dished out a career high 11 assists in the win over High Point. Junior **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** is only one rebound shy of grabbing number 500 for her career.

HIGH POINT

High Point is looking to bounce back after falling to both Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb this past week. In the GWU game the Panthers were down 22 points at halftime, but staged a huge second half rally that fell just short. Against CSU guard **FRANCES FIELDS** notched 10 assists for her second highest output of the season and her second double assist performance in as many games.

LIBERTY

Liberty ranks No. 3 nationally in rebounding margin (+11.6) ... The Lady Flames have ranked among the NCAA's top five teams in rebounding margin for five consecutive seasons ... On Feb. 9, Liberty became the first visiting team to win at Paul Porter Arena this season, dealing Gardner-Webb a 58-51 setback ... Last season, the Lady Flames were the only visiting team to win at North Carolina A&T ... Liberty's next victory will be No. 500 in program history ... The Lady Flames' all-time record stands at 499-403, entering this week's games ... Over her last two games, **MEGAN FRAZEE** is averaging 26.0 ppg, 10.0 rpg and shooting 71.9 percent from the field (23 of 32) ... On Saturday, Liberty will aim for its 31st consecutive win against Coastal Carolina.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC snapped a 15-game skid with a decisive 77-42 victory over Allen University ... The 35-point win is the largest victory for the Blue Hose in the Division I era ... Junior forward **LEA SMITH** scored a career-high 23 points and 11 rebounds while sophomore guards **AMANDA MILLS** and **KATLIN MOORE** also registered double-digit points ... Smith contributed 20 points the following game as the Blue Hose came up short, 67-58, against UNC Asheville ... Mills added 15 points, including 12 from beyond the arc.

RADFORD

Junior **KYMESHA ALSTON** has been a force on the boards in Big South play. She is averaging 9.6 rebounds per game which includes a career-best 14 at High Point, followed by a 12-rebound effort at Winthrop. She has also pulled down 12 against Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. Radford has won the turnover battle in seven of its last eight games (+5.3). The Highlanders forced 20-plus turnovers in five of those games. During this eight game span, Radford has recorded 11.1 steals per game, including a season-high 15 against Coastal Carolina and Winthrop.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville went 1-1 this week, falling to Coastal Carolina and defeating Presbyterian. **ANA BAKER** led the Bulldogs with 20 points against Coastal and 11 points at PC. She averaged 15.5 points, 4.5 assists, and three steals per game for the week. **KENDALL SHEPARD** scored 13 points at PC as she averaged 10 points per game for the week. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** went 7-for-10 from the floor for 14 points in the win at PC. The Asheville bench had a solid week outscoring the opponents bench 46-21 in the two games. The Bulldogs will travel to Gardner-Webb on Monday before hosting its final home game of the season against High Point on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Winthrop captured its fifth straight win after defeating Radford on the road Saturday. In the process the Lady Eagles have shot 50 percent or better from the field in the last four games. The previous 19, Winthrop did not shoot 50 percent or better at all. Winthrop started 1-3 in the league, but since the return of **TIFFANY RODD**, has won four straight league games and is now in third place. Since her return offense is up 18.1 points and defense allowing 3.6 less. Head coach **BUD CHILDERS** is in his fifth season with the Lady Eagles and is closing in on becoming the school's all-time leader in wins. He currently has 54 victories and is now just six away from becoming the all-time leader. **ROBIN MULLER** holds the record for wins at the Division I level by a Lady Eagle coach. Rodd has made 16 threes in her last four games to close in on becoming the Big South Conference all-time leader. She now trails **NIKKI REDDICK** by just two. She has 237 made in her career. She has averaged 15.8 points in the last four games and shooting 50 percent from the floor.
