Hammond averaged 16.5 points per game and shot 58 percent from the field and 78 percent from downtown to lead her Lady Flames to a 2-0 record in Big South play. Hammond got her week started with eight points on 60 percent from the floor and 2-of-2 from downtown to go along with three boards, two steals and one assist against Coastal Carolina on Jan. 26. On Jan. 31 against High Point, the guard put in 25 points as she connected on 57 percent of her shots from the floor and drained 71 percent from downtown. She also put in all four free-throw attempts and came away with seven boards and one assist. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod of her career.

Schwagmeyer averaged 19 points and shot 74 percent in two games for the Lady Bucs last week. Against Radford on Jan. 26, she nailed 69 percent of her shots from the floor and added a trey and a free throw to finish with 20 points. She also ripped down nine rebounds and came up with three steals and one assist. Five days later in Charleston Southern's win over Presbyterian, Schwagmeyer poured in 18 points as she nailed 80 percent from the floor and canned two treys. In the post, she pulled down five boards and dished out three helpers. The honor marks her third Freshman of the Week plaudit this season.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 60 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She is currently ranked No. 9 in the country with 3.3 steals per game and has 327 steals in her career.

SEP-LU-RATION

At the mid point in the Conference season the Lady Flames have found themselves as the No. 1 team in the Big South. Liberty is 7-0 and is in sole possession of first place.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KELSEY WASMER** has been making it rain three pointers in most every gym she has played in this season. She is ranked No. 5 in the country with 3.0 triples per game to spark a Lady Buc offense that ranks No. 6 in the nation with 8.2 treys per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Being inside the paint is not where a team wants to be when they're playing High Point. Led by **MACKENZIE MAIER**'s League-leading 2.52 blocked shots per game, the Panthers rank No. 1 in the Big South and 21st in the country in blocked shots with 5.14 rejections per game. Maier's blocked shot total has her currently ranked No. 22 in Division I.

GLASS MASTER

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has established herself as one of the top post players in the League this season. Fann is tops in the Big South with 9.2 boards per game and ranks No. 1 in the League with nine games of 10-or-more rebounds.

TWO OF A KIND

When **MORIAH FRAZEE** joined her sister **MEGAN** on the Big South 1,000 point list Liberty went down in NCAA history. Liberty is the only school in the nation to produce multiple sisters with 1,000 career points. Liberty's first sister pair to record 1,000 points were **SHARON** and **SARAH WILKERSON**.

THE SCOOP ON MEGAN

MEGAN FRAZEE picked up her third Big South Player of the Week plaudit this season on Jan. 26. The honor marked her 15th Player of the Week accolade of her career and moved in into a tie for the most Player of the Week nods in a career. She is now tied for No. 1 all-time with former Liberty Lady Flame and WNBA player **KATIE FEENSTRA**.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs struggled in their game against Radford where they held the lead and were up by as much as 14 points in the first but ended up with a loss after Radford took control in the second half. Despite the loss, the Lady Bucs saw three players in double figures. The Lady Bucs were able to snap their four game skid against Presbyterian College on Saturday with a 61-48 win. Freshman **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** pulled in double digit scoring in both games, while only being one rebound away from a double-double in the contest against Radford.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina had its best shooting performance of the season at 62.7 percent from behind the arc, hitting a season-high 10 triples to fly past Gardner-Webb 70-64 Saturday, Jan. 31 at Kimbel Arena. Junior **AMANDA STULL** was two rebounds shy of her first career triple-double as the Rushville native registered game highs of 15 points and 10 assists, while adding eight rebounds to her stat line. Sophomore **KATE JASINSKI** was 4-for-4 from three-point range and picked up 14 points in the win. Coastal Carolina will conclude the first half of conference play when it hosts Presbyterian Feb. 2 at 7 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs had their four-game winning streak snapped on Saturday afternoon with the loss at Coastal Carolina. Coach Reeves' squad defeated Presbyterian on Monday night at home, a win that put them at 8-0 at home this season. GWU wrapped up their non-conference schedule on Wednesday night, defeating Appalachian State 77-62 on the road in Boone, N.C. Gardner-Webb finished the year with an 8-5 non-conference record. On Saturday, the Bulldogs fell on the road at Coastal Carolina in the two program's first ever meeting.

HIGH POINT

High Point split on the week, falling to Liberty on Saturday after beating UNC Asheville earlier in the week. Sophomore **MACKENZIE MAIER** made a mark in the HPU record books this past week. Against UNCA she set the single-game block record with seven. In the Liberty game Maier tallied two blocks which gave her 53 this season and ties her for the single season record. The Panthers have a few days off this week before facing Coastal Carolina at home on Saturday.

LIBERTY

Liberty has won 10 games in a row, which is the 10th-longest winning streak in program history ... The Lady Flames went 8-0 in January, wrapping up their second straight perfect month of January ... Liberty has also won 37 straight home games during January, dating back to the 1999-2000 season ... Senior **RACHEL HAMMOND** set new career highs for points (25) and three-pointers (5) during Saturday's win over High Point. She became the first Lady Flame not named **FRAZEE** to reach the 20-point plateau since **KATIE FEENSTRA** in the 2005 NCAA Tournament. Hammond was also the first Liberty player to make five triples in a game since **DAINA STAUGAI-TIENE** in 2001. However, Hammond saw her streak of nine consecutive made three-pointers snapped on Saturday.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC scored 48 points in consecutive losses to Big South opponents last week ... Junior forward **LEA SMITH** recorded her first double-double of the season against Charleston Southern (17 points, 10 rebounds) ... Sophomore guard averaged 14.5 points per game last week and went a career-best 9-of-11 from the free throw line on Saturday evening ... Freshman **KRISTEN STEVENS** had a career-high six assists against the Lady Bucs ... The Blue Hose wrap up the first half of the Big South schedule on Monday at Coastal Carolina and finish their five-game road trip on Saturday at Winthrop.

RADFORD

Playing its 1,000th game in program history, Radford defeated Charleston Southern, 76-67 on Jan. 26. In its 38th season of basketball, the Highlanders have recorded a 582-418 record. **TALEIA MOTON** has registered double figures in her last 11 games, averaging 16.1 points during that stretch. She has also been in double figures, in 15 of 17 games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs dropped a pair of close game at High Point and then at home to Winthrop. Poor shooting was Asheville's biggest concern. The Bulldogs shot 31 percent from the floor, 15 percent from three-point range, and 52 percent from the free throw line in the two games. **ANA BAKER** had a great week despite the team's performance. Baker had 12 points, six assists, and five steals at High Point and then dropped in 19 points, seven rebounds, four assists, and five steals against Winthrop. For the week, she was 15-for-32 from the floor averaged 15 points, six rebounds, five assists, and five steals per game. She now has 243 career steals and is just one shy of the UNC Asheville career record. **LINDA AUGHBURNS** also had a good week posting her first career double-double with 10 points and 15 rebounds against High Point. She had seven points and eight rebounds against Winthrop. The two combined for almost half the Asheville offense for the week.

WINTHROP

ASHLEY FANN recorded 19 points and 17 rebounds in the victory over UNC Asheville. It was her sixth double-double of the season and the second time this month she posted at least 17 rebounds and 19 points in a single game. She now has 799 career rebounds and has moved into third on Winthrop's all-time list. She is now 39 behind second place all time held by **STEPHANIE MORRIS** and 46 behind the all-time leader, **TAMMY JONES**. She has to average 4.0 rebounds the rest of the season to move into second and 4.7 rebounds to become the school's all-time leader. Fann has 1,398 career points now and has to average 15.3 points a game the rest of the way to move into second all-time on the scoring list. With two blocks on Saturday against UNC Asheville, **ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT** has moved into a tie for fourth on the school's all-time blocks list with 74. **YVONNE VAN DAALEN** has moved into third place on the school's all-time assists list with 376 total in her career. She is now just seven away from moving into second on the list. It won't be possible for her to reach the all-time leader, **SHEILA BAILEY** at 595 total. Fann came off the bench against UNC Asheville to score 19 points and 17 rebounds. It was the first time since her freshman season that she did not start a game, ending her streak at 87 straight starts. If she had started the game, she would have become Winthrop's all-time leader in games started. Fann along with **NANCY ARCHER** and **BECKI BARBARY** are currently tied for first with 105.
