Hargraves averaged 15.5 points per game and shot 44 percent from the field to lead her team to a 2-0 record last week, including a win over League foe Gardner-Webb. Against the Runnin' Bulldogs on Jan. 12, Hargraves was on fire as she connected on 7-of-14 from the field and canned 5-of-5 from downtown to finish with 22 points. She also added three from the line and came away with four boards, two assists and one steal in the win. Three days later against Elon, the guard put in nine points, dished out seven assists and ripped down six rebounds. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod of the season and the first plaudit of her career.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 50 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She currently has 317 steals in her career.

HOME COOK'N

Gardner-Webb is the only team in the Big South that is undefeated at home this season. The Runnin' Bulldogs are currently 6-0 in their home barn. The Bulldogs also picked up a historical win in Paul Porter Arena last week as they won their first-ever Big South Conference game with a 60-50 win over Charleston Southern.

DOUBLE'N UP

KELSEY WASMER is also the only individual in the Big South that is ranked nationally in two categories. She is ranked 15th in the country with 2.8 three-pointers per game, while her 42.9 clip from beyond the arc is ranked 24th in the Division I.

GLASS MASTER

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has established herself as one of the top post players in the League this season. Fann is tops in the Big South with 9.0 boards per game and ranks No. 1 in the League with seven games of 10-or-more rebounds.

HITTING THE GROUND RUNNING

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** is not your ordinary freshman. She has stepped up to become a BIG part of the Panther offense this season. Brown has been named the Big South's Freshman of the Week four times this season and has posted three 20-point games this year. She also ranks tied for second in the Big South with three double-doubles on the year.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs split their games this last week beating Savannah State 74-43, but losing their Conference contest to Gardner-Webb by 10. Freshman point guard **KIKI RUTLEDGE** pulled in her first career double-double against Savannah State with 12 points and 11 rebounds. The Bucs travel to Clemson to face non-conference Tigers on Tuesday and then to Liberty on Saturday.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina got back into the win column with a 51-34 win over Winthrop. The Chanticleers rallied behind 29 bench points from redshirt freshman **COURTNEY GRAMBLEY** (14 points) and sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS** (13 points). Coastal Carolina will make its way to Virginia this weekend for a two-game road trip starting with Radford Jan. 24 at 3 p.m.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs picked up their first ever Big South Conference win on Saturday, defeating Charleston Southern 60-50 in Paul Porter Arena. Red-shirt junior **LAURA POVILONYTE** had her second consecutive double-double in the win, pulling down 14 boards to go along with her 11 points. In the loss to High Point on Monday night, Povilonyte had 15 points and a career high 15 rebounds. The Bulldogs are undefeated at home this season, going 6-0 thus far. The win on Saturday snapped the Bulldogs four-game losing streak.

HIGH POINT

High Point extended its win streak to five games this week after defeating Big South newcomer Gardner-Webb on Monday before stepping out of League play to defeat its oldest rival, Elon on Thursday. Sophomore **JURICA HARGRAVES** had a perfect night from outside the arc, shooting 5-of-5. The Panthers went 7-of-10 from outside en route to their best Division I outside shooting percentage, 70-percent (min. 10 att.). High Point set another record later in the week with 26 assists against Elon, the most tallied against a Division I program. Freshman **SHAMIA BROWN** posted 20 points in the first half against the Phoenix, going a perfect 10-of-10 in the opening period. She finished with a career high tying 22 points on 11-of-12. This week HPU will travel to Rock Hill to face Winthrop on Monday and will return to the Millis Center on Saturday to face Big South newcomer Presbyterian.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames defeated East Tennessee State and Presbyterian last week, pushing their season-long winning streak to six games ... **AMBER MAYS** had eight steals versus East Tennessee State on Jan. 13, which was the most by a Lady Flame since **SHARON WILKERSON** had eight thefts on Feb. 21, 2000 ... **MORIAH FRAZEE** enters the week just eight points shy of becoming the 12th 1,000-point scorer in program history ... After Liberty's Monday evening game at UNC Asheville, the Lady Flames will have played 11 of their 16 games away from the Vines Center ... Liberty has held 67 straight opponents to below 50 percent field goal shooting, a streak which began on Dec. 30, 2006.

PRESBYTERIAN

Junior forward **LEA SMITH** tied her season-high of 15 points against UNC Asheville, leading the Blue Hose for the second straight game ... Smith also tied a team-high eight rebounds against the Bulldogs ... Sophomore guard **AMANDA MILLS** scored 16 second-half points to keep PC in the game against Liberty, after the Blue Hose entered the second half down only one point ... Mills finished with 21 points on the evening, including four three-pointers and going 7-of-7 from the free throw line...Sophomore Katlin Moore added 16 points against the Lady Flames.

RADFORD

Radford concludes a four-game conference road swing at Presbyterian Monday night. It will be the 12th road game in RU's first 16 contests of the season. A different Highlander has recorded a double-double in each of the last three games. **VANDY PULLEN** recorded her first and the team's first at High Point with 14 points and 11 rebounds. Last week, **KYMESHA ALSTON** netted 13 points and pulled down a game-high 12 boards at Winthrop for her first in a Highlander uniform and second in her career. Sophomore **DENAY WOOD** picked up the third one, also the first of her career. She tallied a career-highs with 12 points and a game-high 13 rebounds at UNC Asheville. Sophomore **TALEIA MOTON** has scored in double figures (14.8 ppg) in Radford's last eight games an 13 of 15 this season. Radford's victory at Winthrop was the first on the road this season. Senior **JOHNETTE WALKER** tied **PEBBLES MAYNARD** (1981-85) for second on RU's all-time assists list with 467.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville was won three straight games for the first time this season and has won four straight in Conference for the first time in two seasons. The last time Asheville won four straight Conference games was at the end of its championship season of 2007, when the Bulldogs won the final three games of the regular season and then won all three tournament games. **ANA BAKER** has enjoyed playing on Jan. 17, in her career. In 2007, she hit a buzzer-beating three pointer at High Point to give the Dogs a one-point win. On Saturday, she hit the game-winner against Radford with three seconds left to give the Dogs a two-point win. Those are the only two game -winning baskets of her career. Baker has hit six first half ending baskets in her career. Baker is now the Bulldogs team leader in scoring, assists, steals, and minutes played. The Bulldogs have turned up the defense in Big South play. Asheville is allowing 55.8 points per game to Big South opponents. After giving up 70.9 points per game to non-conference opponents.

WINTHROP

Just last season Winthrop posted one of its best home records in school history at 10-4. With four of the first five Big South games at home the Lady Eagles had a chance to get off to a good start in league play. However, this year the team is 4-5 at home and has opened up with a 1-3 Big South record. On Saturday Winthrop scored just 34 points, the second lowest ever by a Winthrop team in a Big South game at home. The previous low is 33 against UNC Asheville in 2005. Despite playing with an injured shoulder, senior **ASHLEY FANN** pulled down 13 rebounds against Coastal Carolina on Saturday. Fann now has 760 career rebounds and is now 21 shy of moving into fourth on the school's all-time list. She is currently 17th on the Big South all-time list. On the week she averaged 9.5 points and 11.5 rebounds a game. Friendly Confines of the Winthrop Coliseum? I don't think so. Nobody can ever accuse the Lady Eagles of home cooking this season. In addition to having just a 4-5 record at home, Winthrop has attempted just 129 free throws compared to 210 by its opponents at home this season. Last year Winthrop shot 561 free throws on the season. This year they have attempted 201 in 15 games and with at least 13 games remaining, Winthrop will fall way short of that mark. In Saturday's loss, Winthrop attempted zero free throws. It is the first time during **BUD CHILDERS** time as head coach of Winthrop that the team hasn't attempted at least 2 free throws in a game.
