Fann averaged 22 points and shot 59 percent to lead Winthrop to a 3-0 record in League play in the final week of the regular-season. She got her week started with 22 points and nine rebounds as Winthrop downed Coastal Carolina on March 2. Four days later against UNC Asheville, Fann posted a 27-point, 10-rebound double-double to lead Winthrop to the 72-58 win. Fann connected on 12-of-16 shots for a 75 percent clip against the Bulldogs. She closed out her week with 17 points and nine rebounds as Winthrop downed Charleston Southern and locked up the No. 4 seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. Fann averaged 9.3 rebounds per game and dished out seven assists en route to garnering her first Player of the Week selection this season.

REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPS

With its win on Feb. 23, Liberty clinched the Big South Regular-Season Championship and the No. 1 seed in the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. The title marks Liberty's 11th Regular-Season crown in 12 years.

SEEDS ANNOUNCED

High Point locked up the No. 2 seed as it closed out its League slate with a 10-6 record. Radford and Winthrop posted identical 9-7 records in League play. The Highlanders hold the tie-breaker over the Lady Eagles and pick up the No. 3 seed, leaving Winthrop the No. 4 seed. Coastal Carolina picked up the No. 5 slot with a Big South record of 8-8. Gardner-Webb and UNC Asheville each posted 7-9 records with the Runnin' Bulldogs holding the tie breaker and grabbing the No. 6 position. Charleston Southern rounds out the seeding in the No. 8 slot with its 6-10 record in League play. Presbyterian who is eligible for the regular-season title but not the tournament finished 1-15 in the League.

MAKING THE GRADE

ESPN The Magazine recently announced its Academic All-America teams. **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the lone representative as she was named a first-team Academic All-American ... In the All-District category, the Big South put four players on the First and Second Teams. Liberty's Megan Frazee joined **AMANDA STULL** of Coastal Carolina on the First Team, while **MORIAH FRAZEE** of Liberty and teammate **RACHEL HAMMOND** each earned a bid to the Second Team.

AT LEAST ONE

High Point has done something that no other team in the League has been able to accomplish against the Liberty Lady Flames ... In four the past five seasons, High Point has beat Liberty at least once during the regular-season. This season the win came on the last game of the regular-season for both the Lady Flames and the Panthers. The HPU win clinched the No. 2 seed for the Panthers.

BETTER GRAB AN UMBRELLA

Charleston Southern has been living by the trey all season long ... In the process the Lady Bucs have destroyed the Big South single season three point record of 209 as they have connected on 250 triples this season... In the process Charleston Southern has found themselves ranked No. 3 in the country with 8.7 three-pointers per game.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 80 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She is currently ranked No. 15 in the country with 3.0 steals per game and has 347 steals in her career.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs won their second game in a row taking a last second victory over PC on Saturday evening. The game was a back and forth battle at several points, but sophomore guard Katie Tull hit a three point shot with one second left on the clock to take the three point victory. The Bucs return to the hardwood for a game against Winthrop on Monday evening, their last regular season game for 2008-09.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its final two game of the regular season to finish out the year 16-13 overall and 8-8 in the Big South earning the fifth seed in the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship. Sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS** hit double figures in the scoring column in 15 of the 16 league games this year and averaged 18.3 points in the final three games of the regular season.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs, who have suffered from the injury bug all season, are picking the worst time to have not one, not two, but three key injuries as they head into their first Big South Championship tournament this week. The Bulldogs only dressed eight healthy players in their last contest, a 60-57 loss to Coastal Carolina, as two starters were sidelined due to injuries. The Bulldogs 11-2 home record was the best since the Bulldogs moved to NCAA Division I in 2000-01.

HIGH POINT

High Point wrapped up the regular season with a, 58-53 win over Big South rival Liberty becoming the only League team this season to defeat the Lady Flames. This week HPU will host the Big South Conference Women's Basketball Tournament. The Panthers have secured the No. 2 seed and will face No. 7 seeded UNC Asheville in the opening round on Friday, March 13 at 7:30 p.m.

LIBERTY

Liberty became the first Big South women's basketball team ever to win 15 conference games in a single season and won its 11th conference regular-season title in the past 12 seasons ... Liberty had an 18-game winning streak snapped by High Point in Monday night's regular-season finale ... The Lady Flames held 17 straight opponents below the 60-point plateau, before Radford tallied 61 points versus Liberty on March 6 ... Liberty is the No. 1 team in the nation for rebounding margin in the most recent NCAA statistical report ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** set a school record by scoring in double figures for the 63rd straight game, March 2 versus Presbyterian. Her current 65-game streak is the longest active streak in NCAA Division I women's basketball ... **AVERY WARLEY** has made 37 of her last 43 field goal attempts (86.0 percent).

PRESBYTERIAN

Sophomore guard Katlin Moore scored a career-high 22 points in PC's narrow loss to Charleston Southern (50-47) on Saturday...Sophomore Chelsea Wright and junior Lea Smith each pulled down 10 rebounds on Saturday, finishing with 17 and 12 on the week, respectively...PC's three-point loss to the Lady Bucs is the narrowest loss the Blue Hose have had to a Big South opponent this season... PC dropped a 71-33 decision to Liberty earlier in the week.

RADFORD

Radford finished the season splitting a pair of home games on the last week of regular season play. In Radford's game vs. Liberty, **JOHNETTE WALKER** scored 12 points and moved into fifth on the all-time Highlander scoring list with 1,227 points. She is two assists shy of 500, sitting in second all alone with 498. She also moved up to 16th on the rebounding list with 562. When Walker steps to the court in the first round of the Big South Tournament it will be her 122nd game playing tying **KELLI DARDEN** and **CORRIE FERTITTA** for most all time in a Highlander uniform.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville concluded the regular season with a 10-19 record and 7-9 mark in conference play. **JESSICA MONROE** had a strong final week averaging 12 points and seven rebounds per game. She shot 40 percent from the floor and 80 percent from the foul line in the final two regular season games. **KENDALL SHEPARD** set a career-high and tied a school record in the regular season finale at Winthrop. Shepard scored 18 points on 6-for-9 shooting from three-point range. She is the fourth Bulldog player to hit six three-pointers in a game. **ASHTON BARTON**, **BRITTANY HENDLEY**, and **ASHLEY WOODS** are the other three. **LINDA AUGHBURNS** also had a strong finish to her freshman season. She scored nine points and grabbed seven rebounds in the final week. The Bulldogs will now focus on the upcoming Advance Auto-Parts Big South Championships this weekend..

WINTHROP

Last week **ASHLEY FANN** became Winthrop's all-time leading scorer at the Division I level. She pass Kim Segars with a 22 point performance at Coastal Carolina. Kim Segars is the all-time leader with 1,699 points, but as a freshman she played at the NAIA level and scored 182 points (7.9 ppg). So her total amount of points scored at the Division I level is 1,517 points. Fann now has 1,549 career points. With the victory over UNC Asheville on Friday, Winthrop captured its 8th league win. That sets a new school record for wins in the Big South Conference. The previous record was seven, set in several seasons. With a win over Charleston Southern, the Lady Eagles can captured their second straight winning season in the conference for the first time in school history.
