CHAMPS

The Lady Flames won the program's 12th Big South title in the last 13 years to earn the Big South's automatic bid to the 2009 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament.

TWO IN THE POST SEASON

Winthrop earned a bid to the WNIT to mark the third-straight year the Big South has put two teams into the post season.

SOLID GOLD RECORD

With its win over Gardner-Webb in the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Championship finals, Liberty improved its record to 27-3 in finals games.

TALL ORDER

With Megan Frazee, Moriah Frazee and Avery Warley on the court for the Lady Flames, Liberty has three players who stand at least 6'3". The height has allowed Liberty to control the post as it ranks No. 1 in the nation with a 13.3 rebound margin.

MAKING THE GRADE

ESPN The Magazine recently announced its Academic All-America teams. **MEGAN FRAZEE** was the lone representative as she was named a first-team Academic All-American ... In the All-District category, the Big South put four players on the First and Second Teams. Liberty's Megan Frazee joined **AMANDA STULL** of Coastal Carolina on the First Team, while **MORIAH FRAZEE** of Liberty and teammate **RACHEL HAMMOND** each earned a bid to the Second Team.

AT LEAST ONE

High Point has done something that no other team in the League has been able to accomplish against the Liberty Lady Flames ... In four the past five seasons, High Point has beat Liberty at least once during the regular-season. This season the win came on the last game of the regular-season for both the Lady Flames and the Panthers. The HPU win clinched the No. 2 seed for the Panthers.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 81 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She is currently ranked No. 17 in the country with 2.9 steals per game and has 348 steals in her career.

TWO OF A KIND

When **MORIAH FRAZEE** joined her sister **MEGAN** on the Big South 1,000 point list Liberty went down in NCAA history. Liberty is the only school in the nation to produce multiple sisters with 1,000 career points. Liberty's first sister pair to record 1,000 points were **SHARON** and **SARAH WILKERSON**.

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NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs ended their season 12-18 and 6-10 in the Big South, the best season so far at CSU for head coach **JULIE GOODENOUGH** who has completed her third season at the helm of the program. The coaching staff was very pleased with the Lady Bucs' performances at the Conference tournament as they outscored Liberty in the second half of their first round game. The Bucs saw four of their own named to All-Conference Teams this season with two on the All-Freshman team- **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** and **KIKI RUTLEDGE**. Junior **TINA DECARVALHO** was named to the All-Academic team for the second year in a row, and senior **PAM TOLBERT** earned second team All-Conference honors. The Bucs lose only one senior, and large sophomore and freshman classes bring hopes that the next few years will yield even greater results as they mature in their game.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina wrapped up the 2008-09 season falling 67-48 to Winthrop in the quarterfinal of the 2009 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship. Sophomore **KATE JASINSKI** scored a game-high 22 points and finished second in scoring (10.2 ppg) on the team. Sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS** led the team in scoring averaging 12.1 points per game this season. Moss also led the team in rebounding with 7.0 boards per contest. The Chanticleers finish the season 16-14 overall.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Gardner-Webb women's basketball season saw their season come to an end on a missed last second shot in the Big South Conference Tournament Championship game, falling to the No. 1 seed Liberty Flames 51-50. The Bulldogs made it to the Championship game in their first season as members of the League. Gardner-Webb finished the season 17-15 overall and 7-9 in the conference. The 17 wins is the most wins in one season that the women's basketball program has had since moving to the NCAA Division I in 2000-01. Gardner-Webb won 11 home games, the most home wins in one season since moving to the NCAA Division I and posted a nine-game home winning streak the longest in the program's history. In the Bulldogs first home game of the season, GWU recorded the program's largest margin of victory in the 48-point win over UVA-Wise and broke three school records in the process. GWU won its first ever Big South Conference game on January 17, defeating Charleston Southern 60-50 at home. The Bulldogs also posted its first ever wins over Charleston Southern (Jan. 17) and Presbyterian (Jan. 26). Gardner-Webb posted an 8-5 non-conference record, the first time that it has posted a winning non-conference record since moving to NCAA Division I. The eight non-conference wins were the most non-conference wins in Division I history. GWU's road win over Winthrop on February 23, was the largest come from behind victory in its history, as the Bulldogs erased a 15 point second half deficit to win 65-62. Head Coach **RICK REEVES** recorded his 70th career Big South Conference win with the win over UNC Asheville on February 16, and currently sits with 71 conference victories. Junior **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** surpassed the 500 rebound plateau in the same game, a win over UNC Asheville, becoming only the fourth player to surpass 500 rebounds in GWU's Division I history.

HIGH POINT

High Point ends the 2009 season in the semifinal round of the Big South Conference Championship after finishing the regular season #2 in the conference. HPU's **MACKENZIE MAIER** set a single game tournament record with seven blocks against UNCA. The Panthers set several records this season including the team single season block record (165), single game assist record (27), team season field goals made (762), single game field goals (49). Maier set the single game school record for blocks (7) and single season block record (84).

LIBERTY

Liberty won its 12th Big South Championship in the last 13 seasons with a 51-50 win over Gardner-Webb in Sunday's championship game ... The Lady Flames' last three championship game victories have come by a combined five points ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** was voted Tournament MVP for the second consecutive year, becoming only the fourth player in Big South history to do so ... **MORIAH FRAZEE** joined her on the All-Tournament Team, meaning all three Frazee triplets have made the Big South All-Tournament Team during their career ... Liberty is now 52-12 over the past two seasons, setting a new record for most victories in back-to-back campaigns in program history ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** recorded her 50th career double-double during Saturday's semifinal triumph over Winthrop, breaking **KATIE FEENSTRA**'s school record of 49 ... The nation's No. 1 team for rebounding margin, Liberty outrebounded its three Big South Championship opponents by an average of 23 rebounds per contest ... At Thursday's Big South Awards Banquet, Liberty swept the Player of the Year, Scholar-Athlete of the Year and Coach of the Year awards for the second straight season ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** won the first two honors, while **CAREY GREEN** was named Coach of the Year for the conference-record fifth time ... The Lady Flames will make their 12th NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Championship appearance, and will learn their seed, first-round opponent and destination Monday evening at 7 p.m.

PRESBYTERIAN

Sophomore guard **KATLIN MOORE** scored a career-high 22 points in PC's narrow loss to Charleston Southern (50-47) to close out the season ... Sophomore **CHELSEA WRIGHT** and junior **LEA SMITH** each pulled down 10 rebounds on vs. CSU, finishing with 17 and 12 on the week, respectively ... PC's three-point loss to the Lady Bucs is the narrowest loss the Blue Hose have had to a Big South opponent this season.

RADFORD

Under first year head coach Tajama Ngongba, Radford women's basketball finished off the regular season with a third place finish in the Big South. The rookie head coach picked up her first career victory on Dec. 5 against Southern Virginia. After getting through a very non-conference schedule which saw the Highlanders play their first six games of the season and eight of 11 away from home, the team won their Big South opener against Gardner-Webb on Jan. 5 and went on to finish 9-7 in league play. Radford played its 1,000th game in school history, defeating Charleston Southern 76-67 on Jan. 26. Just two days earlier, a 65-56 victory over Coastal Carolina gave the Highlanders their 200th Big South regular season win ... The season was individually highlighted by career-high games by **TALEIA MOTON** (28 points), Johnette Walker (22 points twice), **KYMESHA ALSTON** (23 points, 14 rebounds), **RACHEL MORRIS** (13 points in first collegiate start), **VANDY PULLEN** (12 rebounds), **DENAY WOOD** (12 points, 13 rebounds in same game), **DAVIDA DODSON** (nine points, six rebounds), **CIARA HAYES** (10 points, seven rebounds) and **KAYLYN CROSIER** (seven rebounds). Moton, who netted her 800th collegiate point in the league tournament against Gardner-Webb, will enter the 2009-10 season 195 points shy of 1,000 ... Senior **JOHNETTE WALKER** is leaving Radford marking up the record books. Playing a school record 122 games (tied with Corrie Fertitta and Kelli Darden), she broke the all time free throws made record with 451 and attempted with 589. The Big South's all-time steals leader (348) leaves RU second in thefts and assists (498), fifth in scoring (1,238) and free throw percentage (.766), tied for seventh in three-pointers made (99) and 16th in rebounding (563).

UNC ASHEVILLE

For the second year in a row, UNC Asheville gave the No.2 seed a scare before falling to High Point 72-67 in the quarterfinals of the Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Tournament. The Bulldogs end the season with a 10-20 overall record. Senior **ANA BAKER** led the team averaging 12.9 points, 4.4 assists, and 2.6 steals per game. She scored 14 points in her final game to finish her career with 856 career points. She leaves Asheville, as the school's all-time leader with 267 career steals and the division I leader with 407 career assists. Freshman **LINDA AUGHBURNS** scored a career-high 18 points against High Point. She finished the season as the team leader in rebounding at 6.4 boards per game. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** also had a solid game against Panthers with her fifth double-double of the season. She scored 11 points, and pulled down 10 rebounds. She finishes the year as the second leading scorer at 7.6 points and the second leading rebounder at 6.0 rebounds per game.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles will be going to the postseason for the first time as a member of the NCAA Division I. Winthrop will represent the Big South by playing in the WNIT. Head coach **BUD CHILDERS** has won 36 games the past two seasons, which equals the best mark ever for most wins back-to-back seasons at Winthrop. The only other time was the 1972-73 and 1973-74 season under the direction of Winthrop Hall of Famer Mary Roland Griffin.
