Rodd shot 48 percent from the field, 50 percent from downtown and averaged 16 points per game to lead her Lady Eagles to two Big South wins last week. She got her week started with 20 points on 54 percent from the floor, 4-of-8 from long range and two from the line in Winthrop's win over Charleston Southern on Feb. 2. Against Presbyterian on Feb. 7, the guard put in 12 points as she connected on 40 percent of her field goal attempts and 50 percent of her tries from beyond the arc. She also chipped in three boards, two assists and two take-aways in the win. The honor marks her first Player of the Week nod this season.

In High Point's win over Coastal Carolina on Feb. 7, the Panthers accomplished something that no team in the League has done this season. High Point had three players notch double doubles. **SHAMIA BROWN** put in 10 points and came down with 12 boards, while teammate **LATEISAH DEAN** notched 11 points and 12 rebounds. Floor general **FRANCES FIELDS** dished out a Big South season-high 12 assists and put 11 points in the win for the Panthers.

TRIFECTA!!!

Charleston Southern set a Big South record for three-pointers in a game on Feb. 2 as it nailed 15 treys. They surpassed the old record of 14 that was set by High Point in 2006.

MAKING THE GRADE

ESPN The Magazine recently announced its Academic All-District teams. The Big South put four players on the First and Second Teams. Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** joined **AMANDA STULL** of Coastal Carolina on the First Team, while **MORIAH FRAZEE** of Liberty and teammate **RACHEL HAMMOND** each earned a bid to the Second Team.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. She has racked up 60 steals this season and in the process became the Big South's all-time steals leader. She is currently ranked No. 11 in the country with 3.2 steals per game and has 327 steals in her career.

MAKE'N IT RAIN

Charleston Southern's **KELSEY WASMER** has been making it rain three pointers in most every gym she has played in this season. She is ranked No. 7 in the country with 2.9 triples per game to spark a Lady Buc offense that ranks No. 6 in the nation with 8.2 treys per game.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Being inside the paint is not where a team wants to be when they're playing High Point. Led by **MACKENZIE MAIER**'s League-leading 2.5 blocked shots per game, the Panthers rank No. 1 in the Big South and 22nd in the country in blocked shots with 5.1 rejections per game. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneers lost both of their contests this past week, but sent the game against UNC Asheville into overtime. The Lady Bucs saw three player sin double figure scoring against Winthrop on Feb. 2, lead by sophomore **KATIE TULL** with 18 points. Freshman **ALI SCHWAGMEYER** lead the defensive effort with 10 rebounds. The contest to UNCA would be a bigger battle with the teams exchanging the lead 13 times. Again, three Lady Bucs were in double figure scoring, lead b y senior **PAM TOLBERT** who was only three points away from tying her personal best; she brought in 30 points. Schwagmeyer again lead the team in rebounds and was only one point and one rbounds away from a double-double, with 9 and 9.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina split its two games last week getting a win over Presbyterian before falling at High Point. Junior **AMANDA STULL** missed the first game of her career after falling ill early Saturday morning, ending a 78-game appearance streak including 49 consecutive starts. Sophomore **KATE JASINSKI** has led the Chants averaging 16 points in the past three games driving the Chanticleers to two wins. Coastal Carolina will end a two-game road trip at UNC Asheville Monday night before returning to Kimbel Arena where they are 8-2 this season for a four-game homestand. The Chants will host Charleston Southern Feb. 14 for their "Think Pink" game.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU remained unbeaten at home in 2008-09, as the Bulldogs defeated Radford 55-53 on Saturday afternoon in Paul Porter Arena. The Bulldogs avenged an earlier loss to the Highlanders this season, a 82-74 loss in Radford, Va. back on January 5. Despite, shooting only 33.3 percent and only 16.7 percent from behind the three-point line, GWU clamped down defensively, as Radford committed 23 turnovers and shot 0-10 from behind the three-point arc, snapping a 160 consecutive game streak with at least one made three-pointer. The Bulldogs again did it with a team effort, as GWU had three players - **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** (19), **LATROYA POPE** (12) and **COURTNEY EPPS** (12) - were in double figures in scoring.

HIGH POINT

High Point played just one game last week, picking up a 71-63 win over Coastal Carolina which featured three HPU players with double-doubles. **LATEISHA DEAN** had 11 points and 12 rebounds, **SHAMIA BROWN** posted 10 points and 12 rebounds while **FRANCES FIELDS** had 11 points and 12 assists. Fields' assist tally was just one shy of tying the HPU single game record. This week the Panthers host Charleston Southern early before traveling to Gardner-Webb over the weekend.

LIBERTY

Liberty's 11-game winning streak is tied for the fifth-longest active winning streak in the country and equals the ninth-longest streak in program history ... The Lady Flames have won five consecutive games by 20 or more points for just the second time in program history (also Feb. 28-March 12, 2005) ... Liberty was one of only three Division I women's basketball teams in the nation to place three players on the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District rosters, as **MEGAN FRAZEE** earned her third straight first-team nod, while **MORIAH FRAZEE** and **RACHEL HAMMOND** made the second team ... Liberty is 498-403 all-time in women's basketball, leaving the team just two wins shy of the 500-victory milestone.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC finished its five-game road trip and is now ready to host the next five games at Templeton Center ... Sophomore guard **AMANDA MILLS** reclaimed the top spot in free throw percentage in the Big South by going 6-of-8 from the free throw line against Winthrop ... The Blue Hose have raised their point production against Conference opponents, scoring 48 points on Saturday for the third time in four games.

RADFORD

Sophomore **TALEIA MOTON** has registered at least 20 points in three of her last four games, including a career-high 28 vs. Charleston Southern. Prior to this, her previous high was 19 points. **JOHNETTE WALKER** is 20 points shy of reaching the top 10 on Radford all-time scoring chart. She currently sits at 12th with a 1145 points. Radford had a five-year streak snapped when it did not hit a three -pointer at Gardner-Webb on Feb. 7. The Highlanders had gone 160 straight games hitting at least one trifecta. The last time they didn't was on Jan. 2, 2004 at Florida International.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville snapped a three-game losing streak with an 87-83 overtime victory over Charleston Southern in its only action of the week. **ANA BAKER** led the Bulldogs with 22 points while playing 43 minutes. She had two steals in the game breaking the school record for career steals. **LINDA AUGHBURNS** recorded her second double-double of the season with a season-high 20 points and 10 rebounds. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** also has a double-double with 13 points and 13 rebounds. Asheville had its second highest points production of the season with 87 points while posting a season-high 20 assists in the game. The Dogs shot well from beyond the arc going 7-for-12 for a season best 58.3 percent. Asheville has two games this week as it welcomes Coastal Carolina on Monday for its Pink Zone game before traveling to Presbyterian on Saturday.

WINTHROP

ASHLEY FANN had a solid week averaging 13.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and two assists while shooting 61 percent from the floor. In the process, Fann surpassed the 800 career rebound mark and became just the third player in school history to do so. Fann also became just the sixth player in Big South history to score at least 1,400 points and grab 800 or more rebounds. She now has 814 total rebounds and is just 31 behind the school's all-time leader. She only had four rebounds in limited minutes against Presbyterian but is still averaging a double-double in league play at 12.3 points and 11.0 rebounds. **TIFFANY RODD** returned to the line-up this week to connect on eight total threes in two games. She now has 229 career threes and is just 10 behind **NIKKI REDDICK**'s Big South Record. In the win over Presbyterian on Saturday, head coach **BUD CHILDERS** was able to play a his entire bench as 11 different players scored at least two points and at least one rebound. Tiffany Rodd, **SHANICE COLE** and **YVONNE VAN DAALLEN** were the only starters to play at least 20 minutes. Nine different players had at least 13 minutes.
