On Feb. 21, Frazee connected on 5-of-9 nine from the floor, added one from downtown and was 6-of-6 from the line as she finished with 17 points against Coastal Carolina. She also added six boards, two assists and two steals in the win. The honor marks Frazee's fifth Player of the Week nod this season.

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NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneers won their contest against Radford on Saturday evening. The team shot 52 percent from the floor, and hitting 10 from behind the arc, puts their three-point shots made at 219 and counting. The win moves the Bucs to .500 in conference play for the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina will play its third contest of a four-game homestand Monday night when it welcomes Radford to Kimbel Arena. The Chanticleers split the first two games of the four, defeating Charleston Southern, 63-62, before falling to Liberty, 77-44. Sophomore **SYDNEI MOSS** has averaged 15.5 points and 5.0 rebounds in the past two games at home and recorded double figures in the scoring column in 11 of the 12 league games this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs continue to dominate at home as GWU is 11-1 in home games this season. The 11 home victories is the most that the Bulldogs have won in a single season since moving to NCAA Division I in 2000-01. In the home win over UNCA on Feb. 16, junior **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** surpassed the 500 career rebound plateau. Also in the win, Coach **RICK REEVES** picked up his 70th career Big South Conference win.

HIGH POINT

High Point is looking to snap a four game losing streak this week as it travels to Presbyterian before returning home to face Winthrop later in the week. The Panthers tied a single game HPU record on Feb. 21 against UNC Asheville with 11 team blocked shots.

LIBERTY

With its two victories last week, Liberty extended several winning streaks ... The Lady Flames have won six straight road games, 14 straight games overall, 15 straight games against Big South foes and 31 straight games against Coastal Carolina ... Liberty's 63-48 victory over Winthrop on Feb. 16 was win No. 500 in program history ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** has scored in double figures in 60 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the nation ... **EVERY WARLEY** made 11 consecutive field goal attempts, between Feb. 9-21 and has connected on 14 of her last 15 attempts (93.3 percent) ... Liberty held both Winthrop and Coastal Carolina below the 50-point mark, and the Lady Flames have now limited half of their 24 opponents this season to 49 points or fewer.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC beat Gardner-Webb, 62-53, to capture its first Big South win in school history...The team shot a season-high 60 percent from the floor and dominated on the glass, outrebounding the Runnin' Bulldogs 33-23 ... Sophomore forward **CHELSEA WRIGHT** set career high numbers with her first double-double of 15 rebounds and 10 points ... Sophomore **KATLIN MOORE** also had a career night scoring a personal-best 20 points as one of four Blue Hose players to finish with double digits in scoring...PC fell to Longwood earlier in the week

RADFORD

Radford plays its final road game of the season on Monday at Coastal Carolina. The Highlanders return home on Saturday, Feb. 28 for their homecoming game against Presbyterian, starting a three-game homestand to end the regular season. With a career-high 22 points at Charleston Southern, senior **JOHNETTE WALKER** jumped from 12th to eighth on Radford all-time scoring list with 1,178 points. She is 19 points from the seventh spot. Defensively, the Highlanders have won the turnover battle in nine of the last 10 game (+5.3). They have recorded 11.6 steals per game over this 10-game stretch.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finished its home schedule with a Senior Day victory over High Point. The Bulldogs' two seniors led the way with **ANA BAKER** leading all scorers with 20 points, six rebounds, and six assists. **JESSICA MONROE** also played a key role with 13 points and seven rebounds. **LINDSEY MONTGOMERY** posted her second-straight double-double with 11 points and 12 rebounds. Montgomery was the lone bright spot in Asheville's loss at Gardner-Webb earlier in the week. She scored a career best 28 points and grabbed 11 rebounds. For the week, Montgomery averaged 19.5 points and 11.5 rebounds. As a team, the Bulldogs shot 70 percent from the free throw line against High Point on Saturday. It was the fourth time this season Asheville has shot better than 70 percent from the foul line. Asheville's only game this week is at Liberty.

WINTHROP

Last season the Lady Eagles captured a school record 20 wins in a single season and finished above .500 for the first time since making the transition to the NCAA Division I level. Before the school became a D-1 program the Lady Eagles had nine winning seasons as a member of the AIAW and four winning seasons in NAIA. Now that the team won 20 games and had a winning record for the first time last year, the team is looking at possibly finishing with a winning record in back-to-back seasons. It would be the first time since the program did it in 1984-1986. Winthrop has at least six games remaining and if it can win at least four of them it will guarantee another winning season. Before last year the Lady Eagles had never finished above .500 in the Big South and posted a 7-5 league record. They need to win three of the last five league games to get the back-to-back winning records in the Big South. **ASHLEY FANN** entered the season with 625 total rebounds for an average of 6.8 per season. She is currently averaging 9.0 rebounds a game this season. She now has 800 career rebounds and has moved into third on Winthrop's all-time list. Fann is just the third person in school history and the 11th in Big South history to reach the 800 rebound plateau. She is now nine behind second place all time held by Stephanie Morris and 12 behind the all-time leader, **TAMMY JONES**.
