Tolbert averaged 26.0 points per game and shot 53 percent from the floor as her Lady Bucs went 1-1 on the week. Against UNC Asheville on Jan. 5, Tolbert connected on 12-of-24 from the floor and added three from the line to finish with 27 points against the Bulldogs. She also pulled down six caroms, dished out two helpers and came up with three steals. Five days later against Coastal Carolina, Tolbert shot 56 percent from the floor, hit 4-of-9 from three-point land and added three from the charity stripe to finish with 25 points in the win over the Chanticleers. The guard stayed busy in the win as she came up with four rebounds, three assists and two steals in the win. The honor marks her second Player of the Week nod this season.

Thompson put in 11.7 points per game, shot 52 percent from the floor and 47 percent from downtown to lead her team to a 2-1 record on the week, including two Big South wins. She got her week started with 18 points on 55 percent from the floor and 57 percent from the beyond the arc in Asheville's win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 5. After scoring seven points against Carson-Newman, Thompson helped the Bulldogs to their second-straight Big South win as she hit 3-of-7 from the floor and 2-of-5 from downtown to finish with 10 points against Gardner-Webb. She also finished with five rebounds, two assists and two steals in the three-game span. The honor marks her first Freshman of the Week plaudits this season.

DYNAMIC DUO TRIO

Charleston Southern is the only team in the Big South this season with three players that have posted multiple 20 point games. **PAM TOLBERT** leads the way with four, while **KELSEY WASMER** has three 20-point games ... **KATIE TULL** each has two 20-point games on the year.

SOLO ON THE TRIO

KELSEY WASMER is also the only individual in the Big South that is ranked nationally in two categories. She is ranked 15th in the country with 2.8 three-pointers per game, while her 42.9 clip from beyond the arc is ranked 24th in the Division I.

LOCKDOWN - WINTHROP LADY EAGLES

The Winthrop Lady Eagles are posting the League's top-rated and the country's 26th-best scoring defense as it is holding opponents to just 54.5 points per game ... From beyond the arc, Winthrop is allowing teams to shoot just 26-percent to rank No. 21 in Division I.

SHE'S A STICK-UP KID

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been picking opponents' pockets all year long on the basketball court. The senior guard has racked up 40 steals on the year and is No. 15 in the country with 3.10 steals per contest. She has also been helping her team out on the scoring end as she is No. 2 on her team with 11.6 points per game.

THIRD TIME IS A CHARM

High Point's **SHAMIA BROWN** is not your ordinary freshman. She has stepped up to become a BIG part of the Panther offense this season. Brown has been named the Big South's Freshman of the Week three times this season and has posted two 20-point games this year. She also ranks second in the Big South with three double-doubles on the year.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs got their first conference win of the season beating Coastal Carolina at home with a shot from **PAM TOLBERT** with 3 seconds remaining, for a final score of 65-63. The win also marks the first victory for head coach **JULIE GOODENOUGH** over Coastal. The Lady Bucs did not fare so well earlier in the week losing to UNCA at home in a game where the Bucs should have been able to capitalize better having less TOs and more steals, but found it hard to sink shots.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina fell to High Point and Charleston Southern last week and has dropped three games in the past four outings. A bright spot for the Chanticleers was junior **KENDRA REYNOLDS**, who averaged 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds in two games. The Chants continue a four-game road swing at Winthrop this Saturday.

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs are currently riding a three-game losing streak and are 0-3 in Big South Conference play thus far this season. All three conference losses have come on the road for the Bulldogs. Gardner-Webb continues to outshoot their opponents from the field, shooting 41 percent compared to 38.8 percent by their opponents, but have been plagued with inconsistent play on both ends of the court. Over the last three games, junior **MARGARET ROUNDTREE** has moved into fourth-place in GWU history in career rebounds with 445. Guards **MERANDA BURNETT** and **DOMINIQUE HUDSON** are now fourth and fifth, respectively in GWU history in career assists. Burnett has 203, while Hudson has 152.

HIGH POINT

High Point has opened the Big South schedule with a three game win streak and is off to its best League start since the 2005-2006 season. Junior **ANDREA TUCKER** has come on strong since League play began, averaging a double-double this past week. **MACKENZIE MAIER** had a strong game against Radford this past week, posting 12 points, 13 rebounds and six blocks. High Point hosts Gardner-Webb on Monday before stepping out of Big South play to host Elon in the team's final non-conference game. The Elon game will also be HPU's Pink Zone game this season.

LIBERTY

After opening the season with a 1-6 record, Liberty has won six of its last seven games, including four in a row ... Liberty is now 28-2 in games played within the state of South Carolina under head coach **CAREY GREEN** ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** scored a game-high 20 points at Winthrop on Saturday, boosting her career point total to 1,515. Frazee is the first Big South women's basketball player since former Liberty standout **KATIE FEENSTRA** to reach the 1,500-point plateau. The contest also marked Frazee's 50th straight game scoring in double figures ... With a big week, **MORIAH FRAZEE** could join her sister in the 1,000-point club. Frazee enters the week with 971 career markers.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC was perfect from the free throw line (7-for-7) for the third time this season (only team in the Big South to do so)...junior forward **LEA SMITH** shot 44 percent from the floor (4-of-9) and went 3-for-3 from the stripe

RADFORD

Radford opened the conference season with an 82-74 victory over Gardner-Webb. In that game the Highlanders set season highs for points, points in a half (51) and field goal percentage (48.2). The win also improved their record to 17-6 in Big South openers. **KYMESHA ALSTON** had a career week. She started with a career-high 23 points on 9-of-10 shooting against Gardner-Webb with nine rebounds. Against High Point, she pulled down a career-best 14 rebounds. Against High Point, Radford corralled 59 rebounds, the most since it recorded 51 against UNC Asheville in the Big South tournament last season. Three Highlanders registered double figures in rebounds. Alston (14), **VANDY PULLEN** (11) and **DENAY WOOD** (10). For Pullen, she also scored a game-high 14 points to recorded her first collegiate double-double. It was also a career-best mark for Wood. Radford played its 300th regular season Big South game at High Point on Saturday. The Highlanders are now 199-101 and will be seeking their 200th win in their 23rd season of Big South basketball.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville picked up two Big South Conference wins this week over Charleston Southern and Gardner-Webb. The Bulldogs were led by **ANA BAKER** who averaged 15 points per game and 5.7 assists per game. Asheville has been hot from beyond the three-point arc. **LINDSEY THOMPSON** was 8-for-17 (47.1 percent) from long range on the week as she averaged 11.7 points per game on the week. She has been in double-figures in six of her last seven games. The only game she missed she left early with an injury. Leading scorer **CHIOMA OKOLI** averaged 13.7 points per game for the week. Baker became UNC Asheville Division I career assist leader against Gardner-Webb. She now has 349 career assists and is 80 assists shy of the all-time school record. The Dogs will complete a stretch of five games in 10 days when they play Presbyterian on Monday night.

WINTHROP

Senior **ASHLEY FANN** entered the season with the 9th highest mark for consecutive starts in her career at 69. She was also tied for 21st with most career starts at 87. She's played in a total of 105 games in her career and has scored at least a point in 106 of the games. The only one she didn't score a point was her second career game. Fann has also grabbed at least one rebound in every single game of her career. Fann has also led the team in scoring every single year of her career. No player in Winthrop history has ever led the team in scoring all four years. She currently leads the team with 11.1 ppg. Fann is currently tied for 19th on the Big South all-time rebounding list and 22nd on the scoring list. On Saturday, Winthrop outrebounded the Liberty Flames by a 34-29 advantage. Liberty entered the game as a top 20 team nationally in rebound margin at +8.7 and in the previous three games had outrebounded opponents by 26, 16 and 20. The last time Liberty was beat on the boards was Dec. 2, 2008 at James Madison.
