Tolbert averaged 24.0 points per game and shot 50 percent from the floor to lead her Lady Bucs to a 2-0 record last week. She got her week started with 33 points on 12-of-18 from the floor and 7-of-12 from downtown as well as two from the line and eight rebounds in Charleston Southern's win over Southern Wesleyan on Dec. 16. Two days later against Savannah State, the guard put in 15 points, dished out eight assists and came away with four steals and five rebounds in CSU's win against Savannah State. For the week, she shot 41 percent from the beyond the arc, 86 percent from the line and posted 13 rebounds and 11 assists. The honor marks Tolbert's first Player of the Week plaudit this season.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs played two games this past week before taking a break for the Holidays. They won both games at home giving them the first time this season they have won back-to-back games. Senior Guard PAM TOBERT tied her career best with 33 points against Southern Wesleyan and Sophomores LYDIA JOHNSON and CRYSTAL ROBINSON gave their first career double-double performaces against Savannah State. The Lady Bucs saw a total of five players score in double digits against Savannah State. The Bucs are taking a break for the Holidays but will be back on the hardwood December 29 at the North Charleston Coliseum to take on Furman in their only coliseum game of the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

After playing to a 2-1 record last week, Coastal Carolina will break for the holidays and return to the court for a meeting with Alabama State Monday, Dec. 29. Opening tip is set for 6 p.m. (EDT).

GARDNER-WEBB

The Bulldogs return to action on Dec. 28 when they travel to Dayton, Ohio to participate in the Dayton Classic.

HIGH POINT

High Point picked up a home win over Chowan this past week in the final game before the holiday break. The Panthers will take some time off for Christmas before returning to action on Dec. 29 when they compete in the UTSA New Year's Classic in San Antonio. Texas.

LIBERTY

Liberty went 1-1 on its pre-Christmas road swing ... The Lady Flames came back from a one-point halftime deficit to claim a 55-43 win at Winston-Salem State on Dec. 20 ... During four of Liberty's 10 games this season, the team leading at the intermission has not gone on to win the game ... **AVERY WARLEY** scored a career-high and team-high 17 points at Winston-Salem State, becoming the sixth different Lady Flame to lead the team in scoring already this season. Only four players paced Liberty in scoring during the entire 2007-08 campaign ... The Lady Flames limited No. 19/20 Vanderbilt to 41.4 percent field goal shooting, and Liberty has now held 61 straight opponents below 50 percent from the floor ... Liberty will travel to Blacksburg, Va., Dec. 29-30, for its third tournament of the season, the Hokie Hardwood Classic.

PRESBYTERIAN

PC grabbed a season-high 31 boards at Wake Forest on Dec. 15 ... Sophomore guard AMANDA MILLS scored a career-high 26 points in PC's narrow loss to Stetson (67-63) ... The Blue Hose played in front of a Templeton Center record attendance at a women's game, in honor of the first annual 'School Day' ... Sophomore KATLIN MOORE racked up a personal-best 10 assists against the Hatters ... PC shot 10-of-21 from beyond the arc on Thursday ... Freshman forward BRITTANY BROWN recorded the team's first double-double with 11 points and 10 rebounds against Stetson ... She was the high scorer with 11 points at Army ... Mills has made 21 consecutive free throws since Oct. 16.

RADFORD

Radford suffered a pair of defeats last week to VCU and at Navy. Against VCU, Charron Leeper tied a career high with 11 points. Making her first collegiate start, junior **DAVIDA DODSON** scored a career high nine points, eight in the first half. Also, **KENDRA PORTER** dished out a career-best four assists. Against Navy, senior **JOHNETTE WALKER** became just the second Highlander to record 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 400 assists and 300 steals in her career. She moved into 16th on Radford's scoring charts, surpassing Radford first 1,000-point scorer and former head coach **CHARLENE CURTIS**.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville is 3-3 over its last six games after a 65-53 loss at Campbell. **ANA BAKER** led the Dogs with 19 points which is her second highest total of the season. Freshman **LINDSEY THOMPSON** had a season-high 11 points to her first career double-figure game. The Dogs are 0-3 on the road this season and will travel to the Terrapin Classic this weekend.

WINTHROP

Winthrop is going through an offensive slump in its last three games and are 1-2 during that stretch. The Lady Eagles set a school record low with just 27 points against 25th ranked Georgia Tech and followed that up with 46 points against Memphis. In the last three games Winthrop is shooting 34 percent from the field, 13 percent from three, and averaging 24 turnovers a game. Defensively they've been solid by holding opponents to just 52 points a game during the three games while shooting 39 percent from the floor ... Despite the team going through a shooting slump, senior **ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT** has been quite the opposite as she's led the team in scoring over the last three games with an average of 9.0 points. She's shooting 72 percent from the floor and was a perfect 9-for-9 over the weekend. She is shooting 51 percent from the floor on the season. **TIFFANY RODD** returned to action over the weekend as she averaged 6.0 ppg off the bench. She moved up the career list to a tie for 13th place with 1,013 points.


