Megan Frazee • Sr. G/F • Liberty Xenia, Ohio

Frazee averaged 20.7 points and 9.3 rebounds per game to lead Liberty to a 3-0 record on the week, including Liberty's first-ever win over Virginia Tech en route to winning the Hokie Classic. She was named the MVP of the tournament as she put in 23 points and ripped down 12 rebounds against North Carolina A&T on Dec. 29. The next day against Virginia Tech, she notched 20 points and seven rebounds. She also came up big in the Lady Flames' League-opening win over Gardner-Webb, as she poured in 19 points and fell one rebound short of a double-double as she corralled nine boards. For the week. Frazee connected on 22of-53 to finish with a 42 percent clip from the floor to go along with an 80 percent mark from the line. The honor marks her second Player of the Week nod this season.

NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Shamia Brown F • High Point Raeford, N.C.

Brown posted two double-doubles on the week as she averaged 15.3 and 8.7 rebounds in three games. After posting eight points and three rebounds against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 29, Brown got things going with 22 points on 11-of-16 from the floor, and 11 rebounds vs. Texas San Antonio on Dec. 30. She finished her week with 16 points and 12 rebounds in High Point's League-opening win over Charleston Southern on Jan. 3. She shot 55 percent from the floor on 21-of-38 shooting, and came up with four steals and one block in the three-game span. The honor is her third Freshman of the Week nod this season.

The Big South opened League play this past weekend with eight teams in action. Coastal Carolina, High Point, Liberty and Winthrop each got the season started off with a win ... Radford will play its first Conference game on Jan. 5.

DYNAMIC DUO TRIO

Charleston Southern is the only team in the Big South this season with three players that have posted multiple 20 point games. **KELSEY WASMER** leads the way with three 20-point games, while teammates **PAM TOLBERT** and **KATIE TULL** each have two.

In her three games back from an ankle injury, Big South Preseason Player of the Year MEGAN FRAZEE of Liberty has been on a tear. In her two games in the Virginia Tech Hokie Classic, Frazee posted two 20-point games, including a 23-point, 12-rebound double-double. She was named MVP of the tournament en route to leading her team to the Hokie Classic Crown.

THIRD TIME IS A CHARM

High Point's SHAMIA BROWN is not your ordinary freshman. She has stepped up to become a BIG part of the Panther offense this season. Brown has been named the Big South's Freshman of the Week three times this season and has posted two 20-point games this year. She also ranks second in the Big South with three double-doubles on the year.

ON THE LOW DOWN... DOWN LOW... NO DOUBT

The Coastal Carolina Chanticleers posted a remarkable feat on Nov. 29. In its win over Southern Virginia, Coastal Carolina held them to just three points in the first 20 minutes of action. Although the NCAA doesn't track halftime stats, it is believed to be one the lowest scoring output by team in a half this season, if not the lowest.

The Big South currently has nine players who have scored 20-or-more points on more than one occasion this season. Winthrop's ASHLEY FANN, Charleston Southern's WHITNEY WILEY and Liberty's MEGAN FRAZEE are the only players in the Big South to post consecutive 20-point games ... Fann and Frazee are also the only players in the League to have two 20 point, 10 rebound games.

Charleston Southern's KELSEY WASMER and KATIE TULL and Gardner-Webb's LAURA POVIONYTE and LATROYA POPE have something in common so far this season ... They are the only teammates in the League to score 20 points in the same game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Buccaneers lost a very hard fought game to Furman in their only game hosted at the North Charleston Coliseum this season. The Bucs opened their regular season Conference play hosting the High Point Panthers at home on Saturday evening, but dropped the contest after a back-and-forth battle in the second half.

COASTAL CAROLINA

For the first time this season, the Chanticleers had five players in double figures in the 68-55 win over UNC Asheville. Sophomores SYDNEI MOSS (18) and KATE JASINSKI (15) combined with juniors AMANDA STULL (11), KENDRA REYNOLDS (11) and DEVIN RIVERS (10) to each hit double figures. Coastal Carolina improved to 7-1 at home this season.

GARDNER-WEBB

GWU used a last second shot to defeat Lipscomb, 66-64, at the buzzer in the Dayton Classic in Dayton, Ohio on December 12. The Bulldogs opened up 2009 with a big home victory over Montreat on New Year's Day. In the 85-57 win, MARGARET ROUNDREE poured in a career high 25 points, while tieing a school record with 12 made field goals as she was 12 of 15 from the floor. DOMINIQUE HUDSON tied a GWU record as she dished out nine assists for the game, while the 35 made field goals by the Bulldogs as a team was the fourth most in a single game in GWU History. In their Big South Conference opener, the Bulldogs fell on the road at Liberty, 55-42. The Bulldogs struggled offensively, shooting only 26 percent from the floor and scoring their lowest point total (42) of the year.

HIGH POINT

High Point got off to a good start as they opened 2009 and the Big South season with a win over Charleston Southern. Sophomore JURICA HARGRAVES hit the 500 point mark during the game. HPU participated in the UTSA New Year's Classic over the holiday break where freshman SHAMIA BROWN was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 15 points and posting her second double-double of the season against host team UTSA.

LIBERTY

Liberty won the Hokie Hardwood Classic by defeating North Carolina A&T and the host team, Virginia Tech, on Dec. 29-30 ... The Lady Flames' two-point win over the Hokies was Liberty's first-ever triumph over Virginia Tech, in 15 tries ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** was named tournament MVP, after sinking the game-winning shot with just 51 seconds left versus Virginia Tech, while **AVERY WARLEY** pulled down 29 rebounds in the two games and also earned a spot on the all-tournament team ... Liberty opened Big South Conference play with a win for the ninth consecutive season on Jan. 3, with a 55-42 home triumph over Gardner-Webb ... Megan and **MORIAH FRAZEE** combined for 33 of the Lady Flames' 55 points against the Bulldogs, putting the Frazee triplets over 3,000 combined career points ... The Lady Flames have won five of their last six games, after opening the season 1-6 ... Liberty has outrebounded seven consecutive opponents, with six of them coming by double digits.

PRESBYTERIAN

The Blue Hose dropped their conference opener to Winthrop at Templeton Center on Jan. 3 ... Sophomore **KATLIN MOORE** scored a team-high 13 points and added three assists and two steals ... PC had a season-low 16 turnovers and a season-high 10 offensive boards, with junior foward **LEA SMITH** leading the way with six.

RADFORD

The Highlanders are coming off a week hiatus and return to action Monday, Jan. 5 when they host Gardner-Webb in the Conference opener for the Highlanders. Radford is 16-6 in league openers, 12-5 at home. It marks the first Big South game in Peters Hall. It also marks the first back-to-back home games for Radford this season, who play 12 of its first 16 games away from home. Junior DAVIDA DODSON pulled down a career-high five rebounds and tied a career-best with three steals vs. American. Both were team-highs. JOHNETTE WALKER (1,053) in three points from moving into 15th on Radford's scoring list. TALEIA MOTON has scored in double figures the last four games (14.8 ppg) and nine of the first 11 contests.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville is 3-3 over its last six games after a 65-53 loss at Campbell. ANA BAKER led the Dogs with 19 points which is her second highest total of the season. Freshman LINDSEY THOMPSON had a season-high 11 points to her first career double-figure game. The Dogs are 0-3 on the road this season and will travel to the Terrapin Classic this weekend.

WINTHROP

With her nine points at Presbyterian on Saturday, ASHLEY FANN surpassed the 1,300 point plateau in her career. She is just the fourth player in Winthrop history to reach the 1,300 point mark. With the win over Presbyterian on Saturday, Winthrop has now won 3 of its last 4 Big South openers. Winthrop entered Saturday's game as the top free throw shooting team in the Big South at .698. Before the Campbell game Winthrop was shooting .723 from the foul line, but has struggled in the last two games by hitting just 14 of 29 (.483). Fann entered the Presbyterian game with 706 career rebounds, which ranked 7th on Winthrop's all-time list. She pulled down a season-high 15 rebounds against the Blue Hose and jumped to 5th. It was the fifth game this year where she's pulled down 10 or more rebounds.
